Comments / Explanations:

Due to high temperatures expected the hot weather protocols were implemented with race times amended to the following:

- R2 – 11:16pm

- R7 – 2:12pm
- R8 – 2:47pm
- R9 – 3:22pm

Trainer G Stevenson was fined \$50 under the provisions of LR 13.3 for a late rider declaration on Steele My Sunshine, race 4.

RACE 1 – 10:43AM – Pre Cup Luncheon @ the Country Club Tasmania Maiden – (1400 METRES)

TOWERING INFERNO	The gelding had an offside shoe replaced on arrival at the track, undergoing a veterinary examination. Jumped awkwardly, shifting out and bumped heavily with another runner and blundering.
DAD SAID YES	Slow to begin. Rider M Ulucinar reported the gelding rode greenly throughout.
HARTFELT	After being placed in the barriers the gelding got its near foreleg over the partition. The gelding was consequently removed, undergoing a veterinary examination being passed fit to start. A warning was placed on the gelding for its barrier manners. This incident delayed the start of the race by approximately 2 minutes.
HIGH TAIL EAGLE	Bumped shortly after the start. Over raced in the early and middle stages.
MANHATTAN NIGHTS	Raced four wide in the middle stages of the race.
PROSPEROUS MISS	Raced four wide in the early stages of the race.
TALK LIKE THAT	Laid in under pressure over the concluding stages. Rider H McCarthy reported the mare raced greenly throughout.
KISSED BY MIST	Jumped awkwardly at the start. Momentarily held up near the 100 metres and shifted outwards to improve.

RACE 2 – 11:16AM – Ladbrokes Launceston Cup 26th February Maiden – (1200 METRES)

TROTSKY	The gelding raced four wide without cover.
BUSINESISBUSINESS	Jumped awkwardly and dipped shortly after the start. The gelding raced wide in the early and middle stages of the race.
ORPHAN EAGLE	After being slow into stride the gelding trailed the field throughout despite the urgings of the rider. The gelding underwent a post-race veterinary examination. Advice from on-course Veterinarians reported the gelding to be shin sore in the near fore. The gelding has been stood down from racing and trailing until a veterinary clearance is received.
CAUGHT ALIGHT	Reluctant to load. A warning was placed on the mare for its barrier manners.
PEAK A BOOM	Shortly after the start from its wide barrier the mare was restrained and taken back behind the field. The mare raced wide from the 400 metres.
TAKEAWAY	Stewards granted permission for rider K Sanderson to ride 1/2kg overweight. Reluctant to load. A warning was placed on the mare for its barrier manners. The mare raced greenly in the early and middle stages of the race.

VANSITTART Fractious in the barriers.

HEART OF PARIS The mare raced keenly in the early and middle stages of the race, shifting ground under pressure approaching the 100 metres.

RACE 3 – 11:50AM – Magic Millions 2YO Classic – (1200 METRES)

YUKONROC Enroute to the barriers the gelding dislodged its rider and got loose. The gelding was recaptured undergoing a veterinary examination. The gelding was a late scratching at 11:47am on veterinary advice. Trainers I & N Hay were advised that the gelding must complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again.

ZANY GIRL Jumped outwards and bumped another horse at the start. The filly raced three wide in the middle stages of the race. On pulling up and returning to scale the filly bawlked, dislodging its rider who took an apparent harmless fall. Rider A Darmanin underwent a routine check by Medical Edge.

BELLA CHINKARA Bumped shortly after the start, racing wide around the home turn.

STAR FORTIAN Over raced shortly after jumping. Rider advised the filly dislodged its near fore shoe at approximately the 600 metres hitting its under belly. The filly underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

SANNIYA Commenced awkwardly.

SKY OF GOLD Shortly after the start from its wide barrier the filly was restrained and taken back behind the field.

In relation to the late scratching of Yukonroc, on the announcement of correct weight stewards ordered that all monies invested on Yukonroc be refunded, with deductions to apply to all successful wagers placed prior to 11:47am. Stewards ordered that the following deductions would apply:

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at the face value of the tickets.

RACE 4 – 12:26PM – Ladbrokes Form Genius Class 1 Handicap - (1200 METRES)

MASTRETTA Bumped shortly after the start.

WHIPPIN PICCADILLY Began awkwardly, shifted out and bumped with another runner. The filly shifted out in the home straight.

SPECIALIZED Three wide in the early stages of the race.

GIE IT LALDY The mare stood flat footed and refused to jump. Trainer Mrs M Dalco was advised the mare must complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again. Trainer advised the mare was in season.

CAPABELLA Reared on jumping and raced ungenerously in the early stages with the rider having some difficulty getting the mare to settle and as a consequence raced wide in the middle stages of the race. Passing the 250 metres had a tendency to lay in with the rider using the whip in the left hand. Stewards advised rider Miss L Annells that in similar circumstances in future she is expected to make every effort to keep her mount straight. Further Miss Annells was reminded of her obligations in relation to the height of her whip use.

