

# Season of success

The Glenn Stevenson-trained First Accused capped a career-best season by being crowned the Ladbrokes Horse of the Year at the annual awards night in Hobart on 5 October.

The seven-year-old son by Turffontein from Keep on Talking won the Newmarket Handicap and Tasmanian Stakes and was placed in the Thomas Lyons and Hellova Street, all at Listed level.

A \$16,000 purchase at the 2019 Tasmanian Magic Millions Sale, the gelding had been trained by Scott Brunton before the 2023/24 season, where he joined Stevenson's Wesley Vale stables in the northwest of Tasmania. In a closely run contest for the Ladbrokes Horse of the Year title, First Accused edged out two-time Stakes winner Indispensable, who campaigned with premiership-winning trainer John Blacker across the summer, and star juvenile filly Geegees Mistruth, who made a clean sweep of her two-year-old season.

Expectedly, Geegees Mistruth was crowned the Two-Year-Old of the Year following a four-win season that included the Listed Elwick Stakes and Gold Sovereign.

While the daughter of Wordsmith's debut campaign was brilliant, the beginning of her three-year-old season has arguably been better. Back-to-back second placings in the Group 3 Quezette Stakes (1100m, Caulfield) and Group 3 Scarborough Stakes (1200m, Moonee Valley) have justified trainer Stuart Gandy throwing her in the deep end and sees the Group 1 Thousand Guineas in November as a realistic target.

The 2023/24 three-year-old crop was arguably the most even in recent seasons, and the Liandra Gray-trained D'oro Star came out on top of the vote.

Another Tasmanian Magic Millions purchase, D'oro Star's wins in the 3YO Trophy and 3YO Classic, were the biggest of his young trainer's career and may have swayed voters, given that the beaten brigade in those races included fellow finalists Island Warrior and Thespian Waters.


In other awards, Tasmanian-bred, South Australian-trained stayer The Map was recognised as the leading Tasmanian Racemare or Filly, and his sire, Alpine Eagle, and dam, This Moment, won respective breeding awards.

The Map's win in the Listed Andrew Ramsden at Flemington in May secured a place in the 2024 Melbourne Cup, a tremendous achievement for Armidale Stud, which presented The Map at the 2020 Adelaide Magic Millions Sale, where she was purchased for \$35,000.

Always a highlight, the Tasmanian Thoroughbred Hall of Fame saw three inductees. Glen Lang into the horse category, Kevin Sharkie as an associate, and Gary White elevated to Legend status.

# Making welfare a top priority

Tasracing awards funding under inaugural Racing Animal Welfare Grant (RAWG) program.

Tasracing has awarded more than \$80,000 in grants to Tasmanian organisations to deliver animal welfare programs in the state.

The grants were awarded under the new Racing Animal Welfare Grant (RAWG) program that was established to provide funding for eligible Tasmanian organisations to deliver animal welfare programs in Tasmania.



The successful applications align with the Tasracing priorities to support the welfare of:

- Tasmanian racing animals.
- Animals transitioning from racing into new careers and homes.

A panel of three assessors evaluated eligible applications, with 11 successful grant applicants awarded combined total funding of \$80,141 as follows:

- Two (2) grants, totalling \$10,000, were approved in the category for Initiatives & Events. This covers initiatives that contribute towards high-quality welfare outcomes for retired racing animals.
- Nine (9) grants, totalling \$70,141, were approved in the category for Facilities & Equipment. This covers facilities and equipment that have a direct impact on the welfare of retired racing animals.


- Actively promoting awareness of appropriate retirement options for Tasmanian racing animals.
- Stimulating demand for retired Tasmanian racing animals to maximise rehoming and retraining opportunities.
- Maximising end-of-racing career opportunities for Tasmanian racing animals.
- Promoting industry uptake in Tasmania of advances in racing animal training, health and welfare.
- It is expected that the RAWG will be offered again in 2025.

### Animal Welfare appointment

Amanda Chant has recently joined Tasracing in the position of Animal Welfare Officer.

Originally from Tasmania, Amanda has spent the best part of the last three decades in Queensland, where she was engaged as one of Racing Queensland's Accredited Retrainers. Amanda has a particular passion for retraining Standardbreds and, in fact, won the Racing Queensland Accredited Standardbred Retrainer of the Year Award last season.

