Comments / Explanations:**RACE 1 – FRIDAY NIGHT RACING 21ST OCTOBER MAIDEN (1) 1200 METRES)**

LONDIANI – Tightened for room at the start by GOES LIKE THE WIND which had been carried in by SHE'S KAGEY.

SWINGAPINGA – Jumped awkwardly and struck the outside barrier gate, raced wide throughout.

BELPINE MISS – Slow to begin. Checked at the 1000m when GOES LIKE THE WIND shifted in when not clear.

GOES LIKE THE WIND – Carried in at the start by SHE'S KAGEY, over raced in the early stages, shifted in near the 1000m. At a subsequent inquiry rider R Tan was reprimanded under the provisions AR131(a) careless riding for allowing his mount to shift in at about the 1000 metres when not fully clear, resulting in BELPINE MISS being checked. In assessing penalty stewards took into account the manners of both horses, in particular GOES LIKE THE WIND over racing.

PRINCESS MATOAKA – Raced wide throughout.

SHE'S KAGEY – Shifted in on jumping bumping with GOES LIKE THE WIND. Laid in over the concluding stages.

SIRENE'S LILY – Jumped awkwardly shifted in and bumped with PIIINK BEAUTY.

STATUE OF DREAMS – Jumped awkwardly.

OUR INDULGENCE – Over raced in the early stages.

PIIINK BEAUTY – Bumped with SIRENE'S LILY on jumping.

ANGELI – Steadied off heels near the 800 metres.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES MAIDEN (2) 3YO & UP (1200 METRES)

AUSSIE BLACK – Over raced passing the 800 metres.

WHEELING – Raced wide throughout.

LORI LEE – Raced fiercely, shifted in abruptly and struck the rail at about the 750 metres dislodging rider I Toker. After examination by the medical attendants, rider I Toker was passed fit to ride. LORI LEE has been stood down from racing until the mare trials to the satisfaction of the stewards.

MILLA'S READY – Slow to begin, carried wider by the riderless horse from the 500 metres.

OLE OLA – Held up for a clear run near the 120 metres.

ROSE DE LUNE – Shortly after the start rider K Quilty was dislodged from her mount when her mount attempted to buck and shifted in abruptly. After examination by the on course doctor and Medical Edge staff rider K Quilty was passed fit to fulfill her riding engagements. The mare will be stood down from racing until it trials to the satisfaction of the stewards.

BORN A WINNER – Raced wide throughout.

PINANDI – Raced wide throughout.

BE KINDER – Tired in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare had suffered Atrial Fibrillation. Stewards have directed that BE KINDER must complete a 1000 metre gallop and have a veterinary clearance with the result of an ECG before trialling or racing again.

RACE 3 – STEVE'S LIQUOR MAIDEN 3YO & UP – (1400 METRES)

DUNCANNON – Shifted in on jumping and struck the inside barrier gate.

EAGLE STREET – Shifted in abruptly on jumping bumping with FALCULA.

MACS RELAXED – Held up in the home straight.

NO ACCESS – Caught wide throughout, over raced in the middle stages.

PREWINGO – Over raced making the 1200 metres turn.

FALCULA – Bumped heavily by EAGLE STREET on jumping and lost its position. Steadied off the heels of SHE'S BLUFFING near the 800 meters. Rider accidentally dropped her offside rein near the 300 metres.

ST REGIS (NZ) – Difficult to load

GEEGEES SUNSHINE – Raced three wide.

BUEL – Raced wide throughout, rider C Jordan reported that the gelding failed to respond to her riding in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

RACE 4 – SHOW DAY THURSDAY - 0-62 – (1400 METRES)

IVORYMAN (NZ) – Connections advised that the gelding would be ridden handy and further forward, circumstances permitting. Tactics were adopted.

SPIRITED TOFF – Fractious in the barriers, underwent a veterinary examination and was passed fit to compete. A warning has been placed on the barrier manners of the gelding.

STARION – Rider A Darmanin when questioned on the below market performance of the gelding he stated that after starting from a wide barrier he raced further back than anticipated. And due to the quick pace set in the race the gelding failed to respond to his riding, when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Rider A Darmanin was advised of his obligation to report anything that may affect the performance of his mounts in future.

BETHPAGE – Rider reported there were respiratory noises made in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 5 – PHIL HUGHES OFFICE SOLUTIONS BM68 – (1400 METRES)

FREELANCER – Held up on the home turn and entering the home straight behind HERO OF ROMANI.

SO ASTOUNDING – Caught wide throughout.

WILLBY RULES – Fractious prior to the start.

ALPINE BLAST – Held up momentarily entering the home straight.

RACE 6 – BOOK YOUR XMAS FUNCTION NOW BM68 HCP - (1100 METRES)

MICHBAR – Blundered on jumping and then bumped with GEE GEE TRUE STORY.

GEE GEE TRUE STORY – Bumped on jumping with MICHBAR.

LUCKY BUCKY – Bumped with COPPER CHARM at the start.

ARTUSO – Jumped awkwardly.

GEE GEE LANETT – Bumped with

SPARKLING ONE – Raced wide throughout.

VETLANDA – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin.

COPPER CHARM – Bumped with LUCKY BUCKY at the start, over raced in the early and middle stages.

RACE 7 – JACKSON SECURITY – 0-62 - (1200 METRES)

Correct weight was delayed for the connections of GEE GEE RHYTHM to review the start with a view that the mare had been denied a fair start. After viewing the official patrol films and speaking with the official starter, stewards declared the mare a non-runner as a result of the blindfold being removed after the barrier gates opened.

GEE GEE ALS PRINCE – Slow to begin.

NEV'S BOY – Crowded on jumping when SHAKE YOUR TOOSHY shifted outwards.

SHAKE YOUR TOOSHY – Shifted out on jumping, rider C Baker reported the mare laid out throughout.

GEE GEE ROYBOY – Crowded at the start when NEV'S BOY was carried outward.

GEE GEE RHYTHM – Stewards declared the mare a non-runner as it had been denied a fair start when the blindfold was removed after the gates opened and the mare was slow to begin. Stewards ordered all bets to refunded in full with the following deductions.

**RACE 8 – MELBOURNE CUP LUNCHEON @ SPORTIES HOTEL CLASS 1
HANDICAP - (1200 METRES)**

LASTAR – Shifted in under pressure for the entire home straight.

FEISTY LION – Blundered on jumping.

FIGHTING STYX – Raced three wide throughout.

SHAMZOU – Stewards granted permission for rider B Neto to ride 1kg over the allotted minimum weight.

MAGIC TYPHOON – Stewards granted permission for rider L Riordan to ride 1kg over the allotted minimum weight.

GENERAL:

TASMANIAN RACING CLUB - 28/11/2021

Licensed stable hand Max Beamish pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR 228(b) Improper conduct in that he struck a horse with a fist to the head when attempting to load it onto the float. After taking into consideration his length of time in the industry, good record and guilty plea he was fined the sum of \$500. Of which \$250 was fully suspended for 2 years on condition that he does not reoffend.

RACE 3 – LADBROKES EASY FORM MAIDEN - (1350 METRES)

Rider I Toker was reprimanded under the provisions of AR114(2)(a) in that he failed to report a condition that may have affected the performance of DUNCANNON. Stewards were satisfied that this accounted for I Toker not riding his mount fully over the last 100 metres.
