Supplementary. Launceston Pacing Club 28/08/2022 Race 10

Stewards inquired into the reasons for EYE SEE DOUBLE (T Rattray) and KERMADEC, (C Castles) locking wheels shortly after turning for home on the final occasion. After viewing the films and taking evidence from the drivers it was determined that as KERMADEC was shifting ground on the inside of EYE SEE DOUBLE, the proceeding runner, ARTYBOY GLENWOOD (D Ford) also shifted up the track carrying KERMADEC wider, causing KERMADEC and EYE SEE DOUBLE to lock wheels, in turn checking EYE SEE DOUBLE. Mr Castles was advised to take more care in future similar incidents.

Stewards inquired into the reasons EYE SEE DOUBLE being checked close to the finish line. After viewing the films and taking evidence from T Rattray (EYE SEE DOUBLE) and M Ford (VELOCITY STRIDE) . It was established that EYE SEE DOUBLE had a tendency to hang out and VELOCITY STRIDE which was making its run to the outside also had a tendency to hang in. Both drivers were of the opinion that their horses were tiring and were shifting ground as a result. Driver M Ford was reminded of his obligations when driving out in future similar situations.

RACE 1 – CAVALOR EQUINE 2YO COLTS & GELDINGS SWEEPSTAKES FINAL 1609 METRES

KARALTA ARTEMIS broke free of interference in the score up and will continue to be out of the mobile draw

BLINGS ON FIRE raced greenly during the event and eventually tired to be beaten in excess of 211 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities and has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

DUKES CHOICE was detained on course for 2.5 hours to enable blood samples to be obtained.

RACE 2 – CAVALOR EQUINE 2YO FILLIES SWEEPSTAKES FINAL 1609 METRES

Acting on a confirmed phone call from the trainer K Butler IDEN LADY LINCOLN was declared a Late Scratching at 1:30 pm owing to a suspected foot abscess. IDEN LADY LINCOLN has been stood down for a period of 28 days which may be reviewed pending receipt of a veterinary clearance.

SCARLETT PLACE underwent a pre-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

CEE TEE CHELSEA was out of position at the start and has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

AREYAWATCHINGTHIS was caught wide early before restraining to race at the rear of the field.

CHASIN FRANKIE was held up and unable to be fully tested.

Driver M Ford (IYLAC PAKARIA) was fined the sum of \$100 after pleading guilty to a charge under AHRR156(3). Particulars were that he removed his hand from a rein whilst engaging in a celebratory gesture.

RACE 3 – DAVID MEDHURST MEMORIAL PACE 2090 METRES

IFBUTZANDMAYBES showed gate speed to lead then surrendered the lead to VELOCITY STRIDE which made a move three wide to take over that position.

PROFICIENT NZ was caught wide early before being restrained to the rear of the field.

DAPPER NZ was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

SEAL THE DESTINY was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

MIDNIGHT CALM was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

ONE OFF NZ was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

RACE 4 – CAVALOR EQUINE 3YO SPRING CHAMPIONSHIP COLTS & GELDINGS 2090 METRES

MUCHO MOVER was out of position at the start. Driver T Rattray was reprimanded under AHRR162(1)(j) for failing to maintain his position until the start was effected.

ROCKNROLL WIZARD broke free of interference around the first turn and has been placed on his last chance to race truly.

ALL FOR DAVE hung in racing to the finish. A warning was issued.

Driver R Backhouse (MAYLEEJAE EAGLE) was advised to modify his whip action to ensure no future breaches of the whip rule.

RACE 5 - NUTRIEN TRAINER ENCOURAGEMENT SPRING SERIES FINAL 2090 METRES

BALDASARRE showed gate speed to lead the event before giving ground to be beaten in excess of 30 metres.

SWEET AMOUR was caught wide early before being restrained to the rear of the field.

HEZ A FAKE broke free of interference around the first turn and has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

STREZLECKI WATUSI worked forward three wide in the middle stages to race outside the leader.

IDEN BOUTIQUE worked forward three wide in the middle stages to take over the lead at the 1000 metre mark.

