A post race swab sample was taken from the winner FINE AUSSIE.

Stewards questioned trainer A Bullock into the improved performance of his greyhound FINE AUSSIE.

Mr Bullock explained he was not surprised to see the greyhound win tonight as it has been trialling well in recent weeks however there was no support from his kennel.

Mr Bullock further explained that the greyhound has had a 6 week break with an injury which may have contributed to the improved performance. Stewards noted the trainer's comments for future reference.

Stewards questioned trainer Adam Collis into the disappointing performance of SEA SICK. Trainer Collis was at a loss to explain the performance and was of the opinion that the greyhound may not have backed up from his two runs last week in Hobart and raced like a tired greyhound tonight. A post race veterinarian examination once the greyhound had cooled down revealed an elevated temperature on the second visit. The trainer was advised that a recheck by his own vet along with blood tests is recommended. The greyhound was stood down for a period of 10 days.
