PUTTING AUSSIE STAYERS ON THE MAP AGAIN

The race that causes the pump shed seems a fitting pre-cursor to the race that stops a nation.

And just like last Saturday, when he welled up watching a horse he bred, reared and sold race her way into Australia's most famous race, Armidale Stud's David Wishaw reckons he'll be an emotional wreck if The Map can win the Melbourne Cup.

And he says it's as much about what the mare means to the race as what she means to him.

Wishaw grew up as a racing-mad kid in an era where schools around the country stopped class to watch the Cup. He has vivid memories of Tripsacum, a horse his family bred, flash home for third in the 1985 edition of the race.

Horses like Tripsacum and The Map, bred in different corners of the country and raced by everyday Aussies, largely made up the race and helped connect the narrative with the nation.

Since then though, the face of the race has changed.

While it took another decade for an internationally trained horse to win the Cup, Vintage Crop's 1993 success was the catalyst for an influx of Europeans and Japanese, first as raiders for their

own connections and, more recently, as adopted Aussies for cashed-up syndicates.

The Map's guaranteed place in this year's Melbourne Cup defies that trend and, for Wishaw, shows the dream of breeding a horse in Australia to run in the race is still a reality.

"I was sitting in a pump shed trying to fix a pump and watching the Ramsden on my phone," Wishaw said.

"I obviously did enough yelling that one of the staff came into the pump shed to check if I was all right and found me sitting in tears and hadn't worked out what was going on.

"It was bloody special, that's for sure.

"I think the last Melbourne Cup runner to be bred out of Tasmania was Alfa but as far as my family is concerned, Tripsacum was the last horse that has come off the farm to run in the Melbourne Cup.

"He ran around in the 1985 Cup won by What A Nuisance and he was absolutely flashing home to run third.

"I feel like since then, the Melbourne Cup has changed a lot.

"It's been very difficult for horses like The Map to get a start in a race like that, so I think for us as a family, for Tassie as a breeding industry, for South Australia

as a racing industry and obviously for connections, being able to get a \$35,000 yearling that's by a \$5000 stallion into the Melbourne Cup is really special.

"These are the things that make the industry special to me, that it doesn't matter who you are or where you come from or how much money you've got, if you're lucky and you play your cards right, you can mix it with the best in the world.

"WE DREAM THAT HOPEFULLY WE CAN BEAT THE BEST IN THE WORLD AND THAT'S WHAT GIVES THE SPORT SO MUCH ROMANCE."

"It worried me that we were losing that, especially around the Melbourne Cup with so many tried imports coming in, so it's lovely to see a horse like this in the race."

The Map is by Armidale's resident sire Alpine Eagle, who boasts his own eclectic story.

Raced by enigmatic German winemaker Wolf Blass, the son of High Chaparral won four races, including the Group 2 Autumn Classic over 1800m. He was Group 1 placed in the Australian Guineas but ultimately an injury to his pedal bone curtailed his progression as an older horse under the care of Tony McEvoy.

Wishaw took a punt on the horse and, incredibly for a stallion domiciled on the Apple Isle, he served more than 400 mares in his first four seasons.

Keen to expose his first crop of yearlings to mainland buyers, Wishaw took a draft of young horses to the Magic Millions Yearling Sale in Adelaide, where Alpine Eagle had raced most frequently.

Among that 2020 draft was Lot 140, a filly out of Savoire Vivre mare This Moment. She was bought by Murray Bridge trainers

Dan Clarcken and Oopy McGillivray for \$35,000 and she would ultimately be named The Map.

A winner on debut and Stakes-placed in her second racing campaign, The Map has improved with each preparation – something that Wishaw often sees with the breed.

"We follow all the horses we breed or are bred on the farm reasonably closely and when they carry your brand you feel a connection to them," he said.

"We launched Alpine Eagle before my wife and I had children and, at the time, we were keen to take some of his stock to the Adelaide sale, given he was trained by Tony McEvoy in Adelaide.

"We took her over there (Adelaide) because we felt she was one of the nicer fillies by the sire from his first crop and we were probably a bit disappointed with the result to be honest.

"She bought \$35,000 and we absolutely loved her but the market is hard on those staying types of horses and that was the case at that sale, particularly with fillies.

"Sometimes things are meant to be and if we didn't take her to Adelaide, she wouldn't have ended up in the hands of Dan and Oopy and they are obviously the perfect trainers for her."

"They haven't been the easiest horses to train on the whole, in that they are highly intelligent and highly geared horses.

"What we've seen is that they need to be in smaller stables or stables that will mix things up to get into the horse's heads.

