Comments / Explanations:

Indefinite delay to race one due to no ambulance on course, race delayed five minutes.

RACE 1 – LADBROKES OWNERS INCENTIVE MAIDEN – (1200 METRES)

AURUM MAN – Raced wide with cover, had a tendency to lay in, in the home straight.

FREDDY'SAJETSTAR – Raced four wide throughout.

JAGGER ROCKS – Raced wide early, Rider C Baker reported her mount raced greenly throughout and failed to settle in the early stages, so she elected to go forward. Rider C Baker also stated that from the wide barrier draw and blinkers first start may not have helped. A Post-race veterinary examination revealed minor abrasions to the left hind heel bulb, however no other abnormalities were detected.

LOUD MOUTH (NZ) – Laid in, in the home straight.

SONTORRE – Performed below market expectations, trainers representative S Brunton was disappointed with the run and the stable veterinarian will be taking blood samples during the week with the trainer to advise Stewards of the result.

PASS US BY – Slow to begin and slow to muster early speed.

RAEHEARTED – Slow to muster early speed.

GRAND PEGASUS – Slow to muster early speed.

AUSSIE WARRIOR – Slow to begin, had to be straightened by its rider near the 50 metres when the gelding laid in.

RACE 2 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS CLASS 1 HCP – (1400 METRES)

CREATIVE LICENCE – Delay on correct weight as rider B McCoull the rider of the second placegetter past the post wished to view the official patrol films in relation to lodging an objection against the winner. After viewing the patrol films correct weight was declared on the judge's numbers.

BERSERKER – Rolled in and brushed with CREATIVE LICENCE prior to the winning post.

GENERAL ASSEMBLY – Raced three wide throughout.

VANITY STAR – Slow to begin, held up for a clear run rounding the home and entering the home straight and then shifted wider to obtain a clear run.

DUTCH AUCTION – Held up rounding the home turn behind the tiring ROLLING IN IT.

MIRA FLORES – Raced three wide with cover throughout. Held up home turn. Rider S Carr reported the mare hung out throughout.

ROLLING IN IT – Trainer B McShane advised stewards that it was their intentions to have the filly ridden further forward circumstances permitting. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Tactics adopted.

RACE 3 – IT'S WHY WE RACE MAIDEN – (1600 METRES)

FASHION FOX – Rider T Baker's whip was tangled up in the reins momentarily inside the 200 metres.

WADDY WADDY – Trainer B McShane advised stewards that it was their intentions for the gelding to be ridden further back circumstances permitting. Tactics adopted.

EMMJAY (NZ) – Raced wide throughout.

FIGHTING GRACE – Slow to begin 1-2 lengths.

GLOBAL AWARENESS – Had a tendency to lay in at about the 150 metres and rider D Pires had to stop and straighten his mount.

MISS PEBBLES – Raced wide throughout, held up momentarily rounding the home turn and had to shift wider to obtain a clear run. Had a tendency to lay in, in the home straight.

YOUR SHUFFLE – Slow to begin.

LADY SARAH – Trainer S Cotton advised stewards that it was their intentions to have the filly ridden further forward circumstances permitting. Tactics adopted.

RACE 4 – ELWICK FUNCTIONS & EVENTS BM68 HCP – (2100 METRES)

MONMOUTH – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to be mildly lame in the off fore. Trainer E Batt was advised a veterinary clearance will be required prior to the next race start.

EAGLE STREET – Stewards queried rider D Pires in relation to the below market performance of the gelding. Rider D Pires stated that the gelding had got back in the early stages of the race however improved in the run home. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be heart stressed. Trainer S Brunton was advised an ECG and veterinary examination is required prior to racing again.

JACKJACK – Restrained off the heels of PERUN at about the 400 metres.

BANCA GLEE – Over-raced near the 1700 metres.

KNOT DANCING – Jumped awkwardly contacting the inside of the barriers and was slow to begin.

RACE 5 – LADBROKES YARD COMMENTS BM60 HCP - (1100 METRES)

THOUGHTS'N'PRAYERS – Jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin.

HOT WIRED – Raced four wide throughout.

GRAPHITE MIST – A course announcement was made to the effect that the mare would not be racing in blinkers as listed in the race book. Jumped awkwardly after contacting the inside of the barrier gate resulting in shifting in and momentarily tightening HOT WIRED. Rider G Catania had to stop and straighten her mount on a number occasions in the home straight.

