Comments / Explanations:

Trainer J Keys was fined \$50 under the provisions of LR13.3 for the late rider declaration of ALPINE KATE in Race 8.

RACE 1 - 6.00PM - TASMANIAN HOSPITALITY ASSOCIATION MDN PLATE- 1200m

2 MAY WE ALL Raced four-wide in from the 800 metres.

3 SMART ARTIE A post-race veterinary exanimation revealed no obvious

abnormalities.

6 NO ARGUMENT Raced fiercely between the 1000m and the 800 meters.

7 SMASH'N GRAB Bumped by another runner upon jumping.

Rider K Boxall reported post race that the mare may have been stepping a bit short in her action after crossing the finish line. Stewards ordered a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

9. VANSITTART It was a late scratching at 2.58pm when the mare showed

signs of suffering from colic. Trainer was advised that a veterinary certificate will need to be tendered before the

mare is nominated to race again.

11. BILLIE THE GREAT Restrained off heels of another runner at the 800 meters.

A post race swab sample was taken from this winner of the

event.

12. DUBAI AFFAIR Jumped out at the start, bumping with SMASH'N GRAB.

Over-race early and middle stages. Shifted wider at the 600

meters to obtain clear running.

RACE 2 – 6:30PM –PIZZA, PARMI & CURRY NIGHT 4TH APRIL HCP- (1400 METRES)

2 WILLINGLY Bumped by another runner upon jumping.

A post race swab sample was taken from this winner.
Rider A Darmanin pleaded guilty to a charge under provisions of rule AR132(7)(a)(i) for using his whip in

consecutive strides. Stewards fined jockey Mr. A Darmanin

a sum of \$100 fine and took his good record into consideration when deliberating on penalty.

3 SHE'S SLICK Bumped by another runner upon jumping.

5 DIESEL'S SUNSHINE Inconvenienced upon jumping and forced inwards.

6 LAST TREMBLE Jumped in at the start, carrying DIESEL SUNSHINE, inwards

onto CARNELIAN ROCK who in turn bumped with SHE'S

SLICK. Also Raced wide throughout the event.

8 CARNELIAN ROCK Bumped by another runner upon jumping.

9 GIE IT LALDY Stood flat footed and missed the start by a considerable

distance. Trainer M Dalco was advised the mare would be required to complete one satisfactory trial prior to its next race start. Stewards considered the mares previous record

when determining a penalty.

10 IKIGAI KATSUMI Over-raced in the early stages of the event.

12 VALIANT KHAN Raced four wide with cover in the middle stages.

13 ENCOUNTER SPHERE Stewards granted permission for jockey J Beriman to ride 1

kg over the allotted minimum weight. Stewards reminded Miss Beriman of her obligations to only accept rides that

she can make the weight.in future.

14 SYRUP Raced four-wide middle stages with cover.

RACE 3 – 7.00PM – LADBROKES FORM GENIUS HCP- (1600 METRES)

1 HARTFELT Steward's spoke to rider J Beriman in relation to the geldings

below market expectation. Miss. Beriman stated that HARTFELT tended to lay out throughout the run and failed to respond to her riding when placed under pressure over the concluding stages. Stewards spoke to trainer Mr. A Trinder regarding the below market performance. Mr. Trinder was unable to provide any explanation and stated that he would monitor the gelding on returning to his stable. Stewards noted their comments for

future reference.

2 LONTANO Restrained after the start to take a position closer to the rail.

Shifted in and brushed with another runner around the 50 meters. A post race swab sample was taken from this winner.

5 HUBUBBAJAHN Over-raced throughout the event.

Stewards questioned rider A Darmanin over the mares below market expectations. Mr. Darmanin stated that his mount over-raced for the entirety of the race and was unable to restrain back to a trailing position to try and settle the mare. He further stated that he placed the mare under pressure, and it failed to respond to his riding over the concluding stages. Mr. Darmanin advised

that he believed the mare would benefit from a spell. Stewards questioned trainer B McShane regarding the

disappointing performance of the mare. Mr. McShane stated that he was at a loss to explain the performance and, based on the performance, he would be speaking to all connections before deciding whether the mare will be spelled. Stewards noted their

comments for future reference.