"It's wonderful to see her getting better with age and better out over a bit of a trip."

That The Map is excelling over staying distances comes as little surprise to Wishaw.

While Alpine Eagle never raced beyond 1800m, Wishaw believes he would've been an elite 2000m horse had his career not been cut short by injury.

The Map hails from a female family that is truly Tasmanian, with Oaks winner Iggimacool and Derby winners Father Floyd and Methuselah on her pedigree page.

"He (Alpine Eagle) was obviously a horse that probably raced best over a mile and 1800m, but we never got to see him out over a trip," he said.

"I know he was touted as a Cox Plate horse there for a while and we expected when breeding to him that he would be throwing mile to middle distance horses.

"He's a son of High Chaparral out of a Zabeel mare, so you could definitely make a case for them getting out over a bit of a trip.

"When you have a look at how The Map is bred – she's bred 3x3 to Sadler's Wells and This Moment's dam sire Savoire Vivre is out of Oh So Sharp, who is a Triple Crown winner – it's easy to suggest that she could run a trip.

"We bred This Moment but she was purchased by good clients of ours that have had the broodmare on the farm since she retired from racing.

"The family has been a Tassie family and one synonymous with Armidale Stud for three generations.

"Midori Miss resided on the farm and I remember prepping yearlings out of her as a young boy and out of her there was Father Floyd and Methuselah who were both Derby winners and then Iggimacool and Love The Moment were also bred on the farm, who were both Stakes performers over a trip.

"It has been a family that has produced good middle-distance and staying horses.

"I remember saying to Oopy and Dan when they bought her that I thought she could be the perfect Oaks filly and I remember feeling a bit shattered for them when they didn't get her there.

"She's far surpassed that."

Wishaw is optimistic that The Map's recent success can stimulate business for the stallion this spring, although he's resigned to the challenges faced by Tasmanian-based sires.

Alpine Eagle, who started his career with a service fee of \$7700, will stand for \$4400 in 2024.

As well as The Map, Alpine Wolf is a dual Stakes winner for the stallion, who has also produced recent mainland metropolitan winners Eye Of The Eagle and Alpine Flyer.

WHITE FINISHES AS IT ALL BEGUN

After almost five decades, most of them spent at the top echelon of trainers in Tasmania, Gary White saddled up his last runner at the Hobart race meeting on 21 April.

In a career with so many highs, White believes the time was right to bow out and start to enjoy some time with family and friends.

"It's a Saturday or Sunday, and your friends invite you to a function, and you can't go; my son Grayson has moved back to Tassie; my granddaughter is here now; she's six, and she had her first soccer game the other day and I couldn't go," White explained.

"I love racing, and now we will be able to pop out to the races, sit up behind the glass and enjoy it."

Like many kids in the 1970s, White grew up not far from the Elwick track, where his love for the sport began.

"I hung around the stables with all my mates; I was about 14 when I started knowing that I was making use of myself down there; I was working around Staffy Devine, Tommy Young and Terry Evans; I got in their way but watched what they did.

"My grandparents lived right by the course, and I spent a lot of time with my pop, so I used to see all the guys riding around.

"I USED TO SPEND ALL MY TIME WATCHING ALL THE HORSES. IT WAS A LOT OF FUN THAT ERA; WE ALL HAD A PASSION FOR THE ANIMAL AND APPRECIATED WHAT A MAJESTIC ANIMAL THEY ARE."

White stepped out as a trainer in 1980. His first starter, Race To Win, did just that, scoring by five lengths.

"The second horse I took to the races got beaten a short half head, and I thought how easy is this, but I quickly found out in the next three months when not one horse weighed in that it wasn't that easy."

After starting his career with a winner, it was only fitting that White would end in the same way.

White had to survive the saddle shifting and a photo finish, but Better Than Banksy sent the Hall of Famer out as a winner when he won the last race in Hobart on 21 April.

"How gifted have I been? We do nothing special but to be afforded the opportunity and success, and for this fairy tale beginning and end, how fortunate have I been?" White exclaimed.

In a five-decade career, White has won almost every major race in the state and plenty interstate, including the 2009 Magic Millions 3YO with Tempest Tost. Still, it would be hard to see any of those achievements topping a winner with his last starter to 'bookend' a marvellous career.

White, 68, retires after being inducted into the Tasmanian Thoroughbred Hall of Fame in 2009, with over 1100 winners, including more than 20 at Group and Listed levels.

He plans to enjoy retirement with his wife, Belinda, including a road trip around Australia.





