GENERAL

Prior to the commencement of today's meeting, Tas Racing Integrity unit undertook the practice of pre-race saliva testing of all jockeys competing today, along with licensed personnel entering the Elwick racetrack leading horses. The total number of saliva tests taken throughout the day was 91.

- : 76 saliva tests from licensed personnel handling horses.
- : 15 saliva tests from Jockeys competing at today's meeting.

RACE 1 – 11:19AM – Kevin Sharkie Maiden - (1100 METRES)

Prior to the running of this event trainer Stephen Lockhart advised the stewards that he will be instructing the two jockeys of his runners ROYAL SCENE & WHISPER OF MATILDA to let their mounts find their feet in the early stages and try and save for late runs in the event. A public announcement was made to the effect.

1 EXPOSTAR Over raced in the early and middle stages of the event.

4 ZURICH Jumped outwards at the start bumping with another runner.

Had to be eased off the heels of the runners in front

approaching the 600m.

6 ORISKANY Stewards ordered a post race veterinary examination of this

mare who was supported in the betting and was unplaced. A post race examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

7 ROYAL SCENE Slow into stride because of getting bumped by another runner

upon jumping.

10 TIGERS ON TOP Raced wide throughout.

11 VANSITTART Became fractious in the barriers and reared on several

occasions.

12 WHISPER OF MATILDA A post race swab sample was taken from this winner for

analytical testing.

14 SEND ME GOLD Following the running of this event, Trainer explained that in his

opinion this gelding may have eased at the 800m and lost ground. The Trainer further explained the recent 2yo trials over the 800m were conducted from the 1400m start and they have been pulling up their horses at the 800m and believed that this was the reason why his horse may have eased at this stage in the race. Stewards after viewing the patrol films were satisfied it was marginal, however will discuss the matter with Tas Racing

going forward with 2yo trials.

RACE 2 – 11:51AM – Winning Edge Presentations Maiden/Class 1 - (2100 METRES)

1 HIGH TAIL EAGLE Dwelt at the start missing it by several lengths. A post race swab

sample was taken from this winner for analytical testing.

2 RED ROWIE Failed to run on over the concluding stages. Stewards ordered a

post race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding had a high heart rate with a slow recovery. No other abnormalities were

detected.

4 UNNERVING It had to be steadied off the heels of the runner in front when it

crossed closer to the rails. A post race veterinarian examination

revealed

6 RAGING WATERS Had to be steadied off heels at the 1800m.

7 STERREK

Stewards questioned Apprentice C Pang into reasons when he shifted inwards to gain the lead at the 1500m when not fully clear of UNNERVING (L Annells) resulting in this rider having to ease her mount at this stage. Stewards after viewing the official patrol films and taking the evidence into consideration, Apprentice C Pang was issued with a Severe reprimand and sternly reminded him of his obligations in similar circumstances. Stewards will be discussing these apprentices' rides with apprentice riding advocate Mr. S Maskiell for comments and tutoring. A post race veterinarian examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 3 – 12:25PM – Ladbrokes Form Genius Maiden - (1600 METRES)

3 KING ZEUS Eased by its rider over the concluding stages off heels.

5 MANHATTAN NIGHTS Over raced making the first turn and had to be steadied off the

heels of the runners in front.

6 MAY WE ALL Raced 4 wide with cover throughout and ran wide making the

home turn. Shifted in under pressure over the concluding stages of

the event.

7 RIPPEN GOLD Began slowly. Raced 4 wide in the early stages of the event

9 IN THE CLOUDS Raced 5 wide in the early and middle stages of the event.

10 SURPRISE SECRET Tended to lay outwards at the 1400m.

11 TOORAK TREASURE A post race swab sample was taken from this winner for analytical

testing.

RACE 4 – 1:00PM – The Three Sister's Benchmark 60 Handicap - (1600 METRES)

1 STEEL MIST Had to be resaddled behind the barriers.

2 EARENDEL Laid out under pressure in the home straight. A post race swab

sample was taken from this winner for analytical testing.

5 OPALSON Slow to muster early speed.

9 WADDY WADDY Tended to over race in the early stages of the event. Raced 3

wide.

10 COUP DE SPRY Raced wide throughout.

11 DESIGNER DREAMER Became fractious in the barriers and struck its head. Underwent a

veterinary inspection and passed fit to take its place in the field. A

warning will be issued against the gelding's barrier manners.

12 FIORENTE DE LEGEND Tended to over race in the middle stages of the event. Had to be

steadied off heels making the home straight.

13 I'M KEEFE Bounded away on jumping.

RACE 5 – 1:35PM – Boucher Support Services Class1 Handicap - (1200 METRES)

1 SNOWDONIA Momentarily shifted inwards at the 800m crowding another

runner.

3 THE LAST HURRAH A post race swab sample was taken from this winner for

analytical testing.

4 FIRST LINE Shifted inwards at the 600m and brushed the running rail.

5 RED FOX Crowded room at the 800m.

6 TRANSOM Crowded for room between runners in the home straight after

getting pressure from the outside and inside.

