RACE 1 - LADBROKES IT! 3YO MAIDEN – (1100 Metres)

ALOTRHONN – Jumped awkwardly and shortly after was contacted on the hind quarters by FULL ZULU which had been forced outwards. Over raced in the early stages.

BAHIA BAY – Failed to muster early speed and tailed the field in the early stages.

FULL ZULU – Bumped at the start when VOLKANOVSKI shifted out and then checked when ALOTRHONN shifted in. Steadied off the heels of MIAMI SUN near the 400 metres.

MIAMI SUN – Shifted in near the 500 metres when carried in marginally by ALOTRHONN shifting in. Shifted out near the 150 metres when not fully clear of BELLASARIO. Rider B Hanham was advised to exercise more care in future. The gelding continued to shift out and near the winning post shifted abruptly. A warning has been placed on the manners of MIAMI SUN for hanging out. Stewards questioned trainer D Keating in relation to the improved performance. Trainer D Keating stated that wasn't surprised by the run as the horse has been working well and that they had educated the gelding over the poles during the week.

VOLKANOVSKI – Jumped awkwardly and shifted out bumping with FULL ZULU.

BELLASARIO – Slow to begin.

DING DING –A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow heart rate recovery.

GEEGEE'S MISTY – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 2 - KEVIN SHARKIE MAIDEN – (1400 METRES)

ADA WAY – Shifted in near the 1200 metres despite the efforts of the rider and tightened the running of GOLD PROOF. Rider B McCoull was advised to exercise more care in future. When questioned on the below market expectations performance rider B McCoull stated that the gelding did not travel well throughout the event and when placed under pressure failed to respond. However, he stated that the gelding ran on well over the final 200 metres and in his opinion the addition of blinkers may help.

BERSERKER – Slow to begin.

CROWN AND ANCHOR – Over-raced in the early stages and raced wide throughout.

DEVIL SUN – Stewards granted permission for rider S Carr to be engaged due to no suitable riders being available. Hampered near the 1200 metres when GOLD PROOF had to be restrained by its rider.

MONTE FLEUR – Raced wide throughout. Shifted in near the 1100 metres carrying DEVIL SUN inwards.

MISS PEBBLES – Raced wide throughout and laid out on the home turn and in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

GOLD PROOF – Steadied off heels near the 1200 metres and shifted out hampering DEVIL SUN. Laid out in the home straight, raced wide throughout.

RACE 3 – SCHWEPPE'S TASMANIAN DERBY DAY FEB 10 CLASS 1 HCP – (1200 METRES)

NICCO THE GREEK – Shifted in near the 100 metres, raced wide throughout.

BELMISTA – Slow to begin. Checked near the 100 metres when tightened between NICCO THE GREEK and GEE GEE MISS QUITA. At a subsequent inquiry it was established that NICCO THE GREEK was laying in at the same time GEE GEE MISS QUITA laid out resulting in BELMISTA being tightened and losing its position. Rider D Pires was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding and rider T Johnstone was advised to exercise care.

NEEDS TO BELONG – Suffered an injury to the near fore fetlock at the 250 metres and was eased down. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a fracture to the near fore fetlock and the gelding was subsequently humanely euthanized.

DOMINATOR'S GIRL – Slow to begin, caught wide and over raced in the early stages.

GEE GEE MISS QUITA – Laid out approaching the 100 metres tightening the running of BELMISTA. Rider T Johnstone was advised to exercise more care in future when shifting ground.

FINXY – Rider S Carr reported that her whip broke on entering the home straight and was placed at a disadvantage for the remainder of the race.

SNOWBIRD – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 4 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS BM68 HCP – (1600 METRES)

CLIFTON DANSEUR – Tired from the 400 metres. When questioned rider E Byrne Burke stated that after working to get to the lead early the gelding failed to respond from the home turn. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

BREW HORSE – Slow to begin.

NEED A FLUTTER – Slow to begin, over-raced in the middle stages.

NORTHERN SPIRIT – Raced three wide from the 1200 metres.

RACE 5 – LADBROKES PUNTER ASSIST MDN/CL1 – (1600 METRES)

BAHEERA – Caught wide throughout.

JACKJACK – Slow to begin.

JUST FOR CURIOSITY – Stewards questioned rider B McCoull on the below market performance of the gelding. Rider B McCoull stated that the gelding was back in distance and in his opinion requires further distance he also stated that when placing the gelding under pressure early the gelding had failed to respond but he was happy with how the horse worked home in the later stages of the race.

SMOKIN' HARD – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

WOUNDED MISS – Over raced early stages.

CLOUDY NIGHTS – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 6 – ELWICK FUNCTIONS & EVENTS BM72 HCP – (1400 METRES)

JEREMIAH – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

MISS CHARLIE BROWN – Raced three wide throughout.

ASSARANCA – Laid in entering the home straight and brushed with MISS CHARLIE BROWN. Continued to lay in for the remainder of the race.

RACE 7 LADBROKES HOBART CUP DAY FEB 12 BM62 HCP – (1400 METRES)

THOUGHTS'N'PRAYERS – Caught wide in the early stages. Bumped on two occasions by Wane's Quest shifting out entering the home straight. Restrained off heels of WANE'S QUEST about the 200 metres.

HELLOT – Slow to begin, tailed the field. When questioned rider G Catania stated she felt something amiss with the gelding's action in front. Trainer S Brunton was advised that the gelding would be required to complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again. Trainer S Brunton advised that his stable veterinarian would be attending his stables to assess the gelding post race.

WANE'S QUEST – Shifted out and bumped with THOUGHTS AND PRAYERS about the 200 metres.

RAVAGE – Shifted in and bumped with ZEWINNA near the 300 metres.

NEV'S BOY – Slow to begin.

ZEWINNA – Bumped near the 300 metres when RAVAGE shifted in and momentarily held up for a clear run.

HAS THE LOOK – Held up on the home turn.

IRIS WEST – Rider reported something amiss with the mare's action. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 8 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK BM62 HCP – (1100 METRES)

VERBANO – Bumped heavily and checked on jumping when WHEELING shifted out abruptly.

GEE GEE ALS PRINCE – Bumped on jumping when VERBANO was carried outwards.

GEE GEE ENUF SPEED – Bumped at the start when GEE GEE AL'S PRINCE was carried outwards. Bumped entering the home straight when GEE GEE AL'S PRINCE shifted wider.

NINA CARMELLA – Bounded on jumping and slow to begin. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

UNDER HIS EYE – Caught wide until the 600 metres.

MILITARY LAW – Raced wide throughout.

OXY DREAM – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 9 – KEVIN SHARKIE ELWICK STAKES DAY JAN 22 BM68 HCP – (1200 metres)

LAYLOW PLUCK – All plates required corrective work by the on course farrier prior to racing.

ZIAVERA – Slow to begin.

HOT WIRED - Slow to begin.
