

Trainers are reminded of the following Rules of Racing;

193. (3) A person shall not administer or allow or cause to be administered any medication to a horse on race day prior to such horse running in a race.

196C. (1) A person must not administer an alkalinising agent in any manner to a horse which is engaged to run in a race:

- (a) at any time on the day of the scheduled race and prior to the start of the race;*
- (b) at any time within one (1) clear day of the commencement of the race.*

Definition - "One clear day" means the twenty four (24) hour period from 12.01 a.m. to midnight.

Trainers are advised that any breach of these rules may result in severe penalties being imposed.