7 COOL CONQUEST Stewards ordered a post race veterinary inspection when the

mare was eased down over the concluding stages of the event by its rider. Post race Veterinary inspection failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Rider reported the mare tended to change legs and was cautious with her action. The trainer advised stewards that on returning to the stables the mare showed no signs of lameness and pulled up well, however will monitor her over the coming days and may go back to the trials

to gain some form on the grass surface.

10 GEEGEE STRAWBERRY Tended to shift outwards in the home straight.

12 OUR INDULGENCE Raced 4 wide throughout the event.

13 PHERE THE GIRLS Stewards granted permission to ride the gelding 1 kg over its

allotted weight.

14 CARNELIAN ROCK Shifted inwards in the home straight crowding another runner.

15 LOVE NEST Slow into stride.

Stewards questioned riders C Jordan (TRANSOM) and T Baker (CARNELIAN ROCK) into reasons why C Jordan had to check her mount in the home straight. Stewards after considering the evidence tendered at the inquiry and acting on their own observations and viewing the official patrol films believed Jockey Troy Baker allowed his horse to shift inwards when being ridden vigorously with the whip resulting in jockey Cody Jordan having to check her mount of the heels of CARNELIAN ROCK. Stewards in not issuing a charge against Jockey T Baker took into consideration that at this stage Jockey Kasi Boxall (GEEGEES STRAWBERRY) had shifted outwards and away from Georgie Catania (CHRISTOPHER ROBIN) and had brushed with the hind quarters of (TRANSOM) and had contributed to this incident. As there were other factors in this incident, the stewards took no action. Jockey T Baker was reminded of his obligations to ensure that when his horses commence to shift ground he stops and straightens.

RACE 6 – 2:10PM – Aviso TAS Insurance Brokers Benchmark 68 Handicap - (1200 METRES)

2 ETOSHA Jumped outwards at the start. failed to run on over the concluding

stages after leading the event.

3 ALPINE THUNDER Jumped outwards at the start, bumping another runner. Tended to

over race in the early stages of the event.

5 FURNEAUX Raced four wide in the early stages. A post race swab sample was

taken from this winner for analytical testing.

8 EASTCOAST MISS Began slowly.

9 MISS KEEDS Bumped upon jumping resulting in the rider becoming unbalanced.

Stewards granted permission for the rider to ride the mare ½ kg

over its allotted weight.

RACE 7 – 2:47PM – Aviso TAS Pink Cup Class 4 - (1400 METRES)

1 HURRICANE KETUT Slow to begin.

3 SH'BOURNE MIDNIGHT Held up for a clear run making the home turn and shifted inwards

to gain a clear run. A post race swab sample was taken from this

winner for analytical testing.

4 AFRICAN THUNDER Bumped upon jumping.

5 JUST A NEEDS Raced wide making the home turn.

9 ROYAL DISPATCH (NZ) Bumped upon jumping. Tended to lay outwards under pressure in

the home straight.

10 GLOBAL AWARENESS Raced in a four wide position in the early stages of the event.

RACE 8 – 3:21PM – Up Cups Open Handicap - (2400 METRES)

1 ZULU ANGEL Slow to muster early speed. Tended to lay outwards under pressure in

the home straight.

2 ASHFALL Stewards questioned the connections of this gelding into the

performance of the favorite in the betting. Connections advised stewards that the gelding may have come to the end of this preparation and will be planning on sending him for an immediate

spell. Stewards noted their comments.

3 HAPPY CLAN Tended to lay outwards under pressure in the home straight. A post

race swab sample was taken from this gelding for analytical testing.

5 DOONICAN (IRE) Stewards agreed for the rider, to ride the gelding 1 kg over its

allotted minimum weight of 54kg.

Stewards questioned rider A Darmanin (ASHFALL) into reasons why he failed to ride his mount fully to the finish line as previously advised by the stewards. Jockey A Darmanin said that he believed he had the fourth place DOONICAN covered in the run and failed to ride with any vigor. Stewards were not satisfied with his explanation and issued him with a severe reprimand and advised him, should he come before the stewards in the future they will be taking action against his license given his previous record. He was reminded of *AR 131: A rider must not, in the opinion of stewards:* (b) fail to ride his or her horse out to the end of the race and / or approaching the end of the race:

RACE 9 - 4:00PM - Mingari + Co 0-62 Rating - (1100 METRES)

1 BAYBOUGG Jumped awkwardly and laid in under pressure in the home straight.

2 ESPRIT DIVA Tightened for room momentarily at the 600m. Held up for a clear run

entering the home turn.

3 NATIVE CLAN Shifted ground outwards abruptly upon jumping. Raced three wide to

the 600m.

8 ARAYA SUNSHINE Laid inwards at the 600m tightening another runner momentarily.

10 LA VIRAGO A post race swab sample was taken from this winner for analytical

testing.

12 TALK SOON Tired over the concluding stages.
