RACE 1 – LADBROKES SWITCH MAIDEN - (1350 METRES)

ANGELIC AMOUR – Jumped awkwardly and slow to begin.

BARBIE'S ACHEEVA – Raced three-wide throughout.

MACS RELAXED - Steadied off heels at the 200m.

SOROLI – Raced wide throughout.

FIGHTING GRACE – Brushed with SHE'S KAGEY on jumping.

MAARKLE – Over raced in the middle stages and laid in under pressure in the home straight. Rider D Tootell was reminded to exercise more care when shifting ground at around the 200m.

SHE'S KAGEY – Brushed with FIGHTING GRACE on jumping, over raced in the middle stages.

RACE 2 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT CLASS 1 HCP - (1350 METRES)

STARION – Shifted wider on the track shortly after the start.

TAPPA PASS – Near fore shoe replaced in mounting yard prior to the race, restrained shortly after the start off the heels of STARION which had shifted wider on the track, over raced in the early and middle stages.

RACE 3 – IN SERIES ELECTRICAL + SOLAR MAIDEN - (1150 METRES)

The all clear in this event was delayed when trainer B Baker (BELPINE MISS) requested to view the official photo finish in relation to the placings. After viewing the official photo finish Mr Baker was satisfied with the placings and correct weight was then given on the judge's numbers.

LACERATE – Raced three-wide throughout.

MAKIN' A MINT – Slow to begin. Rider J Maskiell reported that something was amiss with the gelding's action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Stewards advised trainers stable foremen Mr S Brazendale that the gelding must complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again.

BELLA AQUILA – Slow to begin.

GEEGEES MISTY – Checked over the heels of BELPINE MISS when shifting wider to improve.

RACE 4 – LEIGH JORDAN ONE AGENCY COLLINS REAL ESTATE BM76 HCP - (1150 METRES)

ALPINE WOLF – Shifted in between the 150m and 100m. Rider D Ganderton was reminded to exercise more care when shifting ground inwards. Rider D Ganderton was also reminded of his obligation to ensure he rides his mounts out fully to the line. Trainer B Campbell advised that the gelding would be freshened up and go for a spell.

VIVILICI – Laid in and brushed with ASPIRATE then continued to shift in and as a result S Carr (ASPIRATE) had to check her mount.

ASPIRATE – Checked when tightened for room at the 100m.

LE CADEAU – Shifted out in the home straight.

RACE 5 - WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS BM60 HCP - (1150 METRES)

BORDER PROTECTION – Raced three-wide throughout.

SCHAUFFELE – Shifted out upon jumping and bumped heavily with GEE GEE ROYBOY. Near 200m shifted in and bumped with BORDER PROTECTION.

DUSTY JOE – Jumped very awkwardly and was slow to begin.

LORD WHITEGATE – Over raced in the middle stages. Stewards questioned rider I Toker in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Mr Toker stated that at as a result of the gelding over racing, when he placed his mount under pressure it failed to respond to his riding.

GEE GEE ROYBOY – Shifted in upon jumping and bumped heavily with SCHAUFFELE.

RACE 6 - GOODSTONE GROUP CLASS 1 HCP - (1009 METRES)

BOLD INSTINCT – Shifted in upon jumping and bumped with DEHERE THE WORD, over raced in the early and middle stages, raced three-wide throughout, laid in over the concluding stages.

DEHERE THE WORD – Bumped with BOLD INSTINCT when that gelding shifted in upon jumping.

RACE 7 - KEVIN SHARKIE CLASS 3 HCP - (1350 METRES)

Correct weight was delayed in this event for stewards and the official starter to review the start. After viewing correct weight was declared on the judge's numbers.

THOUGHTS'N'PRAYERS – Shifted out at the 200m at the same time SQUARE DONUT shifted in, as a result the two horses bumped heavily.

SQUARE DONUT – Held up for clear running on the home turn, shifted in at the 200m at the same time THOUGHTS'N'PRAYERS shifted out, as a result the two horses bumped heavily.

GEE GEE BAY WATCH – Declared a late scratching at 3.53pm on veterinary advice after the gelding reared and became cast in the barrier. All monies invested on the gelding were ordered to be refunded in full with, the following deductions;

1ST SQUARE DONUT 18c win 18c place 2nd HERO OF ROMANI 19c place No third dividend

GEE GEE BAYWATCH underwent a post-race veterinary examination was found to be lame in the near foreleg. GEE GEE BAYWATCH has been stood down from trialling and racing until a veterinary certificate of soundness.

BLUSHED – Stewards questioned rider T Baker in relation to the below market performance of the mare. Mr Baker stated that when he placed the mare under pressure it failed to respond to his riding. Trainer B Campbell advised stewards that the mare would now be freshened up and would be spelled for a short period.

NEEDAREIN – Inconvenienced and clipped heels when SO I'M DREAMING shifted in upon jumping.

SO I'M DREAMING – Upon the removal of the blindfold, the gelding struck the barrier gates, bounded and jumped awkwardly unbalancing the rider and as a result the gelding shifted in abruptly.

MALEVOLENT – Shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.
