Race 8 ONE OFF NZ: T Ford

Race 9 KARALTA DAZZLER: T Ford

RACE 1 - NUTRIEN AG SUPPLIES TWO YEAR OLD - 1680 METRES

PROMISE STRIDE broke in the early part of the score up, however was in position at the start and no action was taken.

WAVES STRIDE locked wheels with ART HUNTSMAN racing to the first turn.

ART HUNTSMAN hung in shortly after the start and contacted the sulky of GYPSY AMOUR before breaking. Shortly after this colt again hung in and locked wheels with another runner. A warning has been placed on the manners of this colt.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES DISCRETIONARY – 2200 METRES

The All Clear was delayed on this event when the Driver G Rattray (COLBY SANZ) requested to view the films of the start. After viewing the replays All Clear was given on the Judges numbers.

COLBY SANZ galloped out and has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

DIAMONDS N CASH NZ galloped out and has been placed out of the draw in future standing start events.

After beginning satisfactorily YOUNG ROOSTER has been reinstated in the draw.

COLBY SANZ was over racing and held up around the home turn and made contact with the sulky of THE SHALLOWS before gaining clear running in the home straight.

RACE 3 - TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT STAKES - 2200 METRES

MARCELLA was out of position at the start and has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

GOING GREAT GUNS was caught wide early before restraining to the rear of the field.

MAYS PLACE had a tendency to hang out during the event. A warning was issued.

MAYS PLACE over raced and contacted MAYS PLACE sulky shortly after the bell. No action was taken.

ALL FOR DAVE shifted out under pressure in the home straight

MARCELLA underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 77 metres. No abnormalities were detected and the filly has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

RACE 4 – FIND US ON FACEBOOK STAKES – 2200 METRES

EMJAYS BLACK CHIP was caught wide early before working forward to race outside the leader before giving ground to be beaten in excess of 37 metres.

SPOT ON NZ was held up and unable to be fully tested.

ONEOFTHELADS was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

Racing down the back straight the final time COOL SCOOTER NZ shifted out to gain clear running. BRIDWOOD BELLA was trailing this runner and was slow to respond when checked and momentarily ran onto the back of the sulky of COOL SCOOTER NZ.

RACE 5 - 6TY PACE - 2200 METRES

ROCKS ROY was out of position at the start and has been placed on its last chance in the draw.

CASTLE RETREAT was caught wide early before working forward to race outside the leader then gained a trail when PUNTARNO STRIDE NZ worked forward to take over that position.

EQUITY STRIDE shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

CASTLE RETREAT shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

MAJOR ASSASSIN underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 90 metres. No abnormalities were detected and the gelding has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

ROCKS ROY underwent a post-race veterinary examination after the event which revealed an injury to its near foreleg. ROCKS ROY has been stood down for a period of 21 days and until the receipt of a veterinary clearance.

After beginning satisfactorily WE SALUTE YOU has been reinstated in the mobile draw.

Stewards queried the apparent improved performance of EQUITY STRIDE. Trainer Mr B Yole stated that this gelding performed much better when able to lead in its races and last start had pulled very hard ruining his chances. Stewards noted Mr Yoles explanation for future reference.

RACE 6 – LADBROKES RACING CENTRE PACE – 2200 METRES

TEE JAY CEE hung in shortly after the start and locked wheels with JUNIPER. A warning was issued.

FOREGONE CONCLUSION NZ was restrained to the rear of the field.

PROFICIENT NZ was caught wide early before working forward to race outside the leader.

QUEENOFDANCE NZ pulled hard during the event.

RACE 7 - CARLTON DRAUGHT STAKES - 2200 METRES

AHA REACTION NZ was out of position at the start.

ROCK ON PLAYBOY was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

HICKSTEAD NZ shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

JAWBREAKER underwent a post-race veterinary examination after racing outside the leader before pulling hard and eventually tiring to be beaten in excess of 76 metres. The examination revealed the gelding to be slightly lame. JAWBREAKER has been stood down until the receipt of a veterinary clearance.

Stewards spoke to Trainer B Yole and Driver M Ford regarding the manners of AHA REACTION NZ during the score up and also during the race when travelling fiercely. Mr Yole undertook to utilise a senior driver on this horse in the immediate future.

Driver N Ford (TAROONA BROMAC NZ) was reprimanded under AHRR168(1)(a). Particulars were that he shifted his horse into a run that that hadn't fully developed in the home straight and as a consequence Driver D Ford (PARDOE PLUGGA) was obliged to shift further up the track to avoid contacting the front legs of TAROONA BROMAC NZ.

RACE 8 – VIZPIX BROADCAST SERVICES STAKES – 1680 METRES

KING OF COOL broke in the early stages of the score up however was in position at the start

IDEAL KARALTA broke free of interference approaching the first turn and has been placed on his last chance to race truly.

BOULDER CITY was caught wide early before being restrained to the rear of the field.

CLASSIE AMERICAN NZ raced outside of the leader in the early stages before SOUTHSHORE NZ worked forward to take over that position.

TO THE LOOKOUT was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

ONE OFF NZ was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

CINOCAL JAMANE gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 48 metres.

RACE 9 – TASSIE WASH PACE – 2200 METRES

The start of this race was delayed due to a gear replacement needed on REMEMBER ME NOW NZ

Shortly after the start REMEMBER ME NOW NZ suffered a broken hopple connector strap and was retired from the event. Stewards inspected the gear and found it to be in satisfactory condition.

VIVID STRIDE was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

DON HESTON hung out under pressure in the home straight.

MAJOR DAVVIN obtained an inside run in the home straight.
