Comments / Explanations:

Rider M Ulucinar was stood down from his engagements today by order of Stewards.

RACE 1 – LADBROKES OWNERS INCENTIVE MAIDEN – (1150 METRES)

BARATO – Broke through the barriers gates prior to the start and was restrained and re loaded. Carried wider at the start when CAPTAIN CAM jumped outwards and was slow to begin. Restrained after the start to obtain a position closer to the rail.

CAPTAIN SAM – Jumped outwards at the start, raced three-wide throughout.

GENERAL ASSEMBLY – Improved performance, addition of blinkers.

RUBBLEONTHEDOUBLE – Jumped inwards at the start, raced fiercely in the early stages and laid in for the entire home straight preventing S Carr from riding her mount out fully.

SHOOTING NORTH – Held up for a clear run on the home turn.

CLOVER HILL –Tightened after the start.

FIRE ON MAZZ – Slow to begin.

STARS IN THE NIGHT – Shifted in on jumping hampering CLOVER HILL. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no apparent abnormalities.

VALIANT KHAN –Tightened at the start and checked.

RUBICK'S AFFAIR – Over raced in the middle stages.

LITTLE SAL – Bounded on jumping and lost ground.

RACE 2 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT CLASS 1 HCP – (1150 METRES)

LACERATE –Slow to begin.

MARTINI BLUE –Slow to begin

CHEROKEE DANCER – Warning placed on the filly due to being fractious in the barriers.

LABBY ROCK –Jumped awkwardly and over raced in the back straight and had to be checked off heels near the 800 metres. Lost a near hind plate in running.

BYNANCE – Raced three-wide throughout.

MISS SLEUTH – Raced wide throughout.

ANOTHER PREDICTION – Slow to begin, steadied off heels near the 600 metres. Warning continued on being fractious in the barriers.

RACE 3 – GOODSTONE GROUP MAIDEN – (1650 METRES)

A LITTLE DECEIT – Declared a late scratching at 1.02pm after being kicked on the left side causing bruising and pain to the ribs behind the barriers. On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on A LITTLE DECEIT be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 1.02pm. A pre-race veterinary examination prior to the gelding's next race start is required.

1st – RISIST CAPTURE – 4c win and 3c place

2nd – FALCULA - 5c place
3rd – ONE STAR DREAMING - 5c place

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the ticket.

BALCASKIE – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

LIGHTNING HAMMER – Bounded on jumping and was slow to begin.

PUMA – raced three wide throughout.

FALCULA – Laid out entering the home straight.

MISS PEBBLES – Disappointed for clear running entering the home straight.

PINANDI – Jumped outwards at the start and bumped with REWARD FOR ROSIE.

RISIST CAPTURE – Stewards granted permission for rider B McCoull to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight.

SILENT LOVE – Raced three-wide in the early stages and compounded in the home straight. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a poor recovery rate.

WESTERN TEARS – Jumped awkwardly after hitting the inside of the barriers and was slow to begin. Over raced middle stages. A warning issued on the pre-race manners for kicking A LITTLE DECEIT behind the gates.

REWARD FOR ROSIE – Bumped at the start with PINANDI, raced wide throughout.

RACE 4 – THAI IMPERIAL BM64 HCP – (1880 METRES)

Correct weight was delayed for Trainer A Trinder to view the official patrol films in the home straight, after doing so he was satisfied, and correct weight was declared on the judges numbers.

ONE LOTTO – Slow to begin, raced three wide early.

HELLFIRE EAGLE – Bumped with PROSECUTOR at the start.

BLONDE SUSPECT – Over-raced in the early stages, steadied off heels at about the 1400 metres.

SOUTHERN WIND – Shifted out on jumping tightening HAMPTON BAY

PROSECUTOR – Over raced in the early stages.

HAMPTON BAY – Tightened on jumping between SOUTHERN WIND and PROSECUTOR.

RACE 5 – ALI & SARAH'S 40TH BIRTHDAY CELEBRATIONS BM60 HCP – (1009 METRES)

O'REILLY MCLUKE (NZ) – Slow to begin, held up for a clear run behind QUICKEN UP from the 100 metres to the finish.

BOLD INSTINCT – Over raced in the early stages. Shifted out approaching the 600 metres and tightened the running of OUR SHINKANSEN. Apprentice C Wells was reminded of obligations to ensure she is fully clear when shifting ground under the provisions of AR 131(a) for Careless Riding.

VETLANDA – Jumped awkwardly when making contact to the inside of the barriers. Held up for the majority of the home straight when initially disappointed for a clear run between BOLD INSTINCT and TILLTHEREWARSYOU near the 200 metres and then between TILLTHEREWASYOU and TIDAL.

OUR SHINKANSEN – Tightened near the 600 metres when BOLD INSTINCT shifted out.

FEISTY LION – Raced three-wide throughout.

TILTHEREWARSYOU – Raced four-wide throughout.

GEE GEE GOLDENLASS – Held up for a clear run until near the 200 metres.

TIDAL – Raced five-wide throughout.

RACE 6 – #THESHARKLUVTASSIERACING OPEN HCP – (1009 METRES)

ALPINE WOLF – Laid out making the 600-metre turn.

AND BEYOND – Over raced in the early stages.

LE CADEAU – Slow to begin.

SHARMA RAMA – Slow to begin, laid in over the concluding stages.

GEE GEE QUEEN BEE – Slow to begin.

RACE 7 – THE STABLES AT SPREYTON BM68 HCP – (1350 METRES)

GEEGEELUCKYSTAR –

ALPINE BLAST – Rider reported that the gelding felt short in its action behind. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

ALPINE AFFAIR – Slow to begin. Stewards queried rider S Carr on the below market performance of the gelding. Rider S Carr stated that the gelding had resented the kickback and when placed under pressure failed to respond to her riding.

UBRIACO – Slow to begin.

AZARA – Over-raced making the 1100 metre turn and shifted out.

MULTISANTI – Over raced early, carried wider making the 1100 metre turn and raced wide thereafter.

SQUARE DONUT – Held up for clear running on the home turn and until the 150 metres.

RACE 8 – GREAT NORTHERN 0 – 62 – (1350 METRES)

KING ISLAND – Stewards queried trainer Ms A Brakey in relation to the improved performance. Trainer Mrs A Brakey stated that her stable veterinarian had treated the horse after it had exhibited poor heat rate recovery and the condition had been resolved. In her opinion, trainer A Brakey stated that was expecting an improvement in the gelding's performance today.

ALPINE AVIATOR – Over-raced early and middle stages.

HERO OF ROMANI – Raced three-wide throughout.

SWEETSOP –Slow to begin.

BARIA –Slow to begin.
