General: Trainer D Tyson was fined \$100 under AR166 for leaving MYWORDIS unattended during the meeting, resulting in the gelding breaking loose in the stripping stalls.

RACE 1 – 12:43PM – Kevin Sharkie Maiden - (1009 METRES)

2 NEED A GIGGLE Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination behind the

barriers at the riders' request and was subsequently declared a late scratching at 12:42pm when found to be lame in the off hind. On the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered that all monies invested on NEED A GIGGLE be

refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful

wagers placed prior to 12:42pm.

Stewards ordered that the following deductions would apply:

1st - 5 – PLATINUM REGGAE - 4 cents win, 3 cents place.

2nd - 6 – SIENA WOLF - 6 cents place

3rd – 3 – GEEGEE AUNTY JESS 11 cents place

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of

the tickets.

Connections were advised the mare would be stood down from racing or trialing until stewards receive a veterinary clearance.

3 GEEGEE AUNTY JESS Raced three wide in the early and middle stages.

4 MAKARSKA SUNSET Slow to muster early speed.

5 PLATINUM REGGAE Fractious in the barriers prior to the start. A post race winning

swab sample was taken from the mare.

6 SIENA WOLF Bumped with GEEGEE AUNTY JESS after jumping.

7 ZULU FIELDS Raced three wide in the middle stages. Underwent a post race

veterinary examination which revealed minor skin cuts on the inside near hind cannon, continuous with the gelding being

galloped on during the race.

8 ROCKESTJERNE Reared in the barriers prior to the start. Raced greenly

throughout, tending to over race at stages. Brushed with ZULU FIELDS when making the home turn awkwardly, slightly shifting

outwards.

RACE 2 – 1:19PM – Goodstone Group Class 1 Hcp - (1009 METRES)

2 ZOETE'S ROCK Slow to begin. Held up for a clear run at the 200m behind the

heels of another runner and had to shift inwards to obtain a

clear run.

3 COOL CONQUEST Tended to over race in the early stages.

4 GETCHA GROOVE ON Fractious in the barriers, rearing multiple times. A warning was

placed on the barrier manners of the mare. Raced three wide in the early stages. Underwent a post race veterinary examination

which revealed a small cut on the lower right jaw.

5 KLIMENKO Raced four wide in the early stages. Apprentice L Bingley

reported the filly raced greenly, and she was unable to fully ride her mount out during the run to the finish due to the filly

hanging in when placed under pressure.

6 RED FOX When questioned, jockey A Darmanin told stewards his

instructions were to gain a forward position either leading the event or sitting outside the leader. After the gelding failed to respond to his riding in the early stages, Darmanin reported he found himself further back than he had anticipated. Shifted out on the home turn to gain clear running room, however, ran home strongly. Stewards reminded rider A Darmanin on his obligations of ensuring he is fully clear when shifting ground, after causing ELLISPHERE to steady when entering the home

straight.

7 AMANT FRANCAIS Tended to hang out throughout. Shifted out during the run to

the finish when placed under pressure. A post race winning

swab sample was taken from the filly.

8 ELLISPHERE Raced three wide throughout. Steadied off the heels of RED

FOX when that gelding shifted outwards to gain clear running.

RACE 3 – 1:54PM – Ladbrokes Same Race Multi Maiden - (1350 METRES)

1 BAYSIDE A post race winning swab sample was taken from the gelding.

2 LEO DAVINCI Restrained at the start to take up a position closer to the rail. Over

raced through the early stages.

7 MISS ADELINE Raced greenly, tended to lay out throughout. Made the final turn

awkwardly and shifted out slightly.

RACE 4 – 2:29PM – Tasmanian Horse Transport Class 2 Hcp - (1350 METRES)

2 SPRING BEANA post race winning swab sample was taken from the gelding.

4 BESERKER Jumped inwards at the start, bumping with PEPPARONI twice.

Raced wide throughout. Brushed with SPEED ROCK entering the

home straight.

5 PEPPARONI Jumped outwards at the start, bumping with BESERKER twice.

6 ZUNI Laid out sharply when encouraged by the whip in the home

straight.

7 RUBICK'S AFFAIR Commenced to over race at the 800 meters.

8 SPEED ROCK Stewards granted permission for jockey D Pires to ride 1 kg over

the allotted minimum weight. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was subsequently passed fit to take its place in the field. Rider D Pires reported the gelding hung out throughout. Brushed with BESERKER entering the home straight. Underwent a post race veterinary examination which revealed no abnormalities.

9 UNVANQUISHABLE Stewards granted permission for apprentice L Bingley to ride

without taking any portion of her claim, due to trainer J Luttrell having difficulty engaging a rider, and the late notification to apprentice Bingley. Jumped awkwardly, causing apprentice Bingley to contact the outside barrier partition. Over raced and laid out making the turn at the 1200 meters awkwardly. Failed to run on when placed under pressure, compounding over the

concluding stages.

RACE 5 - 3:04PM - Happy Easter BM68 Hcp - (1350 METRES)

1 CARNEROSRaced three wide throughout.

3 CAPTAIN CAM Shifted in over the concluding stages when under pressure,

apprentice J Radley had to stop riding to straighten his mount. A post race winning swab sample was taken from the gelding.

4 MYWORDIS Disappointed for a clear run in the early stages of the home

straight and had to shift wider to obtain clear running room.

7 SUGOI LEGEND Slow to begin.

9 RING OF HONOUR Raced three wide throughout. Underwent a post race

veterinary examination which revealed blood in the offside nostril. Connections were advised the gelding must complete a

1000 meter gallop and obtain a veterinary certificate of clearance before racing again. Trainer R Hamer advised connections would be reviewing the gelding's racing future.

RACE 6 – 3:39PM – Tasmanian Horse Transport Class 4 Hcp - (1150 METRES)

2 BLOOMTIME Fractious in the barriers. Slow to begin.

3 CHEROKEE DANCER Shifted out when entering the home straight, tightening

BLOOMTIME out onto GEEEGEE CITY BOY, causing that mare to steady momentarily. Stewards reprimanded apprentice C Pang, under AR131(a), for careless riding, in that he failed to stop

riding and straighten his mount.

4 MOVE ON OVER Raced wide throughout.

6 LIBERTY RAE Slow to begin.

7 STARS IN THE NIGHT A post race winning swab sample was taken from the mare.

RACE 7 - 4:14PM - The Stables at Spreyton- BM60 Hcp - (1880 METRES)

1 CHICANE Raced three wide in the early stages.

2 AL MAXIMUS Tended to over race and hung out throughout the event.

3 COUP DE SPRY Rider K Sanderson reported the gelding didn't travel well

throughout the run. Stewards will contact the trainer to get a report as the gelding had left the course when the vet went to

inspect it.

11 SOUTHERN WIND Disappointed for a clear run in the early stages of the home

straight. Raced in restricted room over the concluding stages,

brushing with DOONICAN (IRE) at the winning post.

13 POP A HONDA Resaddled behind the barriers at the rider's request. Held up

for a clear run in the early stages of the home straight, shifting

wider to obtain a clear room.