VENTUS – Jumped awkwardly momentarily unbalancing its rider.

ANOTHER PREDICTION – Declared a late scratching at 2.15pm on veterinary advice after rearing and sitting down in the barriers and was examined and found to have blood in the left nostril and inside the left upper lip. Trainer P Hill was advised that the mare must complete two satisfactory barrier trials and a veterinary clearance prior to racing again. Trainer P Hill advised stewards that the mare will now be retired.

On the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on ANOTHER PREDICTION be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 2.15pm.

1st – UNDER HIS EYE – 0c win and 1c place

2nd – ETOSHA - 1c place

3rd – GRAPHITE MIST - 1c place

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the ticket.

RACE 6 – LADBROKE IT! BM64 HCP F & M – (1200 METRES)

PAGE – carried wider by BLUSHED at about the 600 metres.

SCARDIMALIA – Raced wide throughout.

ZIAVERA – Slow to begin.

BLUSHED – Checked off the heels of BARIA at about the 600 metres, shifted out bumping with PAGE and carrying that mare wider on the track.

MAARKLE – Slow to begin.

BARIA – Checked off the hind quarters of PUNK PRINCESS approaching the 600 metres.

PUNK PRINCESS – Tightened for racing room approaching the 600 metres.

Stewards inquired into an incident approaching the 600 metres where BARIA (L Annells) was tightened for racing room onto the hind quarters of PUNK PRINCESS (C Baker) and was checked. Stewards were unable to attribute the blame to anyone rider however riders S Carr (DAY PERFORMER) and D Pires (SCARDIMALIA) were advised to exercise care in similar circumstances. Stewards believed that when the pace eased the racing manners of DAY PERFORMER getting its head up and over racing and shifting in and away from SCARDIMALIA contributed incident.

RACE 7 – BIG4 ILUKA FREYCINET BM72 HCP – (1390 METRES)

DARK WANDERER – Raced wide in the back straight. Rider L Annells was advised to exercise care when shifting ground at about the 700 metres when not fully clear.

ARTY LUCAS – Underwent a veterinary examination upon arrival and was passed suitable to race, having not raced for over 12 months and returning from a minor tendon injury: got its head up and commenced to over race shortly after the start.

JULIUS – Jumped awkwardly contacting the inside of the barrier. Over raced early stages. Stewards queried rider A Darmanin on the below market performance. Rider A Darmanin stated that the gelding was fractious behind the barriers and when placed under pressure at the 600 metres failed to respond and he was unable to provide an explanation on the performance. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormality.

MUSIC ADDITION – Carried in over the concluding stages by JOHNNY CHUTZPAH.

JOHNNY CHUTZPAH – Held up entering the home straight and shifted out to obtain a clear run. Shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages carrying MUSIC ADDITION inwards. Rider B Muhcu was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances.

FIGHTING FLOYD – Restrained off heels of DARK WANDERER at about the 700 metres.

RACE 8 – KEVIN SHARKIE BM64 HCP – (1200 METRES)

GEE GEE ENUF SPEED – Over raced in the early stages and raced three wide with cover.

STEEL MIST – Slow to begin and was slow to muster early speed.

BRINKTOP LAD – Over raced early, raced three wide throughout.

ALINJER – Four wide early to a three wide with cover.

HELLOT – laid in, in the home straight.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES MAIDEN BREAKTHROUGH BONUS MAIDEN 1100 METRES.

LOUD MOUTH (NZ) – Bumped with TRABZON at the start. Laid in, inside the 100 metres tightening the run of ROLLING IN IT. Rider G Catania was advised to exercise care when allowing her mount to shift in.

Stewards queried rider G Catania on the riding tactics adopted and riding instructions from the trainer. Rider G Catania stated she was advised to lead, however on entering the home straight G Catania stated the gelding had a tendency to lay in throughout to the finish line. Stewards confirmed with trainer S Brunton riding tactics adopted. Rider G Catania stated that the gelding would derive the benefit from the run. Stewards noted rider G Catania's explanation.

RACE 5 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS BM60 HCP – 1150 Metres

OUR SHINKANSEN – Tightened and checked at the start when BERRUTI jumped inwards. Raced four wide early until approaching the 600 metres. Held up for clear racing room approaching the 150 metres. It was noted that the mare had raced in its normal racing pattern of off midfield.
