Comments / Explanations:

A number of randomly selected riders provided urine samples at today's race meeting.

RACE 1 – VALE DEAN HOLLAND 2YO HCP 2-Y-O – (1200 METRES)

THOROS OF MYR – Rider B McCoull advised Stewards that his mount had blundered on jumping and lost ground. He also stated that his mount had hung in throughout; hung in and bumped with GOLDEN MEADOW near the 400 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

CALIFORNIA PUNK – Tightened after the start by GEE GEE TYCOON which shifted out.

GOLDEN MEADOW – Tightened and lost its position near the 400 metres when bumped by THOROS OF MYR which was hanging in despite the efforts of its rider. A post race veterinary examination revealed minor lacerations to the right fore fetlock.

GEEGEEHAILSTORM – Stewards granted permission for rider T BAKER to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight.

Rider T Johnstone pled guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding, the particulars of the charge being that at about the 250 metres she allowed her mount to shift out when not fully clear of CALIFORNIA PUNK (H LeBlanc) resulting in that filly being tightened and checked. Rider T Johnstone's license to ride in races was suspended for oneTasmanian race date.

RACE 2 - LITTLE GIANT HOMES MAIDEN (1) 2-Y-O & UP - (1450 METRES)

AUNTIE JAKE'S BAR – Rider S Carr reported the gelding did not handle todays track conditions. Jumped awkwardly after making contact with the barriers. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

LONDIANI – Tightened approaching the 1200 metres between AUNTIE JAKE'S BAR and I'M VERY HAPPY. Raced three-wide thereafter without cover to the 400 metres.

WHERE YOU FROM - Steadied off the heels of LOVE NEST approaching the metres.

LOVE NEST – Held up approaching the metres and was placed awkwardly inside the heels of IM VERY HAPPY and lost its position.

PASS US BY – Over-raced in the early stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

STEELE MY SUNSHINE – Became fractious in barriers, reared and dislodged rider. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was declared fit to run. Rider A Darmanin underwent a medical examination and was cleared to complete his riding engagements. Jumped awkwardly. Stewards have placed a warning on the barrier manners of the filly.

RACE 3 – JKB RACING MAIDEN (2) 2-Y-O – (1450 METRES)

CAPTAIN CAM – Blundered on jumping, rider lost the inside rein. Shifted out on jumping tightening FALCULA.

FLYING PARIAH – Stewards spoke with rider L Annells in relation to the below market performance. Rider L Annells stated that she was unable to place the gelding into a positive position in the early stages of the race from a wide barrier draw, and that from the 500 metres it had failed to respond to her riding. Ms Annell's was also of the opinion that the gelding had failed to handle today's heavy track conditions; a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Trainer P Hill was advised that a warning has been placed on the gelding's race manners.

MAY WE ALL – Raced three- wide throughout.

FALCULA – Slow to begin.

GOES LIKE THE WIND – Over raced in the early stages.

LILY LUELLA - Contacted outside barrier gate on jumping and began awkwardly.

OZTURK – Stewards granted permission for rider K Sanderson ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight.

PROWL CRAZY – Tightened on jumping between CAPTAIN CAM, which had shifted out, and FLYING PARIAH.

RACE 4 - AUSTRALIAN TRAINERS ASSOCIATION CLASS 1 HCP - (1450 METRES)

MOORBOOZIE – Bounded out on jumping.

VANITY STAR – Very difficult to load, a warning has been placed on the loading manners of the gelding.

FLYING TO PARIS – Rider D Pires reported the filly failed to handle todays track conditions and failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which poor recovery.

A WEE NIP – Crowded on jumping between DUTCH ACTION and SALLY SUNSHINE and was slow to begin.

DUMPUS – Declared a late scratching at 12:37pm on veterinary advice after rearing and becoming cast in the barriers. A warning has been placed on the barrier manners of the gelding. On the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered that all monies invested on DUMPUS be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 12:37pm.

1st – CREATIVE LISENCE – 4c win and 3c place 2nd – DUTCH ACTION - 6c place 3rd – VANITY STAR - 8c place

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the ticket.

SALLY SUNSHINE – Stewards granted rider T Baker permission to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight.

RACE 5 – CARRICK PLATE 3-Y-O (1220 METRES)

CORNELIAN BAY - Raced in restricted room approaching the finish line.

