Comments / Explanations:

All races rescheduled back one race after Race 1 due to a member of the public requiring medical assistance from the on course doctor and medical staff.

SUPPLIMENTARY:

TASMANIAN TURF CLUB 23rd NOVEMBER, 2022

Race 1 – JACKSONS SECURITY TASMANIAN NEWMARKET 30TH NOV MAIDEN (1100)

Stewards concluded an inquiry with rider D. Pires (FEAR THE STING) in relation to the riding tactics adopted in the home straight and over the concluding stages. Stewards accepted the explanation tendered from rider D Pires in relation to the horse's racing manners when shifting in abruptly at the 200 metres unbalancing him and then shifting out under pressure placing him at a disadvantage in gathering his reins.

RACE 1 – CRESSY CHAFF CUTTERS LONGFORD CUP NEW YEARS DAY MAIDEN - (1200 METRES)

There was a delay to correct weight as Rider T Baker wished to view the official patrol films of the home straight. After doing so he was satisfied, and correct weight declared on the judges numbers.

BLONDE SUSPECT – Over raced in the early stages, steadied off the heels of ROSE DE LUNE at the 850 metres.

ROHZHAE – Raced wide throughout.

THE FINAL SEAL – Slow to begin.

ADA WAY – Laid in near the 200 metres and brushed with SNOWBIRD.

DAKOTA PARK – Declared a late scratching at 5.29pm on veterinary advice after becoming cast in the barriers. A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the right hind. Trainer A Trinder was advised a satisfactory trial and veterinary clearance must be completed prior to racing again. Stewards ordered that the following deductions apply to all winning bets prior to 5.29pm.

DEDUCTIONS

1ST – SNOWBIRD	14 cents Win – 19 cents place
2ND – EGAO	14 cents place
3RD – ADA WAY	10 cents place

CLOVER HILL- Delayed the start due to it backing out of the barriers and having to be re-loaded. Steadied off the heels of SNOWBIRD at the start.

ROSE DE LUNE – Restrained off heels at about the 850 metres when ADA WAY crossed when not fully clear. Stewards advised rider T. BAKER to exercise care and ensure he is fully clear when crossing. A post race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame on both forelegs. Trainer J Luttrell was advised that he must submit a veterinary clearance prior to the mare racing again.

MONTE FLEUR – Slow to begin, raced wide to about the 1100 metres.

SNOWBIRD – Brushed with ADA WAY at the 200 metres and shifted out under pressure near the 100 metres. Rider M Ulucinar reported that the filly raced greenly throughout.

RACE 2 – LADBROKE IT! MAIDEN - (1400 METRES)-

AUSSIE BLACK – Raced wide throughout.

CHARLIE BUCKET – Bumped heavily by MADJACK at the start and became unbalanced.

JACKJACK – Bumped with CHARLIE BUCKET at the start, laid in entering the home straight.

ROCKIERRO – Raced wide throughout.

SUSHI EXPRESS – Steadied at the 1200 metres and commenced to over-race, restrained off heels of UPPERCUTS at the 400 metres.

ARTFUL PEGASUS – Shifted in on jumping and raced three wide throughout.

MADJACK – Jumped awkwardly, shifted out making contact with the hind quarters of CHARLIE BUCKET and was checked.

AHZEEZAH – Tightened at the start between MYOCARDIUM which had jumped inwards and UPPERCUTS which had shifted out on jumping.

UPPERCUTS – Shifted out on jumping, bumping with AHZEEZAH. Rider D Pires reported his mount began to tire from the 700 metres. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

ZOU ZOU ZOU – Over raced early stages. Trainer B McShane advised a change of tactics and it was their intentions to race further forward circumstances permitting. Tactics adopted.

MYOCARDIUM – Checked at the start when it jumped inwards and bumped heavily with AHZEEZAH and was carried out onto the heels of ARTFUL PEGASUS. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

RACE 3 – LAFM AFLA BOWL 2YO – (1100 METRES)

ENCOUNTER SPHERE – Laid in under pressure from the 100 metres.

THOROS OF MYR – Bumped with GEEGEEHAILSTORM at the start. Hung out from the home turn and a post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

CAIRNS – Rider A Darmanin on returning to scale advised stewards that his saddle had slipped at the start of the race.

GEE GEE TYCOON – Bumped with GEEGEEHAILSTORM at the start. Raced greenly throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

GEEGEEHAILSTORM – Jumped awkwardly and was then tightened for room between GEE GEE TYCOON and THOROS OF MYR. Rider G. Catania reported her mount travelled greenly thereafter. A post-race veterinary examination revealed an elevated heart rate.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES MEGA MULTI MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – (2100 METRES)

HAMPTON BAY – Shifted out on jumping carrying CASHMORE wider.

NOZTRABEEL – Trainer B McShane advised a change of tactics to be adopted circumstances permitting that it was their intentions to ride the gelding further forward. Shifted in on jumping bumping with WANING WEASEL, then shortly after bumped with GAYNIK. Tired from the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities. Unable to adopt tactics

OLYMPIC HONOUR – Caught wide in the early stages. Rider T. Johnson reported her mount laid in throughout.

POET WARRIOR – Bumped heavily with HATHAWAY on jumping and then checked off heels of RUSTIC CHARM shortly after. Raced ungenerously when steadying off heels of RUSTIC CHARM passing the 1900 metres. Held up on the home turn and laid in passing the 150 metres.