6 THE TAZWEGIAN Bumped with TOSEN FAME at the start.

7 TOSEN FAME Jumped awkwardly, bumping with THE TAZWEGIAN.

Raced three-wide throughout the evet.

10 LOVE NEST Held up for a clear run from the home turn until the 100 metres.

11 WHOLESOME Caught racing three-wide rounding the 1200 metre turn. Brushed

with LONTANO at about the 50 meters.

RACE 4 - 7:05PM - Tasbred Racenight 11th April Class 1 Hcp - (1200 METRES)

1 KAGISO Bumped with another runner upon jumping.

3 NUMBERONESTYLEGUY Stewards ordered a post race veterinary examination of the

gelding which revealed no obvious abnormalities at the time of

inspection.

4 SON GUKU Upon straightening, shifted out over the heels of FLORENCE

GLASS to get a clear run resulting in MANHATTAN NIGHTS being taken outwards and DIAMOND SUNRISE having to restrain off heels. Stewards reminded rider L Annells of her obligations in future she must be sufficiently clear when shifting ground Stewards took Jockey L Annels' good record in consideration in

this incident.

5 MANHATTEN NIGHTS Bumped and carried outwards upon jumping. Carried outwards

rounding the home turn.

6 MERLIN BEACH Shifts outwards upon jumping bumping another runner.

7 DIAMOND SUNRISE Raced three-wide with cover in the middle and later stages.

Restrained off heels shortly after rounding the home turn.

8 FLORENCE GLASS Caught racing three-wide rounding the 1200 meters turn and

continued to race three-wide throughout the event.

A post race swab sample was taken from this winner of the

event.

RACE 5 - 7:35PM - RACING ON GOOD FRIDAY (BM68)- (1400 METRES)

2 CARNEROS Held up in the early stages of the home straight. A post race

swab sample was taken from this winner.

3 MUSCLE UP Shifts in on jumping, bumping with RIGOLETTO. Raced three-

wide throughout.

4 DAYAN STAR Stood flat footed and missed the start by four lengths.

Disappointed for run for the entirety of the home straight. Stewards questioned rider A Darmanin regarding the riding tactics that were adopted in this event. Mr. Darmanin stated that after the gelding jumped poorly, he was unable to gain a forward position and had to ride for luck. He further stated that on entering the home straight he was unable to gain a clear run,

and a gap never eventuated despite his attempts.

Stewards, after viewing the official patrol films and acting on their own observations and taking into consideration the evidence tendered at the inquiry stewards noted Mr.

Darmanin's comments for further reference and will monitor

the geldings future race starts.

6 LORD WHITEGATE Over-raced middle stages.

8 RIGOLETTO Bumped with MUSCLE UP on jumping.

RACE 6-8.30PM - KEVIN SHARKIE HCP (3) - 1200m

1 GLORY MISSION On straightening, was disappointed for the run between GEE

GEES ME BOY and LADY GALADRIEL, when GEE GEES ME BOY shifted ground inwards restricting the racing room. Was held up for a clear run over the vital stages of the event before only gaining a clear run over the final 50m and ran home strongly.

2 LADY GALADRIEL Over-raced early stages of the event.

3 GEE GEES ME BOY Fractious in the barriers prior to the start.

Bumped with CHEROKEE DANCER at the start.

Raced three-wide throughout the event. Shifted inwards over the concluding stages, inconveniencing another runner.

5 CHEROKEE DANCER Shifts outwards on jumping, bumping with GEE GEES ME BOY.

Apprentice J Radley reported that he accidentally dropped his

whip at the 200 meters.

