Trainers A Roach and N Schuurung were reprimanded under the provisions of AR65(1) for failing to produce the horse identification certificates for horses engaged at today's meeting.

RACE 1 – LEAPING GOAT COFFEE BM76 HCP - (1150 METRES)

BANDINELLI – Raced fiercely approaching the 600 metres.

MISS TUPPENCE –Slow to muster early speed and raced ungenerously approaching the 600 metres.

ARGYLE BEACH –Raced three wide in the early stages. Rider T Johnstone reported that the gelding failed to handle the fast pace.

RACE 2 – KEVIN SHARKIE MAIDEN - (1009 METRES)

There was a delay on correct weight for the connections of BELPINE MISS to review the start with a view that the mare had been denied a fair start. After viewing the official patrol films and speaking with the official starter, stewards declared the mare a non-runner as a result of being held by the barrier attendant when the gates opened.

STEEL MIST – Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination as the gelding had not started in a race for in excess of 12 months. And was passed fit to take its place in the field.

WARICA – Caught wide throughout, shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

WHEELING – Raced three wide throughout.

BE KINDER – Shifted out abruptly entering the home straight.

BELPINE MISS – Declared a non-runner after becoming fractious in the barriers and then being held at the start. Stewards ordered all bets to be refunded in full with the following deductions ordered:

1 st Gallant Warriors	15c Win and 16c Place
2 nd Warica	7c Place
3 rd Steel Mist	22c Place

BLOW UP –Bumped heavily with GALLANT WARRIORS on jumping.

MISS RED – Miss Red jumped awkwardly. Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination as the mare had not started in a race for in excess of 12 months. And was passed fit to take its place in the field.

SELKIE – Stewards queried the below market performance of the mare, Rider B Muhcu stated the mare failed to respond when placed under pressure and that she resented the kick back. A post race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

GALLANT WARRIORS –Jumped very awkwardly at the start and bumped with BLOW UP and knuckled, raced greenly throughout.

SHE'S BLUFFING –Threw its head in the air on jumping and bumped with SELKIE. Carried wider approaching the 600 metres when STEEL MIST shifted out.

RACE 3 – GOODSTONE GROUP MAIDEN – (1350 METRES)

HAMPTON BAY –Raced wide throughout.

UPWARD AND ONWARD – Raced in restricted room approaching the 600 metres, raced greenly throughout.

AHZEEZAH – Connections advised that it was their intentions to have the mare ridden more conservatively from the wide barrier draw. The mare was ridden accordingly.

FIGHTING GRACE –

SKY BRIDGE –Raced wide throughout.

TENNESSEE BEACH – Raced three wide throughout. Shifted out under pressure in the home straight and crossed ALPINE ASSAULT when not fully clear. Rider C Jordan was issued with a reprimand under the provisions of AR 131(a) for careless riding.

DEANNE'S WISH –Hung in home straight.

GREYLING –Slow to begin.

RACE 4 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT MDN/CL1 – (1880 METRES)

FIFE AND DRUM –Shifted out shortly after the start tightening PAGE out onto MADAME BENEDICT. Rider D Ganderton was advised to exercise care when allowing his mount to shift ground. When questioned on the below market expectations performance rider D Ganderton stated that it was a disappointing run and he believes the gelding may have come to the end of its preparation.

ANGELIC AMOUR – Pulled hard in the early and middle stages.

PAGE –Tightened shortly after the start.

REAL MONSTER –

SPEED ROCK – Shifted out near the 150 metres and carried PAGE wider on the track. M Ulucinar was advised to exercise care. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

GAYNIK –Over raced in the early stages.

MADAME BENEDICT –Tightened shortly after the start.

RACE 5 – LADBROKES LIVE BETTING CLASS 1 HCP – (1150 METRES)

POWER MAGNUM – Over raced early and middle stages of the race.

FEISTY LION – Restrained off heels of ROCK'EM BABY near 600 metres when making the turn awkward.

OXY DREAM – Raced keenly in the middle stages.

DEHERE THE WORD – Hung in from the 300 metres, raced wide throughout.

HAS THE LOOK – Made the 600 metre turn awkwardly. Rider C Baker reported her mount laid out throughout.

MAGIC TYPHOON – Bounded on jumping and lost some ground and then commenced to over race in the back straight.

STATUE OF DREAMS – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 6 – THAI IMPERIAL CLASS 1 HCP - (1350 METRES)

NEEDS TO BELONG – Shifted wider in the home straight to obtain a clear run.

OLYMPIC HONOUR – Hung in throughout and shifted in near the 200 metres and tightened the running of BAHEERA. Rider M Ulucinar was issued with a severe reprimand under the provisions of AR 131(a) Careless Riding for allowing his mount to shift ground at this point. In not taking more severe action the racing manners of OLYMPIC HONOUR were taken into account.

CYCLONE LOUIE – Raced wide throughout.

MAARKLE – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

BAHEERA – Tightened and lost its position near the 200 metres and then held up for some distance behind PROPHET EYES.

KING ISLAND – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 7 – FIGHT MND BM68 HCP - (1350 METRES)

ANCONA – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

ASPIRATE – Rider A Darmanin pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR131(b) for failing to ride his mount out to the finish line. Rider A Darmanin was fined \$100. A post race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

LESNAR – Raced three wide throughout.

MULTISANTI – Raced ungenerously in the early and middle stage.

SCHAUFFELE – Raced three wide throughout.

RACE 8 – DEAN RAWLINGS SENIOR MEMORIAL BM68 HCP (1880 METRES)

PERUN (NZ) – Restrained off heels at about the 1600 metres when MAINCOURT shifted wider, raced wide throughout.

MAINCOURT – Shifted out on jumping bumping with HIGH MAINTENANCE, shifted wider near the 1600 metres to obtain clear running.

TURK DELIGHT – Raced wide throughout.

HIGH MAINTENANCE – Carried out at the start when bumping with MAINCOURT. Tightened and lost position near the 400 meters when THE EXECUTIVE was carried in by MAINCOURT which laid in.

RACE 9 – CARLTON DRAUGHT BM60 HCP - (1650 METRES)

DUSTY JOE – Fractious in barriers prior to start.

BELL RINGER BOY – Inconvenienced shortly after the start when ISKRA shifted in.

SECRETLY AWESOME – Over raced early and middle stages of the race. Shifted in near the 1400 metres when insufficiently clear of ISKRA. Rider S Carr was reprimanded under the provisions of AR 131(a) for careless riding.

GEE GEE SILENTNITE – Bounded on jumping.

ISKRA –Restrained near the 1400 metres.

SUBMIT ANOTHER – Raced wide throughout.