ROCKY MADE TO EARN THE KNOCKOUT

While his counterparts have flourished, mature-age Japanese-born apprentice Ryota (Rocky) Morimoto has bided his time, waiting for a breakthrough winner.

After having his first race ride in August 2023, Rocky has seen the likes of Chelsea Baker, Taylor Johnstone, and Erica Byrne outride their apprentice claims in a state where the opportunities afforded to apprentices far outweigh those in other parts of Australia.

44 rides and 252 days after making his debut, Rocky finally landed a winning blow in Hobart on 21 April, when the John Keys-trained Tsunami Sam proved too good in a benchmark 76 (1200m).

It was fitting that Rocky's first winner came for Keys, who gave the likeable apprentice his Tasmanian opportunity, including some time in Victoria with John's brother Ken Keys.

"John Keys gave me a chance; it's so good to ride my first winner; I struggle with my weight; all the hard work has paid off," said Rocky following his Hobart win.

You won't find a Keys' Seven Mile Beach staff member who has a bad word to say about Rocky, who is fulfilling a childhood dream of becoming a jockey.

"He's a very good man, if you knew Rocky and his work ethic and the vibrancy,

he brings around the stable, he's outstanding," Scott Brunton said.

"To see him break through was a very good thing; you see this kid get out of bed in the early morning; he's close to six feet tall, but his one dream was to be a jockey."

As tends to be the case in racing, the confidence born from one winner quickly led to another for Rocky, whose second victory came in Hobart just three weeks later when he led all the way with Freak On A Lead in a benchmark 60 (1400m).

With Tasmania's claiming apprentice stocks diminishing, Rocky's success is timely and may hopefully lead to more opportunities for the 27-year-old.

Listed on Racing Australia with a minimum riding weight of 56kg, being a natural heavyweight is a factor in the rides that Rocky receives, but having debuted on the same program as Jackson Radley, Rocky has less than 50 career rides, while Jackson is approaching 250.

"It took a long time to get my first winner, but I have a lot of good people helping me," said Rocky.

"Hopefully I can get some opportunities, I'm the only one left with a 4kg claim."

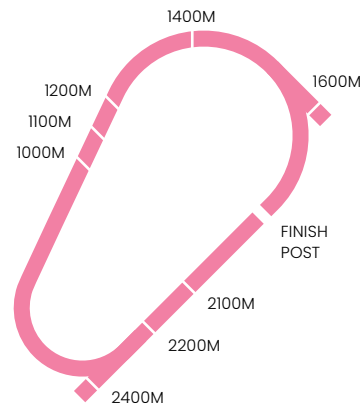
HOBART RACECOURSE

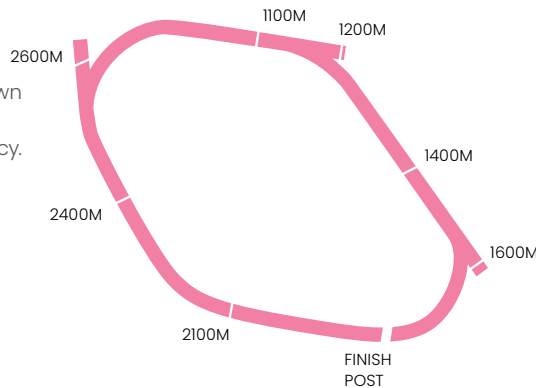

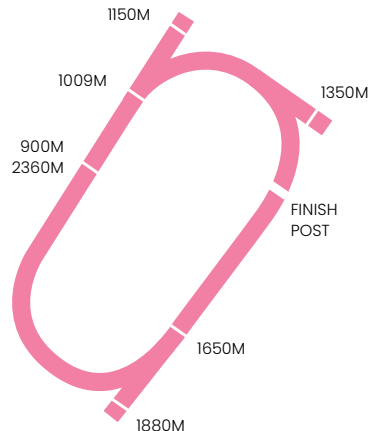
DEVONPORT RACECOURSE

AMENDMENTS TO AUSTRALIAN RULES OF RACING

EFFECTIVE 1 MAY 2024

AR 2, AR 88E BLOODLETTING

Summary:

The International Agreement on Breeding, Racing and Wagering is a voluntary agreement designed for the guidance of recognised Racing and Breeding authorities. The Agreement is reviewed once a year by the IFHA Annual Conference.

Article 6 C (RACING) PROHIBITED PRACTICES deals with practices that jeopardize the health and welfare of the horse, the welfare of the rider, and other participants as well as the integrity of horseracing are inappropriate and prohibited.

In 2021 a number of additional items were added to Article 6C including.