Amanda will be based at the Elwick office and will be pivotal in continuing to build Tasracing's Off the Track program, along with other welfare initiatives.



# Break through Bingley

Since her riding debut in August 2022, it's been a stop-start career for apprentice jockey Lauryn Bingley.

Landing a winner with her first race ride was a sign of the talent that Bingley possesses, but her initial stint in the saddle would last just 17 rides before falling pregnant.

Bingley took 12 months away to give birth to her son Billy before returning to the riding ranks at the back end of the 23/24 Ladbrokes Summer Racing Festival. The winners didn't quite come as quickly as they did the first time around, Bingley breaking through on the Angela Brakey-trained Mandate, a month after her riding return.

"It's great to finally get the monkey off the back," laughed Bingley after her return winner.

The partner of Kyle Maskiell, Bingley was indentured to the partnership of Maskiell and his aunt Tanya Hanson, but when Hanson retired from training in late July, it forced another absence for Bingley who was left without a master.

The talented apprentice has now moved further north, joining Hall of Fame trainer Barry Campbell.

"We've left Longford and moved to Port Sorell, and I'll now be riding for Barry," said Bingley. The new partnership has started well, with Bingley landing a winner on the Campbell-trained Azonto at her first meeting back after a six-week break in Devonport on 11 September.

Now, over two years since her riding career began, Bingley maintains a healthy 16% winning strike rate from just under 140 rides and her 2kg claim is of great value to trainers at a time when the depth of claiming apprentices isn't as strong as it's been in recent seasons.

"Jacko (Radley), Chloe (Wells) and myself are pretty much it locally at the moment, so it's a good time to be getting back into the swing of things."

Working her way back into race shape over the concluding stages of a stretch of racing in Devonport, Bingley hopes to be at the top of her game for the Launceston night season and the start of the 24/25 Ladbrokes Summer Racing Festival.

"I've been riding at 53.5 (kilograms) for the first few weeks, but come Carnival time, and when we're racing those Wednesday and Friday nights, I hope to be able to get down to 52."





#### Feature Race Conditions of Entry

Horses declared to be emergencies and which fail to gain a start, or horses which are eliminated under the balloting conditions are still liable for the nomination fees and only the declaration of acceptance fee will be refunded.

Acceptance fees must be paid prior to the horse starting. However, Tasracing may in its absolute discretion eliminate any horse or horses from this race and/or exclude any horse or horses from the operation of the preceding elimination conditions.

Tasracing reserves the right from time to time to alter the date of running, to make any alteration or modification to this race, to cancel the meeting or any portion thereof, to alter time for taking entries or acceptances, also the right to reject at any time any entry submitted to and for them.


# Hobart Racecourse




## Devonport Racecourse

# Amendments to Australian Rules of Racing Effective 1 November 2024

Proposed Amendment -Australian Residue Limits, AR2 and AR 257B

### Summary

These proposed rule changes cover the Australian Residue Limits (ARL) including a new definition to be included in AR 2, a new ARL Table with preamble and new AR257B.

Communication has taken place between Veterinary and Analytical Advisory Group (VAAG) and the Chairmen of Stewards Committee (COSC) during several meetings in 2023 based on communication from VAAG in 2022 providing the technical basis for these changes.

In July 2022 VAAG provided the following information to COSC;

"The IFHA publish a list of International Residue Limits, which are in effect screening limits for substances of environmental origin or those that may be found naturally occurring in a horse's diet. These substances may be detected in a sample at low levels consistent with the substances arising as a result of being found naturally in the horse's environment or diet.

As these substances may vary in their presence in the environment due to regional factors the view of VAAG is that Australia should not be a signatory to the full IFHA residue limit list – however it would be prudent to maintain an agreed Australian residue limit list in the interests of a national approach to residue limit screening.

It is also noted that the IFHA has previously advised Australia that both theobromine, and more recently dimethyl sulfoxide (DMSO), have now been removed from the list of substances to which a threshold should apply within the international rules and moved to the International Residue Limits list, Australia has responded previously by removing theobromine from Division 3 – Prohibited List B thresholds and agreeing to add theobromine to the current unofficial list of recognised residue limits. *It is* noted that should this ARL list be formally adopted and recoanised within the rules. that DMSO should then also be removed from Division 3 – Prohibited List B thresholds.

