SUGOI ALTO – Slow to begin. Hung in rounding the home turn on the first occasion and contacted the marker pegs.

RACE 2 – KING ISLAND HOTEL PACE– 1680M MOBILE

SANJE COLLINS – Driver B Davis reported to the stewards on returning to scale, that the gelding had jumped the crossing, and in doing so the spreaders had become unbuckled, and as such he elected to ease

down and retire from the event. Trainer P Jakowenko was reprimanded under rule AHRR 273(2)(b) for presenting the gelding to race with insecure gear.

ARMA ROLLING STONE – Worked forward in the middle stages to race outside the leader.

FIGHTING FIRE – Broke gait briefly on the home turn.

King Island Pacing Club, 11th January 2025, Race 5

Drivers Shane Keeler, James Jakowenko, and Peter Jakowenko all pleaded guilty to charges under AHRR 231(2) Misconduct. The particulars of the charges being that during and following Race 5, drivers J and P Jakowenko engaged in abusive language towards S Keeler, who also had engaged in provocative behaviour himself in the saddling paddock, causing the incident to continue on in the stabling area, before being intercepted by stewards. After taking evidence from all parties, as well as eyewitnesses L Keeler, I Styles, ,After taking submissions on penalty stewards issued the following penalties

Mr Shane Keeler \$750 (\$500 suspended for 2 years)

Mr James Jakowenko \$1500 (\$1000 suspended for 2 years)

Mr Peter Jakowenko \$1500 (\$1000 suspended for 2 years)
