### *Comments / Explanations:*

#### **RACE 1 – DANIEL HILL AUSTRALIAN BOXING TITLE SAT NIGHT CLASS 1 HCP – (1400M)**

**CHORIZAMA** – Three wide early until the 900 metres, bumped with DUTCH ACTION near the 1000 metres.

**ALMIGHTY VIRTUE** – Bumped with CHORIZMA near the 1000 metres.

**DUTCH ACTION** – Shifted out on jumping.

**BELMISTA** – Trainer B Baker advised Stewards a change of tactics. It is their intentions to ride the gelding more conservatively, circumstances permitting. These tactics were adopted,

jumped awkwardly and over raced in the early stages and carried wider near the 900 metres when DOONICAN shifted out.

**RICHMOND POET** – Over raced in the early stages.

**DOONICAN (IRE)** – Checked off the heels of MASTER MONTECITO which had been restrained when over racing near the 900 metres.

**MASTER MONTECITO** – Over raced from the 1200 metres to the 900 metres when it was restrained and lost ground resulting in DOONICAN having to checked. Apprentice T Stalker was advised that she had erred in easing the pace excessively at this point. She was also advised that she is not to use the whip when her mounts are out of contention.

**ANOTHER PREDICTION** – Slow to begin.

### **RACE 2 - LADBROKE IT! MAIDEN - (1400M)**

**MAY WE ALL** – Shifted out near the 100 metres bumping with LISKAMM and carrying it wider.

**ONE STAR DREAM** – Over raced in the early stages. A post race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have knocked an old wound to the left hind pastern, which was treated with antibiotic powder.

**VIVRE IS THE WORD** – Held up for a short distance passing the 100 metres when LISKAMM was carried wider.

**BOBBY BOBBY** – Hung out and tailed the field from the 700 metres. Stewards queried rider M Ulucinar in relation to the poor performance. Rider M Ulucinar stated that approaching the 800 metres the gelding locked its jaw and became difficult to ride and failed to run on when placed under pressure. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

**MONTEZULU** – Raced three wide without cover.

**LISKAMM** – Jumped inwards at the start and bumped with NO ACCESS, bumped and carried wider near the 100 metres when MAY WE ALL shifted wider.

**TWINKLEDUST** – A warning has been placed on the mare for being difficult to load.

Apprentice C Baker (MAY WE ALL) was reprimanded under the provisions of AR 131(a) for careless riding after permitting her mount to shift out near the 100 metres and bumping with LISKAMM.

### **RACE 3 – THANK YOU JILL SMITH BENCHMARK 62 HCP – (1600M)**

**COUP DE SPRY** – Slow to begin and tailed the field. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities. Stewards to follow up with trainer.

**THREE'S A CROWD** – Raced three-wide early.

**MARIPOSA** – Trainer advised a change of tactics, it is their intentions for the mare to be ridden more conservatively, circumstances permitting.

**RENASCENCE** – Raced wide throughout.

**SNOWING IN PARIS** – Compounded over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed failed to reveal any abnormalities. Trainer J Keys advised Stewards that the mare would now be retired.

#### **RACE 4 – TAS BREEDERS GOOD FRIDAY FAMILY FUN DAY MAIDEN – (1200M)**

**BAVARIAN FLYER** – Shifted in on jumping.

**BOLD FACE** – Checked shortly after the start when tightened between MISS PRIVATE which shifted out.

**EXPLOSIVE PICTURE** – Checked after the start and lost its position when CORA THE EXPLORER shifted out carrying it out onto STARNOTE. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow recovery rate.

**CORA THE EXPLORER** – Raced wide throughout. Rider L Riordan stated that he was under pressure throughout the race and the filly failed to respond to his riding. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

**MISS PRIVATE** – Shifted out on jumping crowding BOLD FACE.

**STARNOTE** – Bumped on jumping.

#### **RACE 5 – THANK YOU PETER STAPLES BENCHMARK 68 HCP – (1200M)**

**GEE GEE QUEEN BEE** – Three wide throughout.

**GEE GEE ALS PRINCE** – Slow to begin.

**HANNAH'S SONG** – Steadied near the 800 metres when electing to take a sit behind NEEDS TO BE UNIQUE. Rider S Carr was advised she must exercise more care when easing the pace as BARIA had to be restrained off her heels at this point.

**BARIA** – Slow to begin. Over-raced in the early stages and was checked near the 800 metres off the heels of HANNAH'S SONG.

#### **RACE 6 – LADBROKES ODDS SURGE MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – (2100M)**

**AURUM MAN (NZ)** – A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

**CONUMDRUM** – Raced three-wide throughout.

**HEWIE** – Declared a late scratching at 7.54am on veterinary advice after it was found to have superficial abrasions on both hind legs. Trainer A Trinder was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to the gelding racing again.

**ISAFJORDUR** – Bumped near the 1600 metres when PUMA was carried wider.

**PUMA** – Carried wider and bumped with WANING WEASEL near the 1600 metres.

**GRAND PEGASUS** – Raced three-wide in the middle stages and worked forward.

**BELLANIVE** – Jumped awkwardly.

**MISS PEBBLES** – Hung out leaving the home straight and tightened PUMA.

**WANING WEASEL** – Tightened near the 1600 metres when PUMA shifted out resulting in it bumping with ISAFJORDUR. Raced wide throughout. Rider C Baker advised stewards that the mare failed to settle in the run throughout.

#### **RACE 7 – BOOK IN FOR GOOD FRIDAY LUNCHEON 62 RATING – (1400M)**

**MR FREEZE** – Bounded on jumping

**FAST THINKER** – Slow to begin, over raced near the 900 metres when placed awkwardly on the heels of MR FREEZE.

**SILVER PERSUASION** – Steadied off the heels of FANCIFUL FLYING when that mare commenced to over race.

**FANCIFUL FLYING** – Commenced to over race near the 1000 metres and shifted in when not fully clear of SILVER PERSUASION. Rider D Parish was advised to exercise care when allowing her mounts to shift ground.

#### **RACE 8 – LITTLE GIANT HOMES BENCHMARK 76 HCP – (1400M)**

**SH'BOURNE REBEL** – Jumped awkwardly.

**FIVEFINGERDISCOUNT** – Bounded on jumping brushing the outside gate, compounded over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding showing signs of colic and was treated.

**SUMMER FIRE** – Over-raced in the early stages.

#### **GENERAL**

Co-trainer K Maskiell pled guilty to a charge under AR 251(1)(a) for possessing 6 tubes of the equine treatment product Gastrazole on course without permission. After considering all factors, including that product was not being administered to any horse on the day, the Stewards imposed a fine of \$200.00