In addition to the approval of the proposed list of ARL's the Australian Rules should be amended to formally recognise the adoption and maintenance of this list in industry publications, in a similar approach to that taken with the adoption and maintenance of an agreed list of screening limits that apply to equine therapeutic substances. It would be proposed that the residue limits list would never contain any substances that are considered permanently banned at all times (Prohibited List A substances)." Consultation with and by the PRA's was undertaken between May 2024 and August 2024. The PRA's have confirmed their support for these amendments.

### 1. Add the following to AR 2:

Australian residue limit (ARL) means the concentration of a substance of environmental origin or its specified metabolite present in a sample during a screening test or analysis as set out in AR 257B (2), above which the substance of environmental origin will be specified as a prohibited substance.

### Date of effect: 1 November 2024

### 2. Add the new AR 257B as follows:

#### AR 257B Environmental substances

- (1) For analysis of an environmental substance in a sample taken at any time from a horse, there must be an initial screening test or screening analysis of the sample.
- (2) As a minimum requirement, the initial screening test or screening analysis must be conducted by an Official Racing Laboratory in accordance with the following procedure: (a) the relevant biological matrix, equivalent in volume to the portion or aliquot of the sample being tested, is to have added to it a quantity of the environmental substance, sufficient to bring its concentration to the Australian Residue Limit specified for that environmental substance – this is known as the "spiked sample" and is to be analysed concurrently with the sample; (b) the portion or aliquot of the sample is then to be tested to determine whether or not it contains a quantity of the environmental

substance that exceeds that Australian Residue Limit, by making a direct comparison with the spiked sample; (c) if the Australian Residue Limit is not exceeded, the detection of the environmental substance in the sample is not to be reported on a Certificate of Analysis; (d) if the Australian Residue Limit is exceeded, then the sample is to be further tested in accordance with normal laboratory procedures designed to certify the presence of the environmental substance in the sample.

- (3) An environmental substance for the purpose of this rule and the Australian Residue Limit applicable to it, is to be approved and published from time to time by Racing Australia.
- (4) The Australian Residue Limit testing provided for in this rule is not intended to and does not operate to mean that for the purpose of the Rules the relevant environmental substance only becomes a prohibited substance if and when the Australian Residue Limit is exceeded.
- (5) It is no defence to an alleged breach of AR 240 or AR 241 that the result of any initial Australian Residue Limit test or screening analysis should have been below the Australian Residue Limit for the environmental substance in question.

### Date of effect: 1 November 2024

3. Amend Division 3 – Prohibited List B thresholds as follows:

Delete subrule 3 of this division.

Date of effect: 1 November 2024

4. Amend and insert the Preamble to ARL publication and ARL Table (the preamble will precede and be the heading to the ARL Table) as follows:

For the purpose of AR 257B, it is hereby notified that Australian residue limits applicable to the following substances of environmental origin, as approved by Racing Australia, are set out as follows:

Proposed Amendment - AR 231

#### Summary

This rule change concerns the wording of the Care and Welfare Rule AR 231, with changes to the wording of sub clause (1) and the introduction of a new sub clause (7).

A draft rule in relation to this matter was first proposed in 2021 in response to a September 2020 Victorian Supreme Court decision in the matter of Jody Thompson which limited the ambit of AR 231(1)(b). The Chairmen of Stewards Committee considered that amendments should be made to reverse the precedent established in that case. It is considered that amendments are necessary for the promotion and championing of equine welfare.

The draft rule to address this issue was then refined and finalized with multiple communications between VAAG and COSC between in 2022 and 2023.

Consultation with and by the PRA's was undertaken between May 2024 and August 2024. The PRA's have confirmed their support for these amendments.