6. DANCING WOLF A post race swab sample was taken from this winner.

8 CAPABELLE Stewards questioned rider L Annells as to the tactics adopted

particularly in the run to the finish. Miss L Annells stated that she was momentarily held up behind DANCING WOLF entering the home straight and was reluctant to take a run to the inside of that filly when it presented, because she believed there was insufficient racing room. Ms. L Annells further stated that she eventually took a tight run to the inside of DANCING WOLF in

the straight and that her mount brushed the rail on several occasions in the run to the finish. Stewards noted Miss. Annells comments for future reference.

RACE 7 - 9.00PM - LADBROKES PUNTER ASSIST HCP (60) - (1200 METRES)

1 SPEED ROCK Over-raced early stages. Momentarily tightened for room at the

900m. Raced four-wide in the middle stages in the event.

2 I'M KEEFE Caught three-wide early.

3 NO ACCESS Slow into stride and muster early speed. A post race swab sample

was taken from this winner.

4 SWINGING IT Brushed with GEEGEES MISTY shortly after the start. Over-raced

early stages of the event. Tended to shift outwards slightly at the

1000 meters.

6 GEEGEES MISTY Brushed with SWINGING IT shortly after the start. Shifted inwards

around 1000 meters, tightening SPEED ROCK in onto MISS TANZENITE. Continued to lay inwards at the 900meters.

7 POWER MAGNUM Shifted inwards marginally at 1000m

Rider fined for his whip use in the home straight.

8 MISS TANZANITE Bounded on jumping.

Stewards questioned riders D Pires (SPEED ROCK), Apprentice J Radley (POWER MAGNUM), B Muchu (GEEGEES MISTY) and Apprentice J Johnston (SWINGING IT) into an incident racing to the 1100 metres where Mr. B Muchu and Mr. D Pires were tightened for room and had to restrain their mounts. Stewards, after considering all the evidence tendered at the inquiry, viewing the official patrol films and considering their own observations, could not attribute the incident to any one rider. Stewards considered the racing manners of SWINGING IT and POWER MAGNUM who were over racing at the time despite efforts from the riders.to restrain and as such stewards deemed this a racing incident and no action was taken against rider or horse..

Stewards questioned apprentice J Radley, in the presence of Master J Blacker into his whip use in the home straight on POWER MAGNUM. Apprentice J Radley pleaded guilty to a charge under AR132(7)(a)(ii), where he used his whip nine times prior to the 100 meters, and a further 10 times before the finish. Stewards after taking into consideration submissions on penalty from trainer and jockey and taking into consideration his previous record issued apprentice J. Radley a \$400 fine.

Apprentice J Radley, in the presence of Master J Blacker pleaded guilty to a further charge under AR132(7)(a)(i), where he used his whip on consecutive strides on several occasions over the concluding stages of the event. Stewards considered his previous record under this rule and issued Apprentice J. Radley a \$200 fine.

Stewards adjourned an inquiry into an incident at 900m where riders had to ease their mounts. The riders required are S Clarke (I'm Keefe), Apprentice J Johnson (swinging it), B Muchu (Gee Gees Misty), D Pirez (Speed Rock) and apprentice J Radley (Power Magnum). This inquiry will continue at a date to be fixed.

RACE 8 - 9:33PM - SALTERS HIRE- (BM60 Hcp) - (2100 METRES)

3 MATEUS Over-raced in the early stages of the event.

5 ALPINE KATE Over-raced early stages of the event. Raced three-wide

throughout the event with no cover.

6 DOONICAN Stewards questioned trainer J Blacker as to the improved

performance of the gelding in tonight's event given the geldings previous average form. Trainer J Blacker could not offer any real explanation and was surprised with tonight's winning result. Mr. Blacker further advised that his apprentice J Radley rode the gelding with a well timed run and further stated the gelding galloped well during the week which could be a contributing factor in today's improved performance. Stewards noted Mr. J Blacker's comments for future reference and will be monitoring it next race starts. A post race swab sample was taken from this

winner.