BOLD INSTINCT – Shifted in on jumping bumping with JUST A NEEDS.

JUST A NEEDS – Stewards granted permission for rider B McCoull to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight.

UNIQUE GLOW – Raced wide throughout.

MARTINI BLUE – Held up over the final 100 metres.

RACE 6 – A1 HORSE TRANSPORT CLASS 1 HCP – (1220 METRES)

BORN A WINNER – Trainer reported the gelding had been galloped on during the run. A post race veterinary examination revealed a large laceration on his right hind tendon. A veterinary certificate will be required before the gelding trials or races again.

PRINCESS MATOAKA – Struck barrier gate on jumping and began awkwardly. Hung out from the 600 metres and approaching the 400 metres had to be checked off the heels of VENTUS, which was laying in despite the best efforts of its rider. Held up for a clear run passing the 100 metres to the finish.

ALPINE ASSAULT – Checked off the heels of PRINCESS MATOAKA when it had been checked off heels.

MILLA'S READY – Bumped by PUNK PRINCESS shortly after the start.

GRAPHITE MIST – Jumped awkwardly.

BLACK EAGLET – Over raced early stages. Approaching the 900 metres was carried wider by PUNK PRINCESS.

VENTUS – Laid in approaching the 400 metres. Rider H Le Blanc was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground near the 100 metres.

PUNK PRINCESS – Bumped with MILLA'S READY shortly after the start. Over raced middle stages. Rider reported the mare felt amiss in her action towards the concluding stages, a post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near hind. Trainer J Blacker was advised a veterinary clearance will be required prior to the mare trialling or racing again.

BETTER THAN BANKSY – Trainer G White advised Stewards of a change of tactics, that the gelding would be ridden further back today, circumstances permitting. Tactics adopted.

RACE 7 – DELORAINE HOTEL DELORAINE CUP – (1450 METRES)

DARK WANDERER – Shifted out on jumping bumping with Swoop Dog.

SIR SIMON – Raced 3 wide during the early stages. Contacted the outside barrier gate on jumping. Under-went a post-race veterinary examination and treated for signs of colic post race.

ARTY LUCAS – Tightened and lost position on jumping.

JOHNNY CHUTZPAH – Bumped and carried out on jumping.

JULIUS - Over raced from the 1200 metres.

RACE 8 - BRAESIDE PARK 0 -62 - (1450 METRES)

MR FREEZE – Over raced approaching the 1000 metres and had to be checked off the heels of TERRACOTTA, carrying HELLOT wider.

RUSTIC CHARM – Jumped awkwardly, contacted the outside barrier gate and as such was slow to begin. Momentarily held up for clear running approaching the winning post.

ALINJER – Over raced early stages.

HELLOT – Raced wide throughout.

TERRACOTTA – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after having a shoe replaced in the mounting yard and was passed fit to run. Raced three wide throughout.

MAARKLE – Slow to begin.

RACE 9 - R.F FERGUSSON BM68 HCP - (1620 METRES)

MONMOUTH – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination prior to racing and was passed fit to take its place in the field. Raced wide throughout.

PERUN – Harmlessly dislodged rider H Le Blanc after the finish when the gelding jumped over the crossing.

MAINCOURT – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

GEE GEE ENUF SPEED – Held up for a clear run on the home turn.

GEEGES HISWORD – Rider D PIRES reported the gelding did not handle todays track conditions.

KING ISLAND – Rider B McCoull reported the gelding failed to handle todays track conditions.

CARNEROS – Raced three wide throughout. Approaching the 100 metres rider A Darmanin appeared to fumble with his whip and was therefore unable to ride his mount out fully for some distance in the home straight.

RACE 10 - BLAIR SAWMILL/GUY NEWITT MEMORIAL BM60 HCP - (1120 METRES)

COPPER CHARM – Underwent a post veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

ENSNARE – Shifted in shortly after the start tightening ETOSHA in onto MCSWEYN.

TITLE SHOT – Passing the 900 metres had to be steadied off the heels of ETOSHA which had laid in.

UNDER HIS EYE – Held up for a clear run rounding the home turn and until the 200 metres.

GENERAL

Rider R Tan was reprimanded under the provisions of AR127(1) for failing to fulfill his riding engagement at the Devonport Race Meeting on the 16th July, 2023.
