RACE 1 – WELCOME BARRY AND KAYE OCKWELL MAIDEN 3YO & UP - (1100 Metres)

ANGELIC AMOUR – Raced wide throughout.

AUSSIE WARRIOR – Brushed with CARTOON GRAVEYARD on jumping, rider C Atkinson accidentally dropped his whip near the 300 metres.

STEEL MIST – Bumped on jumping with JENNA'S DAY, raced wide throughout.

CARTOON GRAVEYARD – Brushed with AUSSIE WARRIOR on jumping.

GRANDE AQUILA – Held up for a clear run from the 400 metres until the 100 metres. Was held up for a clear run passing the 200 metres when GEEGEE SCARLETBEE rolled in marginally. A post race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

GEEGEESSCARLETBEE – Fractious in the barriers, raced wide throughout. Shifted in marginally passing the 200 metres. Rider T Johnstone was advised to exercise care.

GONE GLOBAL – Declared a late scratching at 12.57pm as it was unable to be loaded, delaying the start by two minutes. Trainer T Keys was advised that the mare has been stood down from racing until it completes two consecutive satisfactory trials. On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on GONE GLOBAL to be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 12.57pm. Steward's ordered all monies wagered on the winner, EYES FOR ASH to be subject to the following deductions:

1 st - EYES FOR ASH	23 Cents Win 20 Cents Place
2 nd - ROZHAE	16 Cents Place
3 rd - STEEL MIST	22 Cents Place

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the ticket.

JENNA'S DAY – Bumped on jumping with STEEL MIST, raced three wide throughout.

RACE 2 - VALE WILLIAM 'MACCA' HARRIS CLASS 1 HCP - (1200 METRES)

BANCA TOM – Shifted out on jumping brushing with MONTE BIANCO.

YANOSHA – Raced wide in the early stages. Stewards queried the improved performance. Trainer N Webberley stated that the gelding had trained on well and at its previous start had been slow to begin and had to work hard early. Trainer N Webberley also stated that she was expecting a positive run today, which was also assisted with a 2kg claiming apprentice. Stewards noted her explanation.

SCARDIMALIA – Slow to begin.

MONTE BIANCO – Brushed by BANCA TOM on jumping and shifted out, raced wide throughout, laid in over the concluding stages

OXY DREAM – Slow to begin and slow to muster early speed. Raced fiercely and had to be steadied off heels at the 600 metres.

GEE GEE SNOWFLAKE – Raced three wide throughout.

RACE 3 – SALTERS HIRE BM676 HCP - (1430 METRES)

ROMARY – Passed pre-race veterinary inspection behind the barriers.

WE DESERVE THIS – Tightened on jumping when SHAMPZ AGAIN shifted out. Rider T Baker stated that he believed that the drop back in distance did not suit the horse today. A post race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

SHAMPZ AGAIN – Shifted out on jumping, rider E Byrne Burke then elected to take a sit closer to the rail.

RACE 4 – KEVIN SHARKIE ELWICK STAKES 2YO – (1100 METRES)

THOROS OF MYR – Shifted outwards abruptly on jumping. Stewards have stood the gelding down from racing until the completion of a barrier test. Tired over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a high heart rate and slow recovery.

ENCOUNTER SPHERE – Bumped on jumping, raced three wide throughout.

OXY BOLT – Slow to begin. Beaten 33.75 lengths and a warning was placed on it for being uncompetitive. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a high heart rate and slow recovery.

THESPIAN WATERS – Slow to begin.

NEEDS SUGAR – Shifted out on jumping bumping with ENCOUNTER SPHERE. Carried wider approaching the 600 metres when CAIRNS shifted out.

ISLAND WARRIOR – Slow to begin. Lost position near the 500 metres when racing in restricted room to the inside of THESPIAN WATERS which was laying in despite the efforts of the rider.

RACE 5 – GEE GEES HORSE STUD BLACKFLASH 3YO – (1100 METRES)

GEEGEE JET BY – Raced three wide throughout, laid in, in home straight.

