Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – T A BRICKNELL MAIDEN – (1800 METRES)

PREWINGO – Jumped outwards at the start brushing with LYRICAL NANOHA. Rider M Ulucinar reported in his opinion there was something was amiss with the gelding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

MADJACK – Raced three wide early in the early stages, A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities

BANCA GLEE – Bumped with CASHMORE at the start. G Catania was advised to exercise care when allowing her mount to shift in when not fully clear of MADJACK on the home turn.

FIGHTING GRACE – Slow to begin, raced three wide early stages.

LYRICAL NANOHA – Jumped awkwardly and brushed the inside barrier gate.

YOUR SHUFFLE – Raced three wide throughout.

CASHMORE – Shifted in on jumping bumping with BANCA GLEE.

RACE 2 - INCITEC PIVOT MAIDEN – (1400 METRES)

BLONDE SUSPECT – Slow to begin, raced three wide throughout.

NOT BLUFFING – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after being kicked behind the gates prior to the start and was passed fit to race. Over raced in the early stages. Placed in restricted room near the 1100 metres when SHE'S BLUFFING shifted in marginally.

WHEELKNOT – Approved to race bare foot behind after losing a plate on route to the barriers. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to race. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

GRAND PEGASUS – Slow to muster early speed, steadied off heels of GEE GEES FLYBY at about the 1100 metres.

AVA OLLY – Slow to begin.

RACE 3 –TASMANIAN LIVESTOCK SERVICES 0-62 – (1400 METRES)

MYOCARDIUM – Shied at the rail at about the 300 metres and shifted out.

GOTCHAGOOD – Over raced early and middle stages.

ESPUR – Disappointed for a run near the 300 metres.

RACE 4 – TTMI & CASE IH – 62 (1400 METRES)

STARION – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities

SPIRITED TOFF – Slow to begin

UNIQUE GLOW – Shifted in abruptly at about the 750 metres momentarily unbalancing the rider.

MARIPOSA – Restrained from a wide barrier, raced wide from the middle stages. Rider C Baker stated that she had been instructed due to the pace in today's race to ride her mount further back. She also added that she had lost ground near the 800 metres when UNIQUE GLOW had shifted abruptly in advance of her. Stewards to follow up this performance with the trainer J Blacker.

RACE 5 – ARMIDALE STUD BM68 HCP – (1400M)

AZARA – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities

ASHAMANIA – Slow to begin, raced wide throughout.

THE DECIDER – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after becoming fractious in the tie up stalls and was passed fit to run.

MALEVOLENT – Checked near the 300 metres when AZARA laid in at the same time it laid out. Resulting in rider T Baker having to check his mount. Rider E Byrne Burke was advised to exercise care.

RACE 6 – CRESSY CHAFF CUTTERS LONGFORD CUP - (1800 METRES)

THE RISK FACTOR – Rider T Baker reported that in his opinion the gelding may have pulled up distressed. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities

SUPER SWOOP – Slow to begin, raced wide throughout.

PERUN – Stewards granted permission for rider B Neto to ride 1kg over the allotted minimum weight. Raced wide throughout. Inclined to lay in entering the home straight.

SKYWAY STAR – Tightened and carried out and had to be restrained off PERUN about the 300 metres when ARGYLE BEACH shifted out..

TOULON BROOK – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

ARGYLE BEACH – Apprentice C Baker was found guilty of a charge of careless riding under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding, the particulars of the charge being that at about the 200 metres she allowed her mount to shift out onto SKYWAY STAR resulting in that mare being tightened between ARGYLE BEACH and PERUN. C Baker was suspended for one Tasmanian race date, commencing midnight tonight and ending midnight the 2nd January, 2023.

UP WIND – Slow to begin.

RACE 7 QUEENS ARMS HOTEL BM62 HCP (1800 METRES)

KING ISLAND – Jumped awkwardly and shifted in, over raced early stages and shifted out marginally near the 1200 metres.

THE EXECUTIVE – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

WELDBOROUGH – Over raced early and middle stages.

DIXIE'S BOY – Over raced early stages, steadied near the 1200 metres when KING ISLAND commenced to over race and shifted out at the same time that THE EXECUTIVE progressed tightly to its outside, raced wide throughout.

NEEDAREIN – The gelding turned its head outwards as the gates opened and was very slow to begin.

CAPTAIN MORGAN – Raced wide throughout.