# Amendments to Australian Rules of Racing Effective 1 November 2024

### Add the following to AR 231:

### (1) A person must not:

(a) commit or commission an act of cruelty to a horse, or be in possession of any article or thing which, in the opinion of the Stewards, is capable of inflicting cruelty to a horse;
(b) if the person is in charge of a horse

- fail at any time:

(i) to exercise reasonable care, control or supervision of the horse so as to prevent:

A. an act of cruelty to the horse; or

B. the horse's body condition from declining to, in the opinion of the Stewards based on veterinary advice, an unacceptable level;

 (ii) to take such reasonable steps as are necessary to alleviate any pain inflicted upon or being suffered by the horse;
 (iii) to obtain veterinary advice and

provide treatment in accordance with that advice where such treatment is necessary for the welfare of a horse; and/or (iv) to provide and ensure that the horse is ingesting proper and sufficient nutrition.

(7) For the purposes of subrule (1)(b)(iii), "veterinary advice" must include, but is not limited to, a diagnosis and/or advice and/or opinion from a qualified veterinary surgeon.

Date of effect: 1 November 2024

Proposed Amendment - AR 109A and AR 223

### Summary

Racing Australia considered the implications for the Australian Rules of Racing resulting from the decision of the Court of Appeal of Queensland in *Queensland Racing Integrity Commission v Endresz; Racing Queensland Board v Endresz [2024]* QCA 76.

Racing Australia in consultation with the PRAs recommended the introduction of a new rule and one amendment to an existing rule in the Australian Rules of Racing.

The new Rule 109A addresses the principles of procedural fairness and natural justice under the Rules of Racing for a horse owner to be given notice of, and an opportunity to be heard at, an investigation or stewards' inquiry into a matter relating to a horse with the notice being given to the trainer or trainer's representative.

The amendment to AR 223 concerns the withholding of prizemoney pending a protest or inquiry. The sub rule (c) change clarifies that any relevant investigation or inquiry is not required to have commenced for prizemoney to be withheld.

Consultation with and by the PRA's was undertaken between May 2024 and August 2024. The PRA's have confirmed their support for this amendment.

## 1. Introduce a new rule AR 109A as follows:

### AR109A Trainer conclusively treated as representative of the owner for the purposes of the principles of procedural fairness and natural justice

- (1) For the purposes of the principles of procedural fairness and natural justice (where applicable under any part of the Rules), the owner or owners of a horse shall be conclusively treated as having been given adequate notice of any matter relating to a horse, and/ or an adequate opportunity to be heard in relation to that matter, where such notice and/or an opportunity to be heard is given to the trainer of that horse or the trainer's authorised representative.
- (2) For the avoidance of doubt, any right or entitlement of an owner or owners pursuant to the principles of procedural fairness and natural justice to receive notice of any matter relating to a horse, and/or an adequate opportunity to be heard in relation to that matter, separate from or additional to (1) above, is excluded.

### Date of effect: 1 November 2024

2. Amend AR 223 as follows:

## AR 223 Withholding of prizes pending consideration of a protest or inquiry

Whenever:

(a) a protest has been lodged; or
(b) an investigation or inquiry which may affect the placing of a horse has been instituted; or
(c) any action is taken or is about to be taken which may lead to an investigation or inquiry which may affect the placing of a horse has been instituted, any prize due in respect of a horse may be withheld pending the consideration of the protest, investigation or inquiry.

### Date of effect: 1 November 2024

### Proposed Amendment - AR 88C, AR 88D, AR 88E and AR 85

### Summary

At a meeting of the Veterinary and Analytical Advisory Group (VAAG) noted that the recently adopted Prohibited Practice Rules – AR 88C, AR 88D & AR 88E; and also, the current rule dealing with "firing procedures" – AR 85, does not explicitly prohibit persons from performing these procedures, whereas the rules dealing with shockwave therapy (AR 86), intra-articular injections (AR 87), injections (AR 254) and injections of Cobalt salts (AR 254A) makes provision in this regard.

The Veterinary and Analytical Advisory Group (VAAG) proposed amendments to AR 85, AR 88C, AR 88D & AR 88E to include a sub-rule which reads as follows;

A person must not:

(a) administer;
(b) cause to be administered;
(c) attempt to administer; or
(d) be a party to the administration of (insert relevant procedure).

to the horse at any time.

The Chairmen of Stewards Committee (COSC) then unanimously supported the proposal of VAAG to include a sub-rule to each of AR 88C, AR 88D, AR 88E and AR85 which prohibits a person from engaging in the procedures covered by the relevant rules ("prohibition clause").

