Comments / Explanations:

Apprentice C Wells was indisposed for this meeting and will be required to provide a medical clearance prior to riding again.

RACE 1 – MARGOT SMART MAIDEN (1200 METRES)

NEFARIOUS – Bumped with WADDY WADDY at the start, over raced early stages, steadied off heels approaching the 900 metres.

POET WARRIOR – Jumped very awkwardly and slow to begin.

CHEEKY WORD – Failed to respond over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

MISS RED – Over raced in the early stages and held up for a clear run on the home turn.

SMASHING HIT – Threw its head in the air on jumping and lost considerable ground.

SOULITA – Slow to muster early speed.

WADDY WADDY – Bumped by Poet Warrior on jumping.

SPECIAL INTEREST – Jumped awkwardly.

WHEELING – Queried on the improved performance. Trainer G McCulloch stated that the previous performance had been promising. Also the addition of blinkers today and the utilisation of a claiming apprentice had contributed to the improvement.

RACE 2 – PAUL & ELIZABETH GEARD MAIDEN/CLASS 1 (1600 METRES)

BAHEERA – Disappointed for a clear run near the 100 metres.

UPWARD AND ONWARD – Steadied off heels near the 1300 metres. Hung out throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

MADAME BENEDICT – Slow to begin.

BELLA AQUILA – Slow to begin. Tired over the concluding stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed a poor recovery rate.

RACE 3 – LADBROKES 3YO MAIDEN – (1100 METRES)

ADA WAY – Laid in, in the home straight.

BOKEO – Shifted out near the 400 metres when not fully clear of OUR INDULGENCE which had to be steadied by its rider. A Darmanin was issued with a reprimand under AR 131(a) for careless riding.

DEVIL SUN – Tightened momentarily after the start when Ding Ding crossed. Tightened at the 850 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a superficial wound to the off-hind fetlock. Trainer S Carr was advised veterinary certificate of soundness will be required prior to trialling or racing again.

GEEGEE'S BIG BIRD – Tightened, blundered and lost its position near the 850 metres when OUR INDULGENCE carried LITTLE LIONEL in onto DEVIL SUN

LITTLE LIONEL – Jumped awkwardly.

OUR INDULGENCE – Laid in making the 800 metre turn despite the efforts of the rider. Hampered on the home turn when Bokeo shifted out.

ZULU GURU – Slow to begin.

RACE 4 – BELLO BEAU CLASS 1 HANDICAP – (1400 METRES)

NOZTRABEEL – Shifted out on jumping

LAUNNIE NIGHTS – Steadied near the 800 metres to obtain a more favourable position behind the race favourite.

MAARKLE – Jumped awkwardly

SAXON MIST – Became fractious in the barriers and was withdrawn from the gates before being passed fit to compete by the veterinary surgeon. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities.

DEHERE THE WORD – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 5 – MYSTIC JOURNEY CLASS 3 HANDICAP – (1200 METRES)

GEE GEES SO TRUE – Held up behind POWER MAGNUM approaching the winning post.

MCSWEYN – Jumped outwards at the start.

OUTBOUND – B McCoull was reminded of his obligation to ride his mount out fully to the finish.

POWER MAGNUM – Jumped very awkwardly.

WE DESERVE THIS – Rider queried on poor performance, failed to respond from the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed sores on the withers. A veterinary certificate of soundness will be required prior to trialling or racing again.

GEE GEE ALS PRINCE – Tightened at the start and raced wide throughout.

HOT RELATION – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 6 – STILL A STAR OPEN HANDICAP - (1100 METRES)

GEE GEE SECONDOVER – Shifted out near the 150 metres hampering LIFFEYBEAU. T Johnstone was issued with a reprimand under AR 131(a) for careless riding.

LIFFEYBEAU – Hampered near the 150 metres when GEE GEE SECONDOVER shifted out when not fully clear.

MISS TUPPENCE – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin.

GEE GEE LANETT – Laid out in the home straight.

RACE 7 – BEAT THE SHARK BM60 HANDICAP - (1600 METRES)

BANCA NIP – Hampered on jumping when GEE GEE ENUF SPEED shifted in.

BELL RINGER BOY – Slow to begin.

CAPTAIN DAVE – Raced wide from the 900 meters.

ZOUSTORM – Jumped awkwardly.

RACE 8 – ALPINE WOLF BM68 HANDICAP - (2100 METRES)

POLITICAL – Lost the off fore plate shortly after the start. Over raced in the early and middle stages. Laid out near the 200 metres and bumped

THE EXECUTIVE – Blundered on jumping. Over raced in the early stages.

TURK DELIGHT – Tired over the concluding stages. I Toker stated that gelding failed to respond to his riding from the 400 metres and he felt there may have been something amiss. A post-race veterinary inspection revealed no obvious abnormalities.

DARGO – Race three wide in the early and middle stages before progressing to a forward position.
