STARTER: A EMERY

RACE 1 – CROWN LAGER TWO YEAR OLD – 1680 METRES

IMHOOKED was caught wide early before restraining to the rear of the field.

TRIEDTOTELLYA was restrained after the start.

PROMISE STRIDE was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

PROMISE STRIDE gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 45 metres.

MAJOR IDEAL tired over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 65 metres and has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

After beginning satisfactorily PROMISE STRIDE has been reinstated in the mobile draw.

RACE 2 – LAUNCESTON VETERINARY GROUP STAKES – 2200 METRES

ENDEAVOUR STRIDE showed gate speed to lead then proceeded to pull hard during the event. Racing down the back straight the final time, shifted out when Driver M Ford was activating gear affording an inside run to the following runner. M Ford was advised to take more care in similar situations.

BELIEVE IN FOREVER was inconvenienced behind a tiring runner.

A warning was issued to CASTLE RETREAT which hung in and contacted a marker peg.

EQUITY STRIDE raced outside the leader and pulled hard before tiring to be beaten in excess of 51 metres. The gelding has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

CASTLE RETREAT was inconvenienced behind a tiring runner.

MONTANA FLASH obtained an inside run in the back straight when the leader (ENDEAVOUR STRIDE) shifted up the track.

KOHANAH tired over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 57 metres and has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

Trainer B Yole was spoken to about the race manners of both ENDEAVOUR STRIDE and EQUITY STRIDE which both pulled hard during the event. Mr Yole advised that he would be making some adjustments to the gear used on these horses to prevent any further occurrences.

Stewards spoke to drivers M Ford and S Edyvean regarding the lack of control when driving horses that were inclined to pull. Both drivers were advised to modify their driving style in future.

RACE 3 – ELDELSLIE HORSE CARE PACE – 2200 METRES

WITH REVENGE NZ was caught wide early before working around the field to race outside the leader.

QUEENOFDANCE NZ was restrained after the start.

LALIBELA NZ contacted several marker pegs around the 800 metre turn when racing in restricted room.

LALIBELA NZ was held up and unable to be fully tested.

JANJUC underwent a post-race veterinary examination after being beaten in excess of 224 metres which revealed that the mare had suffered an atrial fibrillation for the second occasion. JANJUC has been stood down for a period of 28 days and until the receipt of a veterinary clearance inclusive of an ECG, and until the completion of two satisfactory trials.

RACE 4 – BEVAN LEE'S BUTCHERY STAKES – 2200 METRES

A warning was issued DRAGON BLOOD which hung out and raced roughly shortly after the start.

A warning was issued to STREZLECKI WATUSI who had a tendency to hang out in the straight with 1100 metres to run.

Driver M Howlett, (GALAXY DANCER) was reminded of his obligations when attempting to improve into a run that wasn't fully developed after attempting to gain an inside run in the home straight and contacting a number of marker pegs.

Driver C Castles (CZARINA) was fined the sum of \$100 after pleading guilty to a charge under AHRR168(1)(a). Particulars were that he allowed his mare to contact the rear of GALAXY DANCER ultimately flattening its tyre.

DRAGON BLOOD underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 64 metres. No abnormalities were detected and the gelding has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

RACE 5 – TRAINERS ENCOURAGEMENT PACE – 2200 METRES

SPORTS ILLUSTRATOR was tightened and contacted a marker peg around the first turn.

A warning was issued to AUNTY BESSY which raced roughly shortly after the start.

IM ROCK SOLID worked forward three wide to race outside the leader.

SPORTS ILLUSTRATOR was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

Driver S Davis (MAJOR DAVVIN) was advised to further modify his actions when driving his horses out in the run to the finish.

RACE 6 – IMPRESS PRINT PACE – 2200 METRES

Shortly after the start KIAVINO STRIDE hung in and locked wheels with SOMEDAN causing both horses to lose ground and take no competitive part in the event. . A warning was issued on the race manners of KIAVINO STRIDE

GORDIEVSKY LEIS was caught wide early before working around the field to race outside the leader and then gaining cover when EMJAYS BLACK CHIP worked around to take over that position.

Driver K Williams (EMJAYS BLACK CHIP) was cautioned for the shifting ground when taking over the position outside the leader

GORDIEVSKY LEIS (\$4.80 fav) underwent a post-race veterinary examination after giving ground to be beaten in excess of 41 metres. No abnormalities were detected

RACE 7 – FAITHFUL PARK STUD STAKES – 2200 METRES

After beginning satisfactorily LEFT A HURRIKANE has been reinstated in the mobile draw.

FOREGONE CONCLUSION NZ was caught wide early before restraining to the rear of the field.

MAYS PLACE was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

MOZASU NZ gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 35 metres.

VIGOROSO NZ was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

LEFT A HURRIKANE tired over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 50 metres. After taking into account that the gelding was having his first start for 11 months Stewards stood the gelding down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

RACE 8 – ELDERS INSURANCE LAUNCESTON STAKES – 1680 METRES

SPRING QUEEN underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 137 metres. No abnormalities were detected. Acting on her recent race record the mare has been stood down for 14 days and until the completion of two satisfactory trials.

CINOCAL JAMANE was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

CHRISTIAN JAZ NZ pulled hard during the event.

RACE 9 – DAKIN REFRIGERATION PACE – 2200 METRES

VIVID STRIDE underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to race.

OZZIE MAJOR broke its near side hopple connector strap racing down the back straight the first time and broke before being retired from the event. Stewards inspected the gear worn by the gelding and found it to be in satisfactory condition.

HEZA RUMMAGE NZ worked forward three wide to race outside the leader

WRITTEN IN SILK was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

MISTA EAGLE was held up and unable to be fully tested.

RACE 10 – RARE EARTH FREE FOR ALL – 2200 METRES

DEADLY ASSASSIN underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 57 metres. No abnormalities were detected and the gelding has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

ROCK ON PLAYBOY tired to be beaten in excess of 50 metres and has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.
