RACE 1 – 12:00PM – Ladbrokes Form Genius 2yo Maiden - (1150 METRES)

1 ONLY FOR A MINUTE Raced greenly in the early and middle stages, three wide without cover.

Laid in over the concluding stages.

2 ROCKESTJERNE Raced wide until 600 metres.

4 BABY PANDA When questioned on the filly's performance today rider G Catania stated

Baby Panda had not raced on the synthetic surface before and resented

the kick-back.

RACE 2 – 12:35PM – Goodstone Group Maiden - (1150 METRES)

2 SPARK OF FINE Hung out making the home turn.

4 GENUINE LADY Bounded on jumping Made the home turn awkwardly and shifted out

abruptly to race tightly with VANSTITTART.

6 VANSITTART Rider G Catania reported that her mount hung out for the majority of the

event and she was unable to ride it out in her usual manner. A post-race

veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

7 VIXEN'S MOON Vixen's Moon jumped awkwardly.

RACE 3 – 1:10PM – Tasmanian Horse Transport Class 1 Handicap - (1150 METRES)

3 GETCHA GROOVE ON Reared on jumping and subsequently tailed the field in the back straight

until the 800 metres. Raced wide making the home turn.

5 PLATINUM REGGAE Declared a late scratching at 11.43 am on veterinary advice after

becoming cast in the race day stalls. A veterinary certificate will be

required prior to racing again.

6 RED FOX Tightened between runners on jumping.

7 BILLIE THE GREAT Rider J Johnstone's whip became momentarily entangled in the near side

rein entering the home straight.

8 WILD NIGHTS Permission given to be ridden 1kg overweight. Over-raced in the middle

stages and hung in in the home straight.

RACE 4 – 1:45PM – Kevin Sharkie Maiden/Class 1 - (1650 METRES)

2 ROCHEAUX Inconvenienced entering the home straight when Miss Private shifted out.

5 ALPINE TROUT Underwent pre-race veterinary inspection and passed fit to compete

after its near hind leg became cast on the barrier footplate.

6 LEO DAVINCI Restrained after the start to take up a position closer to the rails.

7 MISS PRIVATE Bumped with ROCHEAUX entering the straight and then continued to

shift out momentarily inconveniencing that runner. Apprentice L Bingley

was advised to exercise more care when shifting ground.

RACE 5 – 2:20PM – Stall Gate Kiosk Class 1 Handicap - (1350 METRES)

3 MEGA MIC Rider A Darmanin pleaded guilty to a charge was fined \$200 under AR 132

(7)(a)(i) for using the whip on two consecutive occasions prior to the 100

metres.

4 RED ROWIE Steadied off the heels of the tiring ICE CRYSTAL near the 50 metres

5 STAR WALKIN' Raced three wide to the 600 metres.

7 DYNAMIC DEEL Steadied off the heels.

8 PEAK A BOOM Slow to begin then commenced to over-race in the middle stages.

9 ICE CRYSTAL Tired over the concluding stages.

10 RUBICK'S AFFAIR Over-raced in the early and middle stages.

11 BOUNTY BAY Declared a late scratching at 8.35am when trainer D Clark advised that he

had not received notification that the horse had gained a start in this race.

RACE 6 – 2:55PM – The Stables at Spreyton Class 4 - (1350 METRES)

2 GUNSHIP Late scratching at the barriers when it reared and struck its head. Gunship

has had a warning for its barrier manners issued. Gunship has been stood down from racing until a veterinary certificate stating it is suitable to race

is received.

3 SPRING BEAN Laid in under pressure over the concluding stages.

4 BLOOMTIME Fractious in the barriers. Apprentice C Wells was reprimanded under

132(a) for careless riding when she shifted in from the three wide position to one off the rail near the 800 metres when insufficiently clear of Spring

Bean which had to be steadied.

6 LI'L HAIL MAY Over-raced in the middle stages.

RACE 7 – 3:35PM – Dean Walker Designs BM60 Handicap - (1009 METRES)

1 PEACE BE UPON HIM Slow to begin.

2 WHEELING Compounded from the 400 metres. Rider J Johnstone reported when

questioned that when placed under pressure he felt there was something amiss. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to have a

poor recovery rate.

9 VOLKANOVSKI Obliged to shift wider near the 700 metres when Miss Keeds shifted out.

10 MISS KEEDS Shifted out near the 700 metres and carried VOLKANOVSKI wider.

11 POWER MAGNUM Lost the off-hind plate passing the 700 metres. Checked off the heels of

the tiring Wheeling near the 300 metres.

RACE 8 – 4:10PM – Torque Gear For Guys BM66 Handicap - (1880 METRES)

7 THE PRAYER Rider D Pires was granted permission to ride 1kg over the allotted weight.

8 DOONICAN (IRE) Rider C Catania reported her mount failed to respond to her riding from

the home turn.
