STARTER A EMERY

Supplementary: Tasmanian Trotting Club 21st August 2022 Race 8

Driver N Ford (KENYA NZ) pleaded guilty to a charge under AHRR156(2)(a). Mr Ford was fined the sum of \$400 in line with the minimum penalty guidelines. Mr Ford was also suspended for a period of 4 race dates in that he had also breached the minimum penalty guidelines in exceeding 5 separate offences under AHRR156(2) in the previous 12-month period.

Driver J Duggan (HEZ RAZOR SHARP) pleaded guilty to a charge under AHRR156(2)(a). Mr Duggan was fined the sum of \$200 in line with the minimum penalty guidelines.

RACE 1 – THREE YEAR OLD SPRING CHAMPIONSHIP HEAT 2. – 2200 METRES

A warning was issued to MAGICIAN which had a tendency to hang out during the event.

Driver G Rattray (ROCKNROLL WIZARD) was fined the sum of \$100 after pleading guilty to a charge under AHRR162(1)(www)(c). Particulars were that he allowed his horse to shift wider in the home straight affording an inside run to NERO STRIDE which went on to finish in second place.

NERO STRIDE was held up early before gaining an inside run in the home straight.

RACE 2 – LAUNCESTON VETERINARY GROUP TWO YEAR OLD- 1680 METRES

BIG ENERGY raced roughly shortly after the start.

NORBET raced greenly throughout the event then hung in around the final turn and contacted a marker peg. A warning was issued.

MAJOR IDEAL was held up and unable to be fully tested.

RACE 3 - FIND US ON FACEBOOK STAKES- 2200 METRES

MONTANA STORM NZ broke in the early stages of the score up however was in position at the start. The gelding will be placed on its last chance in the mobile draw.

AHA REACTION NZ was caught wide early before working forward to race outside of the leader and then obtained a trail when DIAMONDS N CASH NZ worked forward to take over that position.

SOMEDAN was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

MONTANA STORM NZ was held up and unable to be fully tested.

YOUNG ROOSTER was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

DIAMONDS N CASH NZ was detained on course for 2.5 hours to enable blood samples to be obtained.

RACE 4 – LEE'S ORCHARD PACE HEAT 2– 2200 METRES

LALASA was caught wide early before working forward to race outside the leader.

ALTA CASSINO NZ was caught wide early before working forward to the lead.

RACE 5 – TRAINER ENCOURAGEMENT SPRINT SERIES - HEAT 2– 2200 METRES

BIGLITTLESIS was caught wide early before working forward to race outside the leader.

THE ATHERLETE was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

IMPULZE was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

MISS BARTY was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

RACE 6 – LADBROKES RACING CENTRE PACE HEAT 2–2200 METRES

KOHANAH was out of position at the start and has been placed on its last chance in the mobile draw.

COOLHAND EASTON NZ was out of position at the start and has been placed on its last chance in the mobile draw.

KIWI BLOKE NZ raced roughly shortly after the start and was caught wide early before being restrained to the rear of the field.

WATTABOUT SPANGHER was caught wide early before being restrained to the rear of the field.

BUSTER WILLIAM worked forward in the middle stages to race outside the leader.

EQUITY STRIDE shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

RACE 7 - NEIL PITTS PTY LTD STAKES- 2200 METRES

KARALTA DAZZLER was out of position at the start however no action was taken against this horse as there was no horse to follow on the front row.

HEZA RUMMAGE NZ was out of position at the start however no action was taken against this horse as there was no horse to follow on the front row.

TO THE LOOKOUT was caught wide early before being restrained to the rear of the field.

MISTA EAGLE was caught wide early before being restrained to the rear of the field.

WRITTEN IN SILK was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

CINOCAL JAMANE pulled hard during the event and was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

DON HESTON was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

KEEP PLAYING was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

RACE 8 - RARE EARTH STAKES HEAT 2-2200 METRES

SMOOTH DEAL NZ broke after the start and has been placed on its last chance in the stand draw.

JACKSON NEPTUNE swung sideways at the start and has been placed on its last chance in the stand draw.

BELIEVE IN FOREVER galloped out and has been placed on its last chance in the stand draw.

BLUE MOON RISING NZ galloped out. As this was the geldings first start since qualifying it has been placed out of the draw in future standing starts.

SEAL THE DESTINY was fractious before the start and then moved backward and reared as the start was effected. As this was the geldings first start since qualifying it has been placed out of the draw in future standing starts.

EMJAYS BLACK CHIP galloped out and has been placed on its last chance in the stand draw.

KIAVINO STRIDE was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

WHERE YA BIN NZ was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

EMJAYS BLACK CHIP pulled hard during the event.

STREETSIDE CLASSIC was inconvenienced after the start.

MACHS MARETA NZ underwent a post-race veterinary examination after being beaten in excess of 56 metres. No abnormalities were detected. Driver K Pratten reported that the offside tyre had deflated at the 500 metre mark and after taking into this into account no action was taken.

RACE 9 - CARLTON DRAUGHT PACE- 2200 METRES

TRUE STEPPER was out of position as the start was effected. Driver C Bell was reprimanded under AHRR162(1)(j) for failing to maintain his position until the start.

SAFE JEWELS raced outside the leader in the early stages before obtaining a trail when WITH REVENGE NZ made a three wide move to take over that position.

COVERED KYLIE gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 41 metres.

ASHLEYS BLUE CHIP gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 41 metres.

SAFE UNDER FIRE gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 43 metres.

STUNIN MAGIC NZ underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 78 metres. No abnormalities were detected and the mare has been placed on her last chance to race competitively.

LORIMERTYRRELL shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

RACE 10 - NUTRIEN AG SUPPLIES PACE- 2200 METRES

JUNIPER was out of position as the start was effected. Driver C Bell was reprimanded under AHRR162(1)(j) for failing to maintain his position until the start.

GUYS BETTOR BET was out of position as the start was effected. Driver K Pratten was reprimanded under AHRR162(1)(j) for failing to maintain his position until the start.

KERMADEC was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

TEE JAY CEE underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 67 metres. No abnormalities were detected and the gelding has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

VIGOROSO NZ broke in the score up and was slightly out of position at the start. The gelding has been placed on its last chance in the mobile draw.

An inquiry into the reasons why EYE SEE DOUBLE locked wheels and was checked close to the finish line in this event will be heard at a later date.