# Amendments to Australian Rules of Racing Effective 1 November 2024

Consultation with and by the PRA's was undertaken between May 2024 and August 2024. The PRA's have confirmed their support for this amendment.

### 1. Amend AR 85 as follows:

## AR 85 Horses that have had a firing procedure

- (1) If a horse has been subjected to a firing procedure in Australia:
  (a) the horse is ineligible for; and
  (b) a person must not enter or start the horse in, any race, official trial, jump-out or trackwork.
- (2) If a horse is subject to a firing procedure, the owner of the horse or that owner's authorised agent must provide written notification of that to the Stewards as soon as practicable. The Stewards will then seek to ensure that:

(a) details of the procedure and the horse's ineligibility to race are recorded in Racing Australia's national online database; and
(b) if applicable, the Thoroughbred Identification Card of the horse is endorsed with details of the procedure and the horse's ineligibility to race.

#### (3) A person must not:

(a) administer;
(b) cause to be administered;
(c) attempt to administer; or
(d) be a party to the administration of a firing procedure,

to the horse at any time.

### Date of effect: 1 November 2024

### 2. Add to AR 88C as follows:

## AR 88C Horses that have had blistering procedure

- (1) If a horse has been subjected to a blistering procedure in Australia:
  (a) the horse is ineligible for a minimum period of 12 months; and
  (b) a person must not enter or start the horse in any race, official trial, jumpout or trackwork.
- (2) If a horse is subject to a blistering procedure, the owner of the horse or that owner's authorised agent must provide written notification of that to the Stewards as soon as practicable. The Stewards will then seek to ensure that:

(a) details of the procedure and the horse's ineligibility to race are recorded in Racing Australia's national online database; and
(b) if applicable, the Thoroughbred Identification Card of the horse is endorsed with details of the procedure and the horse's ineligibility to race.

(3) A person must not:
(a) administer;
(b) cause to be administered;
(c) attempt to administer; or
(d) be a party to the administration of a blistering procedure.

to the horse at any time.

Date of effect: 1 November 2024

### 3. Amend AR 88D as follows:

## AR 88D Horses that have had chemical castration or immunocastration

 If a horse has been subjected to a chemical castration or immunocastration procedure in Australia:

(a) the horse is ineligible for a minimum period of 12 months; and
(b) a person must not enter or start the horse in any race, official trial, jumpout or trackwork.

- (2) If a horse is subject to a chemical castration or immunocastration, the owner of the horse or that owner's authorised agent must provide written notification of that to the Stewards as soon as practicable. The Stewards will then seek to ensure that:
  (a) details of the procedure and the horse's ineligibility to race are recorded in Racing Australia's national online database; and
  (b) if applicable, the Thoroughbred Identification Card of the procedure and the horse's ineligibility to race.
- (3) A person must not:
  - (a) administer;
    (b) cause to be administered;
    (c) attempt to administer; or
    (d) be a party to the administration of a chemical castration or immunocastration procedure,

to the horse at any time.

### Date of effect: 1 November 2024

### 4. Amend AR 88E as follows:

## AR 88E Horses that have had a bloodletting procedure

- (1) If a horse has been subjected to a bloodletting procedure in Australia:
  (a) the horse is ineligible for a minimum period of 12 months; and
  (b) a person must not enter or start the horse in, any race, official trial, jumpout or track work.
- (2) If a horse is subject to a bloodletting procedure, the owner of the horse or that owner's authorised agent must provide written notification of that to the Stewards as soon as practicable. The Stewards will then seek to ensure that:

(a) details of the procedure and the horse's ineligibility to race are recorded in Racing Australia's national online database; and
(b) if applicable, the Thoroughbred Identification Card of the horse is endorsed with details of the procedure and the horse's ineligibility to race.

(3) A person must not:
(a) administer;
(b) cause to be administered;
(c) attempt to administer; or
(d) be a party to the administration of a bloodletting procedure.

to the horse at any time.

# Stewards segment

### Farrier

The on-course farrier will be in attendance at a race meeting no later than 45 minutes prior the advertised start time for the first race. During a race meeting he will be positioned within close proximity to the steward's room.