(2) SPECIFIED PROHIBITED PRACTICES

Prohibited practices include but are not limited to:

- (d) The withdrawal of blood from a horse for any purpose other than for diagnostic/laboratory testing procedures or as permitted by 2(e) below
- (e) The withdrawal, manipulation and reinfusion of homologous, heterologous, or autologous, blood products or blood cells into the circulatory system with the exception of those procedures performed for lifesaving purposes or in the use of veterinary regenerative therapies for

the treatment of musculoskeletal injury or disease..

“Bloodletting” in humans and other animal species has been practised for millennia in the original belief that it expelled illness through the elimination of impure fluids. Bloodletting has been practised in horses since the mid-16th century with reports of its extensive use in the 18th century to treat a multitude of diseases and injuries. However, as poor outcomes were beginning to be raised with its use in humans in the 19th century its popularity gradually declined, although it is still considered a valid therapy in humans in certain conditions characterised by polycythaemia (an increase in concentration of all blood cell types) or erythrocytosis (an increase in red cell parameters).

In horses, bloodletting involves the removal of a significant proportion of the animal's blood volume (up to 10 or more litres in a racehorse) via a large bore catheter or needle, or by incision (phlebotomy) of the jugular vein. This results in immediate physiological and behavioural changes, including a sudden reduction in blood pressure and the potential to stagger and collapse.

The procedure has been advocated to “freshen up” a horse that is performing poorly due to overtraining, a situation that might be attributable to polycythaemia, or to reduce the tendency for exercise-induced pulmonary haemorrhage (EIPH).

However, there is no sound scientific.

basis to attribute any beneficial effect due to bloodletting in healthy horses, and bloodletting is difficult to detect using routine haematological tests, although there may be visual evidence of jugular vein cannulation or phlebotomy.

There is also the matter of the impact of bloodletting conducted on horses that remain in training and race, given the physiological effects and possible effects on performance. It should be noted that any prohibition of bloodletting would not extend to the withdrawal of small volumes of blood for diagnostic or testing procedures, or for use in those procedures performed for lifesaving purposes or in the use of veterinary regenerative therapies for the treatment of musculoskeletal injury or disease. Such procedures should be performed by a veterinarian and recorded in the trainer's treatment schedule.

In evaluating whether bloodletting should be considered a prohibited practice, the following could be noted:

- Bloodletting has the potential to cause unnecessary discomfort
- Any benefit to the health and welfare of horse could not justify the discomfort caused by the procedure.
- There was a variety of more modern therapies and management interventions available to treat conditions that might be the subject of bloodletting.
- Bloodletting is still used in modern human medical practice to treat certain medical conditions such as haemochromatosis.
- Bloodletting is still mentioned in modern veterinary medical and veterinary textbooks as one means

of managing polycythaemia in Standardbred trotters, a condition that is rare in thoroughbreds.

- Bloodletting of healthy racehorses would be perceived adversely by the general community.

It has been suggested and supported by VAAG and COSC that the minimum period of ineligibility should be for a period of 12 months, and that this provision should apply to this practice.

COSC unanimously agreed to support this definition of Bloodletting for inclusion in AR 2 and a new rule (AR 88E) to formalise a period of ineligibility of 12 months to participate in any race, trial, jump out or track work.

Racing Australia has after consultation determined to introduced the definition to AR 2 and the add new rule AR 88E to give effect to adoption of Bloodletting as a Prohibited Practice.

1. ADD TO AR 2 AS FOLLOWS:

AR2 Definitions

Bloodletting means the withdrawal of blood from a horse for any purpose, including the withdrawal, manipulation and reinfusion of homologous, heterologous, or autologous, blood products or blood cells into the circulatory system other than for;

- (i) diagnostic/laboratory testing procedures; or
- (ii) use by a veterinary surgeon in any procedure/s performed for lifesaving purposes; or
- (iii) in the use of veterinary regenerative therapies for the treatment of musculoskeletal injury or disease, as the case may be.

2. ADD NEW AR 88E AS FOLLOWS:

AR 88E Horses that have had a bloodletting procedure

- (i) If a horse has been subjected to a bloodletting procedure in Australia:
 - (a) the horse is ineligible for a minimum period of 12 months; and
 - (b) a person must not enter or start the horse in, any race, official trial, jump-out or track work.
- (2) If a horse is subject to a bloodletting procedure, the owner of the horse or that owner's authorised agent must provide written notification of that to the Stewards as soon as practicable. The Stewards will then seek to ensure that:
 - (a) details of the procedure and the horse's ineligibility to race are recorded in Racing Australia's national online database; and
 - (b) if applicable, the Thoroughbred Identification Card of the horse is endorsed with details of the procedure and the horse's ineligibility to race.

