RACE 1 – LADBROKES MATES MODE POTS PACE – 1680m Mobile

**ARRHYTHMIA** – Shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

**QUALIFY** – Raced greenly in the score up then was restrained after the start.

#### RACE 2 – TASSIE WASH PACE– 2200m   Mobile

PARTY BLAZE – raced outside the leader throughout.

CHEAT THE STORM – sulky contacted causing flat tyre at the 500-metre mark.

LIKACHOCCIESHAKE has been placed back in the draw for future mobile events.

VINCENTS RAINBOW – contacted a sulky at the 500-metre mark.

LIKACHOCCIESHAKE – underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring and then being retired from the event. No abnormalities were detected. The gelding has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

*Driver T Ford was fined the sum of \$100 after pleading guilty to a charge under AHRR168(1)(a) for allowing her horse to contact the tyre of CHEAT THE STORM.*

#### RACE 3 –PACING FOR PINK STAKES – 1680m   Mobile

THE IRON LADY NZ - hung in shortly after the start.

SPORTS WRACK – was held up in the vital stages then locked wheels with BELIEVE IN FOREVER on the home turn.

LOU BABY NZ - was detained on course for 2.5 hours to enable post-race samples to be taken

#### RACE 4 – LEES ORCHARD STAKES– 2200m   Mobile

HURRICANE ROCK – galloped away and has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

COLBY SANZ – galloped out and has been placed out of the draw in future standing start events.

THEE OLD BOMB NZ galloped out and will continue out of the draw.

MAJOR LESTER – was held up and unable to gain clear running.

BOLD CENTURIAN – was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

THEE OLD BOMB NZ - was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

RACE 5 – PACING FOR PINK PACE– 2200m   Mobile

**BINALONG BAY** – over-raced and pulled hard during the event.

**GOODTIME OSCAR** – driver inconvenienced when BINALONG BAY raced up onto his sulky after the bell.

**SAPPHIRE GAMBLER** – over-raced during the event.

RACE 6 – LADBROKES LAUNCESTON MILE– 1680m   Mobile

**TRIEDTOTELLYA** – caught wide early then worked forward to race outside the leader.

**JAMES CAGNEY NZ** – hung in and contacted a marker peg rounding the home turn.

**ANOTHER NIEN** – was held up and unable to gain clear running.

RACE 7 – NUTRIEN AG SUPPLIES STAKES– 2200m   Mobile

No racing incidents to report.

RACE 8 – LADBROKES ODDS SURGE STAKES – 1680m   Mobile

**PARK LANE NZ** – tended to hang out in the home straight on the first occasion.

**JUSTIFY** – over-raced during the event.

**MORRIS BROWN** – hung in around the final turn.

RACE 9 – LADBROKES SAME DAY MULTI PACE– 2200m   Mobile

**MISS BARTY** – was out of position at the start and will continue to be out of the draw.

**MISS BARTY** – failed to take any competitive part in the event and has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial. Connections reported that the mare may well be retired from racing.

## RACE 10 – HAPPY MOTHERS DAY PACE– 2200m   Mobile

**SABINE** – shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

**RAY DAN** – held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

**DEFENCE ATTORNEY** underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 57 metres. No abnormalities were detected. The gelding has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

**JUST JAYDO** – underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 63 metres. No abnormalities were detected. The horse has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.