RACE 6 – TASMANIAN TROTTING CLUB METROPOLITAN CUP 2579 METRES

YOUNG ROOSTER was caught wide early before being restrained to the rear of the field.

EUREKA NZ gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 41 metres.

A warning was issued to AHA REACTION NZ which pulled hard during the event.

THE SHALLOWS was out of position at the start and has been placed on its last chance in the mobile draw.

Driver C Bell's foot momentarily slipped from footrest in the home straight before being immediately replaced.

IZAHA utilised the sprint lane to win the event.

RACE 7 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT FINAL 2090 METRES

Acting on a confirmed phone call from the trainer R Pullen MOST PERFECT MAJOR was declared a Late Scratching at 11:50 am owing to filling in a hind leg. MOST PERFECT MAJOR has been stood down for a period of 28 days which may be reviewed pending receipt of a veterinary clearance.

SOUTHSHORE NZ raced ungenerously in the score up

BRIDWOOD BELLA hung out in the score up inconveniencing IFITSTOBEITSUPTOME and has been placed on her last chance in the draw

LANCELOT was out of position at the start however due to having no horse ahead of this gelding no action was taken.

GORDIEVSKY LEIS showed gate speed to lead before surrendering that position to ALTA CASSINO NZ who worked around to the lead.

MOZASU NZ raced outside the leader early before obtaining a trail in the middle stages when JAWBREAKER worked forward three wide to take up that position.

FORGOT THE WALLET was held up and unable to be fully tested.

RACE 8 – PRYDES EASIFEED FINAL – 2090 METRES

STREETSIDE CLASSIC galloped out and has been placed out of the draw in future standing starts.

JACKSON NEPTUNE galloped out and has been placed out of the draw in future standing starts.

NO NUKES SKIPPER NZ broke shortly after the start and has been placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

SHARMEY galloped out and has been placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

BEAST MODE galloped out has been placed on its last chance in the standing start draw.

BEESEVENTEEN was slow to begin then was checked behind the galloping STREETSIDE CLASSIC

JACKSON NEPTUNE pulled hard during the event.

COOL SCOOTER NZ worked forward early to race outside the leader.

After beginning satisfactorily WHERE YA BIN NZ has been reinstated in the standing start draw.

Driver M Ford was advised to take more care when shifting horses wider in the future.

RACE 9 TASMANIAN EQUINE VETERINARY SERVICES FINAL 2090 METRES

CHEDDAR VALLEY NZ was caught wide early before restraining to the rear of the field and then gave ground to be beaten in excess of 36 metres.

KENYA NZ was caught wide early before working forward to race outside the leader.

HEZ RAZOR SHARP was held up early before utilising the sprint lane in the run to the finish.

THE DEMOCRAT pulled hard during the event.

DEADLY ASSASSIN was held up and unable to be fully tested.

BUSTER WILLIAM was out of position at the start. Driver K Williams was reprimanded under AHRR162(1)(h) for failing to come up into position at the start.

BETTER AMOUR was out of position at the start. Driver R Duggan was reprimanded under AHRR162(1)(j) for failing to maintain his position until the start was effected.

RACE 10 RACING CONNECT PACE 2090 METRES

DREAMS ARE BETTER was out of position at the start. After taking into account the mares recent race record she has been placed out of the mobile draw.

SHEZLIKEROYALTY raced ungenerously in the score up and broke just prior to the start. SHEZLIKEROYALTY has been placed out of the draw in future mobile starts.

After beginning satisfactorily SAFE UNDER FIRE has been reinstated in the mobile draw

COVERED KYLIE underwent a post-race veterinary after tiring to be beaten in excess of 136 metres. No abnormalities were detected and the mare has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

STUNIN MAGIC NZ tired to be beaten in excess of 75 metres and has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

MISS TYLER tired to be beaten in excess of 75 metres and has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

SAFE UNDER FIRE underwent a post-race veterinary after tiring to be beaten in excess of 136 metres. No abnormalities were detected and the mare has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

Driver C Castles was reprimanded under AHRR43A for failing to remain on course for 30 minutes after his last engagement.
