



1. OBJECTIVE

To detail the circumstances when a driving fee is paid to a driver for a horse that is a late scratching.

2. DEFINITION

2.1 A late scratching is defined as a horse that is scratched after 8.00 am on race day.

3. POLICY

- 3.1 If a horse is on course at a race meeting and is subsequently a late scratching from the meeting, a driving fee will be paid.
- 3.2 If a horse has the trainer listed as a driver and is a late scratching prior to arrival at a race meeting, a driving fee will not be paid.
- 3.3 If a horse is a late scratching prior to arrival at the course, and the trainer is not listed as the driver, the driver will be paid a driving fee provided that the driver has travelled 150 kilometres or more (return) to attend the race meeting and does not drive two or more horses at the race meeting.

4. GENERAL

- 4.1 Tasracing reserves the right to make the final determination in relation to any aspect of this policy in its sole discretion.