LOVE NEST Dwelt at the start. The mare was momentarily held up at the 300 metres.

RACE 5 – 1:20PM – Kevin Sharkie Class 3 Handicap - (1100 METRES)

GOLDEN MEADOW Slow to begin.

BELPINE MISS Slow to begin, racing three wide in the middle stages of the race.

VOLKANOVSKI Resaddled behind the barriers prior to the start.

LIBERTY RAE Stewards granted permission for rider H McCarthy to ride 1kg overweight. The mare raced three wide in the middle stages of the race.

SISTINE Fractious prior to the start of the race. The mare jumped awkwardly and was slow to begin.

RACE 6 – 1:37PM – Magic Millions 3YO/4YO Classic - (1400 METRES)

STARDARMUS Raced three wide down the back straight.

PEROLA Turned its head on jumping making contact with the barriers, losing ground affecting the mares start.

ZOETE'S ROCK Under pressure around the home turn.

The declaration of correct weight was delayed while the Stewards viewed vision of the start of this race. It was established that Perola (C Newitt) had turned its head and made contact with the inside barrier partition as the start was effected, resulting in the mare losing considerable ground. In accordance with AR204, after taking into account the mares 2nd place, correct weight was declared. Rider C Newitt underwent a post medical examination and was passed fit.

RACE 7 – 2:12PM – Book Now for the Kreglinger Corporate Marquee BM60 Hcp - (1400 METRES)

PEACE BE UPON HIM Raced wide leading up to the home turn. When questioned, rider Miss L Bingley, explained that the gelding travelled well throughout however when asked for an effort in the straight failed to respond and laboured from there on.

FROM PANTHERLAND Underwent a post-race veterinarian examination with no abnormalities detected.

CORNELIAN BAY Raced wide in the early stages.

SPEED ROCK Raced wide in the middle stages.

IBUTHO

Restrained at the start to take up a position closer to the rail.

Trainer Mr J Blacker fined \$50 under the provisions of AR194 for Miss Pebbles being late into the mounting yard.

Apprentice J Johnstone (Did You Decide) accompanied by a senior rider, A Darmanin, appeared before the stewards in regard to the ride of his mount in the home straight. Apprentice Johnstone explained approaching and in the early stages of the home straight, had been riding his mount along, however near the 200 metres he was of the opinion that he did not have the room to progress and consequently steadied his mount as he was concerned he had insufficient room to improve into. Over the final 100 metres when clear he then rode his mount out. Stewards accepted his explanation but reminded Apprentice Johnstone of his obligations to ensure he is giving his mount every chance of finishing in the best possible position, mindful of the safety of himself, other riders and horses.

RACE 8 – 2:57PM – Art Hotel Sydeston Cup - (2100 METRES)

DISTRUSTFUL AWARD Slow away.

SUSHI EXPRESS Steadied when improving on to heels at the 1100 metres. Approaching the 1800 metres momentarily steadied and closed to heels.

RISING LIGHT Rider K Sanderson dropped his whip at the 150 metres.

MOVEFORLEX Lost its rear hind shoe during the race.

DANTES (NZ) Over raced at the 1200 metres. Steadied off the heels of another horse in the back straight.

WELDBOROUGH Four wide in the middle stages. Passing the 250 metres the gelding was carried inwards by another runner and got bumped.

MYWORDIS Passing the 250 metres the gelding made contact with another runner to its outside and shifted inwards.

Trainer Mr G Hodges was fined \$50 under the provisions of AR194 for Sushi Express being late in the mounting yard.

RACE 9 – 3:22PM – SEN Punters Marquee Cup Day BM66 Hcp - (1200 METRES)

BOLD INSTINCT Bumped at the start.

ETHICAL DILEMMA Approaching the 100 metres was held up and shifted inwards to obtain clear running.

CAPTAIN CAM On jumping bumped another runner.

WHEELING Trainer Mr G McCulloch advised the gelding got it's off fore leg over the partition in the race day stall. Subsequently undergoing a pre-race veterinary examination, after having tips fitted and was passed fit to start. Passing the 200 metres shifted outwards under pressure with the rider putting his whip away and straightening his mount.

NGAPALI BEACH Over raced in the early stages. The mare was attended to by the on-course veterinarians for signs of heat stress.

PEPPARONI

Slow to muster. Over the final 100 metres had difficulty obtaining clear running.

Apprentice Miss E Byrne-Burke (Periwinkle) was questioned over the disappointing performance of her mount. Apprentice Byrne-Burke explained that she had elected to race just behind the pace and had travelled well throughout but when asked for an effort on straightening the mare had failed to respond and had been disappointing. A post-race veterinary examination revealed suspected 'tying up' and was subsequently treated.
