RACE 1 – 5.55PM– LADBROKES RACING CLUB MAIDEN PLATE- 1100 METRES

- 1. HOTAPPLEPIE-** Underwent a pre race veterinarian examination and passed fit to take its place in the field.
Jumped inwards at the start and was slow to muster early speed.
Raced 4 wide from the 800m to the 400m.

Over raced in the early stages and got its head up and raced ungenerously. |

RACE 2 – 6.30PM – EASTER EGG GIVEAWAY FRIDAY MDN PLATE - 1600 METRES

| 6. MANHATTAN NIGHTS- | Slow to begin. Rolled inwards marginally at the 500m momentarily tightening another runner. |
| 7. MERLIN BEACH- | Raced 4 wide from the 800m to the 400m. Laid inwards in the home straight when struck with the whip resulting in the rider having to stop and straighten. |
| 8. DIAMOND SUNRISE- | Raced three wide in the early and middle stages of the event. |
| 9. LOVES THE TRIP- | It was restrained at the start to take a position closer to the rail. |
| 10. ICE CRYSTAL- | A post race swab sample was taken from this winner. |

The announcement of correct weight was delayed as rider L Annells placed in 4th place wished to view the photo finish between 3rd and 4th place. After viewing the official photo finish, jockey Annells was satisfied with the judge's placings, and the announcement of correct weight was declared.

3. **BUNKER JAKO-** Over raced in the early stages. A post race swab sample was taken from this winner.
4. **SMASH "N" GRAB-** Raced 4 wide from the 600m to the 300m. tended to lay inwards in the home straight.
8. **VANSITTART-** Reared upon jumping and as a result was slow into stride and missed it by 2 to 3 lengths.
9. **DUBAI AFFAIR-** Shifted inwards upon jumping.
Shifted out under pressure in the home straight carrying another runner wider.
5. **SURPRISE SECRET-** Tightened between runners shortly after the start.

RACE 4 – 7.30PM – TASBRED RACE APRIL HCP -1200 METRES

1. **SANDUAL-** Raced 4 wide from the 800m.
4. **FLYING BILLY-** Tended to over race in the early stages and shifted outwards under pressure in the home straight. A post race swab sample was taken from this winner.
2. **BOUNTY BAY-** Jumped outwards at the start and was slow to muster early speed.

RACE 5 – 8.00PM – GOOD FRIDAY RACES APRIL - 1100 METRES

2. **CHEROKEE DANCER-** Tended to shift outwards under pressure over the concluding stages brushing another runner. A post race swab sample was taken from this winner.
4. **MOHNAR-** The Trainer was questioned regarding the tactics adopted in this event.
6. **GUNSHIP-** The trainer was questioned regarding the tactics adopted in this event.
8. **CAPABELLE-** Jumped outwards at the start and was slow away. Tended to shift inwards under pressure brushing another runner.

Stewards questioned trainer R Hamer into the tactics of his two runners in tonight's event. Mr. R Hamer explained that he instructed his riders to try and lead or sit outside the leader. He said his

instructions were followed by his riders and MOHNAR gained the lead, and his other runner GUNSHIP sat outside the leader however when placed under pressure in the home straight they both failed to run on over the concluding stages. Stewards after viewing the official patrol films were satisfied with trainers R Hamers explanations and noted his comments for future reference. Mr. Hamer further advised the stewards he would be reassessing the gelding (GUNSHIPS) future on returning to his stables and believed (MOHNAR) may be looking for further ground.

RACE 6 – 8.30PM– LADBROKES FORM GENIUS HCP - 1400 METRES