Date of Effect: 1 May 2024

HORSES THAT HAVE NOT STARTED FOR 12+ MONTHS

Policy

Where a horse has not raced for 12 months or longer, a satisfactory veterinary clearance must be obtained and the horse must trial satisfactorily before being granted permission to nominate for a race.

Protocols

1. Veterinary clearance before trialing
The trainer of a horse that has not raced for 12 months or longer must produce to the Stewards a veterinary clearance as well as any other information, examination or report they require, from a qualified veterinary surgeon indicating that the horse is suitable to resume trialing and racing.

Details of any injury or medical condition which might have caused the prolonged break from training or racing must be provided with the veterinary clearance. Following receipt of a satisfactory veterinary clearance, the Stewards may grant written permission for the horse to be nominated for and participate in an official trial or jump-out.

2. Satisfactory trial If permission to trial is granted by the Stewards, the horse must:
 - (a) participate in an official trial or jump-out to the satisfaction of the Stewards; and,
 - b) have a post-trial veterinary examination (conducted by a qualified veterinary surgeon) to ensure that the horse is suitable to continue its training regime.
3. Permission to race Following a satisfactory trial and upon receiving the above satisfactory post-trial veterinary examination report, the Stewards may grant written permission for the horse to be nominated for and participate in a race.

STEWARDS SEGMENT

BARRIER CERTIFICATE AUTHORISATION

1. In accordance with Local Rule 8.3, an unraced horse must not be permitted to start until it has been issued with a barrier certificate after performing satisfactorily in a trial, over at least 600 metres, with at least two other horses.

LR 8.3 Unraced horses must have a barrier certificate obtained in an official trial prior to the closing of acceptances.

LOCAL RULE 8.3

Unraced horses must have a barrier certificate obtained in an official trial prior to the closing of acceptances; in the event that an unraced horse has been issued a barrier certificate by interstate stewards, the horse may be permitted to start provided that vision of the unofficial trial is readily available and the performance is deemed satisfactory by the Chairman of Stewards.

2. A horse will only be issued with a barrier certificate if it is seen to be tractable when entering, standing in and jumping away from the barriers.

3. A horse will only be issued with a barrier certificate if:

- It is ridden into the barriers with minimal assistance (one attendant with a lead on the bridle and a gentle guide behind)
- It stands without assistance with all four feet on the ground
- It jumps out in a satisfactory manner

4. A horse will not be issued with a barrier certificate if:

- It has to be 'lifted' into the barriers
- It is fractious or laying to excess on the side of the stall

- It rears or attempts to burrow under the front gates

- It stands flat footed and fails to jump away (2 lengths)

- It jumps out and starts to buck

- It jumps out and does a left or right hand turn

5. Barrier Blankets:

Application for approval of a barrier blanket must be made prior to acceptances for the race it is intended to start. The blanket must be placed on the horse prior to it being ridden into the barriers and it must be tractable when loading and standing in the barriers

6. Blind fold and Stallion Chains:

For safety reasons, it is the Office of Racing Integrity's policy that horses using blind folds or stallion chains shall be loaded into the barriers riderless. Application for approval of a blind fold or stallion chain must be made prior to acceptances for the race it is intended to start. The horse must satisfactorily enter the barriers with the blind fold or stallion chain on.

7. Before issuing barrier certificates, the document of description must be supplied to the steward who must ensure that all brands and markings are verified against the horse.

STEWARDS SEGMENT CONTINUED

HORSES THAT HAVE NOT STARTED FOR 12+ MONTHS

Policy

Where a horse has not raced for 12 months or longer, a satisfactory veterinary clearance must be obtained and the horse must trial satisfactorily before being granted permission to nominate for a race.

Protocols

1. Veterinary clearance before trialing
The trainer of a horse that has not raced for 12 months or longer must produce to the Stewards a veterinary clearance as well as any other information, examination or report they require, from a qualified veterinary surgeon indicating that the horse is suitable to resume trialing and racing.

Details of any injury or medical condition which might have caused the prolonged break from training or racing must be provided with the veterinary clearance. Following

2. Satisfactory trial If permission to trial is granted by the Stewards, the horse must:
 - (a) participate in an official trial or jump-out to the satisfaction of the Stewards; and,
 - b) have a post-trial veterinary examination (conducted by a qualified veterinary surgeon) to ensure that the horse is suitable to continue its training regime.
3. Permission to race Following a satisfactory trial and upon receiving the above satisfactory post-trial veterinary examination report, the Stewards may grant written permission for the horse to be nominated for and participate in a race.