FAKE MAGIC – Slow to begin.

BOLD INSTINCT – Delayed the start by two minutes when the girth had to be replaced behind the barriers.

VIBURNUM – Slow to begin.

SISTINE – Over raced in the middle stages.

FEAR THE STING – Jumped awkwardly contacting the outside barrier gate and then shifted out.

TRICKY MIKKI – Over raced in the middle stages. When questioned on the apparent poor performance rider D Ganderton stated that the filly was up in class and failed to respond to his riding from the 200 metres. A post race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

GOOGLY – Jumped very awkwardly and struck the inside barrier gate and was slow to begin.

RACE 6 – AVISO TAS INSURANCE BROKERS THOUSAND GUINEAS 3YO FILLIES – (1600 METRES)

JAGUAR STONE – Jumped awkwardly and shifted out.

UNIQUE GLOW – Restrained from a wide barrier to take up a position closer to the rail.

CLOUDY NIGHTS – Momentarily held up entering the home straight.

JUST A NEEDS – Inclined to lay in under pressure.

PINANDI – Restrained from a wide barrier to take up a position closer to the rail.

RACE 7 – CESSIAH ALICE MILLINERY LADY LYNETTE FILLIES & MARES – (1100 METRES)

DUNBRODY POWER – Raced wide throughout.

EMILY – Shifted out on jumping making heavy contact with SIRENE STRYKER. When questioned rider A Darmanin stated that the mare failed to muster speed from the 600 metres to the home turn and he was held up behind QEENBOROUGH FLYER at this point however ran on well in the home straight.

FAIRY MAGIC – Raced three wide until the 600 metres.

QUEENBOROUGH FLYER – Slow to begin.

JAJA CHABOOGIE – Rider S Tsaikos was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(b) for failing to ride his mount out fully to the finish.

SIRENE STRYKER – Jumped awkwardly striking the inside barrier gate. Checked shortly after when Emily shifted out making heavy contact.

VERBANO – Bumped with ZADES STORIES near the 600 metres.

DONNA'S DAY – Raced wide throughout, over raced in the middle stages.

ZADE'S STORIES – Bumped with VERBANO near the 600 metres.

RACE 8 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK SUMMER CUP – (2200 METRES)

CREATIVE HERO – Checked on jumping and lost its position when I'M SO COOL shifted in and made heavy contact and GLASS WARRIOR shifted out. Raced wide in the middle stages.

STEEL SKIES – Change of tactics advised to be ridden further back. These tactics were adopted. Jumped awkwardly and race wide from the middle stages.

I'M SO COOL – Shifted in on jumping bumping heavily with I'M SO COOL.

GLASS WARROIR – Bumped with STEEL SKIES on several occasions from the 1800 metres until the 1500 metres.

DRAMAZING – Stewards spoke with trainer B Campbell on the below market performance of the mare. Trainer B Campbell stated that the mare pulled up sound. He stated that he was disappointed with the run and in his opinion a number of factors may have contributed including first start at the track, along with the heat and long day may have not helped. He also stated that the jump from a handicap race to weight for age may not have assisted.

RACE 9 – LADBROKES LIVE BETTING BM62 HCP – (1600 METRES)

NEED A FLUTTER – Jumped awkwardly and slow to begin.

NOZTRABEEL – Shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

MARIPOSA – Threw its head down on jumping and was slow to begin.

SMOKIN' HARD – Declared a late scratching at 4.44pm on veterinary advice due to striking its head in the wash bay and bleeding from the right nostril. On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on SMOKIN' HARD to be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 4.44pm. Steward's ordered all monies wagered on the winner, NOZTRABEEL to be subject to the following deductions:

1 st NOZTRABEEL	12 Cents Win 14 Cents Place
2 nd RENASCENCE	14 Cents Place

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the ticket.

Trainer T Romeo was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to trialling or racing again.