At all times the farrier should have the appropriate equipment to carry out the required duties, this must include, spare plates ranging in sizes, which should be taken to the start of each race.

### Replating

Any required re-plate and/or repair should be carried out as soon as possible and the horse must then be examined by the veterinary surgeon prior to racing. If a replacement/repair is required such work should be notified to stewards upon completion.

### Unable to replace or repair

If a plate is unable to be replaced or repaired the following should take place:

- Front standard plate A horse will not be permitted to start under any circumstances with either one plate or bare foot.
- 2. Rear standard plate A horse will not start with only one rear plate. The following options will be undertaken –
- a) The trainer will be contacted to ask permission for the removal of the opposite plate to allow the horse to race barefoot.
- b) If the trainer cannot be contacted the jockey will be asked for

permission to remove the opposite plate and allow the horse to race barefoot.

c) If neither party grants permission, the horse will be scratched.

### Therapeutic and Bar plates

Under no circumstance will a horse be permitted to start in a race if a therapeutic or bar plate (either front or rear) cannot be replaced or repaired.

### Notification

Stewards will contact the broadcaster as soon as possible to alert the public of the fact a horse will be racing barefoot behind. Any horse that has plates removed must be inspected by the veterinary surgeon both pre and post race.

### **Barrier Certificate Authorisation**

1. In accordance with Local Rule 8.3, an unraced horse must not be permitted to start until it has been issued with a barrier certificate after performing satisfactorily in a trial, over at least 600 metres, with at least two other horses.

LR 8.3 Unraced horses must have a barrier certificate obtained in an official trial priorto the closing of acceptances.

- 2. A horse will only be issued with a barrier certificate if it is seen to be tractable whenentering, standing in and jumping away from the barriers.
- 3. A horse will only be issued with a barrier certificate if:
- It is ridden into the barriers with minimal assistance (one attendant >>



with a lead on the bridle and a gentle guide behind)

>>

- It stands without assistance with all four feet on the ground
- It jumps out in a satisfactory manner
- 4. A horse will not be issued with a barrier certificate if:
- It has to be lifted into the barriers
- It is fractious or laying to excess on the side of the stall
- It rears or attempts to burrow under the front gates
- It stands flat footed and fails to jump away (2 lengths)
- It jumps out and starts to buck
- It jumps out and does a left or right hand turn.

#### 5. Barrier Blankets

Application for approval of a barrier blanket must be made prior toacceptances for the race it is intended to start. The blanket must be placed on the horse prior to it being ridden into the barriers and it must be tractable when loadingand standing in the barriers.

#### 6. Blind fold and Stallion Chains

For safety reasons, it is Racing Services Tasmania Policy that horses using blind folds or stallion chains shall be loaded into the barriers riderless. Application for approval of a blind fold or stallion chain must be made prior to acceptances for the race it is intended to start. The horse must satisfactorily enter the barriers with the blind fold or stallion chain on.

7. Before issuing barrier certificates, the document of description must be supplied to the steward who must ensure that all brands and markings are verified against the horse.

### **Rider Declarations**

LR13.3 – Trainers are reminded that riders must be declared, prior to the new time of 2pm on all race meetings. If a rider is not declared, Trainer may be fined.

#### Track Rules

To ensure safety and cooperation on All Tasmanian training venues, participants are reminded of their obligations and rules associated with each venue. ORI advises all participants to the Tasmanian Thoroughbred Track Rules on the Tasracing Corporate website to familiarise yourself with rules, obligations and procedures.

Mandatory Training – RPL Workshop Dates

To assist participants that are required to complete mandatory training requirements prior to renewing their license in 2025, Tasracing will be running a series of Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) workshops.

These RPL workshop dates will cover the first three units of competency for all license categories.

# Retiring your thoroughbred

### **Notification forms**

Under the Australian Rules of Racing, a notification form must be lodged when a decision has been made to retire a horse or to not commence racing a horse (AR 51) or upon the death of a horse (AR 52). Penalties may apply if failing to comply with notification obligations under the rules.

### Notification forms for retirement of horses should be completed

Named horse within 1 month of the decision to retire the horse from racing or within 24 hours of the horse's death.

Unnamed horse within 1 month of the decision to not commence racing the horse, or within 24 hours of the horse's death.




