Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – LADBROKES OWNERS INCENTIVE 3YO MAIDEN – (1100 METRES)

CARNELIAN ROCK – Bumped on jumping when TIGERS ON TOP shifted in.

GEE GEES ME BOY – Bounded on jumping and over-raced in the early stages. Shifted in over the concluding stages.

GEE GEES RUN OUT – Held up momentarily near the 100 metres and shifted wider to obtain a clear run.

TIGERS ON TOP – Shifted in on jumping bumping CARNELIAN ROCK.

YOU BETTER RUN – Jumped awkwardly and brushed the inside barrier gate.

RACE 2 – RACING CONNECT MAIDEN 3YO & UP – (1400 METRES)

ALITTLEDRINKY - Began awkwardly and shifted in bumping heavily with Church Bells.

ALPINE TROUT – Threw its head up on jumping and was slow to begin. Hung in for the entire home straight.

AUNTIE JAKE'S BAR – Held up on the home turn.

CARTOON GRAVEYARD – Bumped with GRANDEZZA near the 700 meters. Rider D Pires pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(ii) in that he used his whip on 8 occasions prior to the 100 metres and 11 occasions inside the 100 metres, three more than permitted over-all. After considering submissions on penalty, including his guilty plea, record in relation to this rule and that he had won the race. Rider D Pires had his licence to ride in races suspended for 1 Tasmanian race date, to commence midnight September 3rd 2023 and expire midnight 10th September 2023.

GEEGEES SUNSHINE – Raced wide throughout.

ALPINE LEGEND – Declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 12.13pm after it was kicked in the ribs on right hand side behind the barriers. Trainer J Luttrell was advised that the gelding must undergo a pre-race veterinary examination prior to its next race start. On the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered that all monies invested on ALPINE LEGEND be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to all successful wagers placed prior to 12.13pm.

Stewards ordered that the following deductions would apply:

1 st – CARTOON GRAVEYARD	1c Win 1c Place
2 nd – WHIZ BY	1c place
3 rd – MONTE FLEUR	2c place.

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the tickets.

CHURCH BELLS – Bumped on jumping.

GRANDEZZA – Raced four wide throughout. Bumped with CARTOON GRAVEYARD near the 700 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow recovery rate.

MONTE FLEUR – Rider reported that the mare over raced in the early stages.

RACE 3 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK MAIDEN 3YO & UP – (1400 METRES)

KING KURT – Slow to muster early speed.

ROYAL SCOTCH – Shifted out near the 200 meters and brushed with BATTLE AWARD.

MURPHY'S KNIGHT – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 4 – HOBART UNITED FC CLASS 1 HCP – (1400 METRES)

MIRROR ONE (NZ) – Raced three wide in the early and middle stages.

WANDERBETOUGH – Fractious in the barriers and slow to begin. Laid in throughout the home straight.

CRYSTAL PALLAZO – Compounded over the concluding stages.

EVELINA ROSE – Declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 11.53am due to atrial fibrillation. Trainer R Hall was advised that the mare must complete a 1000 metre gallop and have a veterinary clearance with the result of an ECG before trialling or racing again. On the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered that all monies invested on EVELINA ROSE refunded, with the following deductions to apply to all successful wagers placed prior to 11.53am.

Stewards ordered that the following deductions would apply:

1 st – ADACHI	2c Win	3c Place
2 nd – MIRROR ONE		4c place
3 rd – SMOKIN' HARD		4c place.

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the tickets.

SMOKIN' HARD – Stewards granted permission for rider D Pires to ride 1kg over the allotted weight. Laid in under pressure in the home straight.

BLACK EAGLET – Slow to begin. Over-raced in the early stages.

RACE 5 – KEVIN SHARKIE CLASS 1 HCP – (1600 METRES)

PUNTER – Raced three wide in the early and middle stages.

LILY LUELLA – Shifted in under pressure near the 250 metres tightening the running of A WEE NIP. Shifted in under pressure near the 150 metres. Apprentice T Stalker was advised to exercise more care in future on both occasions.

A WEE NIP – Checked and lost ground when initially tightened by LILY LUELLA shifting in then WHERE YOU FROM shifting out.

WHERE YOU FROM – Trainer I Miller applied to Stewards for approval for rider B McCoull to ride 1kg over the allotted weight. Ms Miller submitted that rider B McCoull be considered due to him being the regular rider in every Tasmanian start and that the gelding was difficult to ride, and it was her opinion that a senior and strong rider was better suited. Stewards exceeded to the request on this occasion. Raced three wide without cover from the 700 metres. Shifted out near the 250 metres tightening the running of A WEE NIP. Rider B McCoull was advised to exercise more care in future. When questioned on the below market expectations performance rider B McCoull stated that his mount did not respond to his riding in the home straight and that the distance of today's race may not have suited.

RACE 6 – WELLINGTON CRICKET CLUB BM68 HCP - (1600 METRES)

SUPER SWOOP – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

HOT RELATION - Laid out under pressure in the home straight.

UBRIACO – Blundered on jumping. Rider K Sanderson stated that the gelding failed to respond to his riding in the home straight and the trainer will now send the horse for a short spell. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

SUNSET GUN – Shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.

RACE 7 - AYC NETBALL CLUB BM60 HCP - (2400 METRES)

ALWAYS A WINNER – Bounded on jumping unbalancing the rider.

RENASCENCE – Apprentice C Wells reported that she accidentally dropped her reins near the 400 metres.

REWARD FOR ROSIE – Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

RACE 8 – MONTAGU BAY CRICKET CLUB BM60 HCP – (1400 METRES)

MR FREEZE – Over-raced early and middle stages, raced three wide throughout.

JEREMIAH – Shifted in under pressure in the home straight.

BRINKTOP LAD – Raced wide throughout.

LORD WHITEGATE – Over-raced in the early and middle stages. When questioned rider A Darmanin stated that racing in restricted room didn't assist with the horse's manners. A warning was issued on the racing manners of the gelding.

RACE 9 – LADBROKE IT! CLASS 2 HCP – (1200 METRES)

BOLD INSTINCT – Laid in over the concluding stages.

BELLASARIO - Rider S Carr accidentally dropped her whip near the 100 metres.

GEEGEES MISTY – Stewards granted permission for rider B McCoull to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight. Rider B McCoull reported that his mount failed to respond to his riding over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a slow recovery rate.

BETTER THAN BANKSY – Slow to begin.

VOLKANOVSKI – Apprentice C Van Munster was spoken to in relation to allowing her mount to shift out on the home turn allowing an inside run to her own detriment. She was also advised that she must ensure that she rides her mounts out fully to the winning post.
