Comments / Explanations:

Trainer S Brunton was fined \$150 for late rider declarations under the provisions of LR13.3.

Trainer R Hamer was reprimanded under the provisions of LR13.3 for the late rider declaration on MISS DELIA in race 3.

Trainers G McCulloch, K Paterson and Team Wells were reprimanded under the provisions of AR65(1) for failing to produce the horse identification certificates for horses engaged at today's meeting.

RACE 1 - RON RILEY MAIDEN (1220 METRES)

The start of this race was delayed one minute due to FIGHTING GRACE being re-saddled behind the barriers.

MISS KAFOOPS – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

OXY DREAM – Tightened on jumping when GEEGEE'S SHOWTIME carried ROSE OF SEPOY outwards and MISS KAFOOPS shifted in marginally, raced wide throughout.

SMASHING HIT – Jumped awkwardly, shifted out tightening GEEGEE'S MISTY and FIGHTING GRACE, over-raced in the early stages. Rider D Tootell was advised to exercise care when shifting out at about the 400 metres, carrying ROSE OF SEPOY outwards.

WOUNDED MISS – Raced wide throughout.

ADACHI – Jumped awkwardly and restrained off heels of WOUNDED MISS shortly after and was slow to begin as a result. Checked off heels of ROSE OF SEPOY near the 400 metres when being carried wider by SMASHING HIT.

FIGHTING GRACE – re-saddled behind the barriers prior to the start.

RACE 2 – ALF MATTHEWS MAIDEN (1620 METRES)

CAMPEAO (IRE) – Bumped WEALLSTUCKATHOME at the start, lost nearside bubble cheeker in the barriers, placing the gelding at a disadvantage throughout the event, laid in throughout. Rider D Tootell was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding for allowing his mount to shift in near the 350 metres, resulting in VELOCE AQUILA checking and losing its position. In not taking further action stewards took into account the horses racing manners and that it had lost its near side bubble cheeker at the start.

JACKJACK – Caught wide throughout.

NEEDS REMEMBERING – Caught wide to the 650 metres.

UNNERVING – Rider I Toker was harmlessly dislodged after the finish and was examined by the on course medical officers and passed fit to fulfill his remaining riding engagements. A post-race veterinary examination of the gelding failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

VELOCE AQUILA – Checked and lost its position at about the 350 metres when tightened for room by CAMPEAO. A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor abrasions to the right foreleg.

LADY INDY – Fractious in barriers prior to the start, a post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

LEICA STARLET – Slow to begin, over raced early and middle stages, raced wide throughout.

WEALLSTUCKATHOME – Jumped inwards at the start and bumped with CAMPEAO.

RACE 3 - LADBROKES BM60 HCP (1620 METRES)

ASHMANIA – Bumped with LUCA BRATZI passing the 1500 metres, rider dropped her whip near the 200 metres.

DOONICAN (IRE) – Slow to begin.

MISS DELIA – Jumped awkwardly and was slow into stride, raced wide throughout.

UNVANQUISHABLE – Fractious in barriers, bounded out on jumping and was slow to begin as a result.

NEED A FLUTTER – Tightened for room at about the 750 metres, steadied and lost its position.

LUCA BRATZI – Bumped with ASHMANIA passing the 1500 metres, under-went a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

RANSOM TRUST – Bounded out on jumping.

FOUR LETTER WORD – Raced wide throughout. Stewards inquired into an incident passing the 750 metres. Rider B Neto pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding for allowing his mount to shift inwards for a considerable distance tightening LUCA BRATZI in onto NEED A FLUTTER resulting in rider R Tan having to steady his mount for some distance and then ultimately losing his position in the race. In considering the penalty stewards took into account the level of interference, his guilty plea and his record in relation to this offence. Rider B Neto's licence to ride in races was suspended for one Tasmanian race date, commencing midnight Tuesday 30th August 2022 until midnight Sunday the 4th of September 2022. Rider B Neto was advised of his right of appeal.

CAPTAIN DAVE – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 4 - ACCESS HARDWARE BM68 HCP (1450 METRES)

BRINKTOP LAD – Raced three wide throughout, shifted out in the home straight carrying NEED TO BE UNIQUE wider.

IRIS WEST – Compounded over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Stewards to follow up.

BLUSHED – Rider T Baker reported the mare failed to respond when placed under pressure and that in his opinion the mare failed to stretch out and the action felt a miss. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a poor heart recovery. Stewards to follow up.

RACE 5 - VALE MICHAEL HART CLASS 1 HCP (1450 METRES)

DAWN EAGLE – Raced three wide throughout.

POWERFUL PEBBLES – Held up for a clear run from the 300 metres to the 200 metres.

A WEE NIP – Stewards granted permission for rider C Atkinson to ride 1kg over the allotted minimum weight. Held up for a clear run between BAHEERA and SHANOA from the 200 metres to 150 metres.

RECOMPENSA – Rider reported the mare choked down and was making unusual respiratory noises in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Follow up by stewards.

RACE 6 - MARJORIE FITZPATRICK MEMORIAL OPEN HCP (1220 METRES)

BLAZE FORTH – Over-raced in the early stages and steadied off the heels of MUSIC ADDITION at about the 800 metres.

MUSIC ADDITION – Stewards spoke to Rider C Jordan in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Rider C Jordan stated that gelding didn't appreciate the track conditions today. Stewards will follow up with Trainer G Stevenson.

ALPINE WOLF – Raced three wide throughout. Laid in over the concluding stages. Rider D Ganderton reported that the gelding failed to respond when placed under pressure from the 400 metres and he felt something amiss in the gelding's action. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination and was found to have a slow heart rate recovery. Stewards to follow up.

VIVILICI – Bumped with FIVEFINGERDISCOUNT which shifted out on jumping.

FIVEFINGERDISCOUNT (NZ) – Stewards granted permission for rider C Atkinson to ride 1kg over the allotted minimum weight. Shifted out on jumping bumping with VIVILICI. Stewards spoke to trainer J Flannery in relation to the apparent improved performance of the gelding. Trainer J Flannery stated that the addition of blinkers and the schooling over the jumps during the week, including working on the gelding's fitness would have assisted the improved performance.

RACE 7 - GRENVILLE STUD CLASS 1 HCP (1220 METRES)

GEE GEE MISS QUITA – Raced wide throughout.

TWEE – Hampered after the start when PUNK PRINCESS shifted out, raced three wide throughout. Rider reported the mare failed to handle today's track conditions.

POET WARRIOR – Bumped with SWINGAPINGA which shifted out on jumping.

SHAKE YOUR TOOSHY – Laid out approaching the home straight.

SOROLI – Laid out throughout.

SWINGAPINGA – Shifted out at the start and bumped with POET WARRIOR.

PUNK PRINCESS – Shifted out on jumping and bumped with TWEE.

RACE 8 - KACHOO FASHION CLASS 3 HCP (1220 METRES)

THUNBERG – Over raced in the early stages.

NEV'S BOY – Fractious in barriers, slow to begin.

ENTRAPPED – Jumped outwards at the start, raced three wide throughout.

MILITARY LAW – Slow to begin

SEGUIMENTOS – Slow to begin, laid out throughout