AMERICAN JEWEL – Trainer B McShane advised a change of tactics to be adopted circumstances permitting that it was their intentions to ride the gelding further forward. Restrained off heels of PREWINGAO shortly after the start. Unable to adopt change of tactics.

CASHMORE – Carried out on jumping by HAMPTON BAY and bumped with AMERICAN JEWEL and then commenced to over race.

GAYNIK – Bumped on jumping with NOZTRABEEL which shifted in.

SMASHING HIT – Trainer D Keating advised a change of tactics to be adopted and circumstances permitting it was their intentions to ride the mare further forward. Tactics adopted. Trainer advised the mare would now be retired.

WANING WEASEL – Checked off the heels of NOZTRABEEL at the start.

HATHAWAY – Bumped heavily with POET WARRIOR at the start.

RACE 5 – LADBROKES LAUNCESTON CUP 22ND FEBRUARY BM62 HCP – (1200 METRES)

SQUARE DONUT – Travelled three wide throughout.

LADY JOKEY – Slow to begin.

THE MASTER SPEED – Jumped awkwardly brushing with BELMISTA.

BELMISTA – Brushed with THE MASTER SPEED shortly after jumping.

RACE 6 – STEVE’S LIQUOR 3YO TROPHY - (1400 METRES)

BOKEO – Shifted out on jumping tightening JAGUAR STONE and raced three wide throughout.

CORNELIAN BAY – Required replating on the near fore pre-race, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to race.

HAPPY CLAN – Bumped with SHARMA’S LAST at the start.

CLOUDY NIGHTS – Raced ungenerously in the early stages and was tightened making the turn at the 1200 metres when ALVARINHO shifted in marginally as PIINK BEAUTY was racing tightly to its outside.

ALVARINHO – Jumped awkwardly and was tightened momentarily about the 1200 metres by PIINK BEAUTY. Held up on the home turn behind PIINK BEAUTY and then again entering the home straight. Rolled out at the 400 metres momentarily inconveniencing CLOUDY NIGHTS.

JAGUAR STONE – Tightened on jumping.

PIINK BEAUTY – Was tightened after jumping and shifted in onto ALVARINHO at around the 1200 metres, rider C. Jordan was advised to exercise more care.

RACE 7 – RAYNER TRANSPORT CONQUERING STAKES - (1400 METRES)

THE INEVITABLE – Shifted in on jumping hampering AND BEYOND, laid in under pressure in the home straight, rider D Pires had to stop riding and straighten his mount approaching the 100 metres.

FIRST ACCUSED – Shifted out on jumping hampering AND BEYOND.

ALPINE WOLF – Threw its head in the air on jumping and restrained off the heels of VALLABAR which had shifted in marginally.

SWOOP DOG – Over raced in the middle stages.

VALLABAR – Raced three wide throughout.

AND BEYOND – Lost its position at the start when FIRST ACCUSED jumped outwards resulting in the gelding being restrained off the heels of THE INEVITABLE.

DARK WANDERER – Momentarily steadied at about the 1200 metres off the heels of REBEL FACTOR and commenced to over race.

REBEL FACTOR – Rider B McCoull was advised to exercise care when attempting to sit outside the leader near the 1200 metres after crossing DARK WANDERER when not fully clear.

RACE 8 – LADBROKES SAME RACE MULTI CLASS 3 HCP – (1400 METRES)

There was a delay to correct weight for trainer G Stevenson and rider C Jordan to view the official patrol films at the start. After viewing correct weight was declared on the judges' numbers.

KAYTEE VALIENTE – Shifted in abruptly when attempting to slot in approaching the 800 metres.

MELITON – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin.

SPIRITED TOFF – Began awkwardly.

MOSHAMA – Brushed the side of the barriers on jumping.

RACE 9 – SPORTIES HOTEL CUP EVE CALCUTTA BM68 HCP – (1600 METRES)

SUPER SWOOP- Had to be steadied near the 1400 metres and raced tightly

PAGE – Tightened on jumping and lost its position when NAMABAALÉ shifted out and RODRICK'S SECRET shifted in.

I'M SO COOL – Checked off heels approaching the 200 metres.

NAMABAALÉ – Shifted out on jumping.

RODRICK'S SECRET – Shifted in on jumping and travelled three wide throughout.

THE DECIDER – Declared a late scratching at 6.06pm when the gelding was unable to be loaded onto the float. Stewards ordered that the following deductions apply to all winning bets prior to 6.06pm.

DEDUCTIONS

1ST – NAMABAALÉ	7 cents Win – 7 cents place
2ND – MARIPOSA	11 cents place
3RD – WELDBOROUGH	9 cents place

MARIPOSA – Bounded on jumping unbalancing its rider.

Stewards inquired into the reasons I'M SO COOL restrained off heels at about the 200 metres. It was ascertained that KING ISLAND and MARAPOSA had both shifted out marginally when attempting to improve with NAMABAAL also improving to the outside of those two runners, resulting in I'M SO COOL being tightened for room. Rider D Pires stated that he had commenced to tire and momentarily had to restrain. Stewards were unable to attribute the blame to any one rider. All riders were reminded to exercise care when shifting ground.
