All horses engaged in tonight's meeting that raced on Friday the 30th of September 2022 at Hobart underwent a veterinary examination after racing and prior to racing tonight. All horses were deemed suitable to start.

RACE 1 – FIND US ON FACEBOOK PACE – 2200 METRES

SPORTS ILLUSTRATOR was out of position at the start. No action taken.

IMPULZE was out of position at the start. No action taken.

ALL FOR DAVE was out of position at the start. No action taken.

MISS PAPENHUYZEN was out of position at the start. No action taken.

MAYS PLACE was out of position at the start. No action taken.

BIG BOY MAL was restrained after the start, then raced greenly during the event and was held up and unable to be fully tested.

SPORTS ILLUSTRATOR was held up and unable to be fully tested.

RACE 2 – NUTRIEN AG SUPPLIES PACE – 2200 METRES

YOUNG ROOSTER was caught wide early before being to the rear of the field

A warning was issued to MAJOR GENERALJUJON who hung in and contacted a marker peg.

EUREKA NZ was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

HICKSTEAD NZ was held up early before gaining clear running in the home straight.

MAJOR GENERALJUJON underwent a post-race veterinary after tiring to be beaten in excess of 74 metres. No abnormalities were detected and the gelding was placed on its last chance to race competitively.

RACE 3 – GREAT NORTHERN SUPER CRISP STAKES – 1680 METRES

WATTABOUT SPANGHER pulled hard and hung out in the score-up before being out of position at the start.

WATTABOUT SPANGHER hung out racing into the first turn checking NO NUKES SKIPPER NZ which was following. A warning was issued.

KIAVINO STRIDE was caught wide early before restraining to a position in the running line.

BEAST MODE pulled hard and contacted his own sulky wheels before hanging in and contacting several marker pegs. No action was taken however Trainer B Yole was reminded to take remedial action to prevent a recurrence.

NO NUKES SKIPPER NZ was inconvenienced racing into the first time when the preceding runner hung out and was checked.

JACK JAMES underwent a post-race veterinary examination after giving ground to be beaten in excess of 49 metres. No abnormalities were detected.

RACE 4 – CARLTON DRAUGHT STAKES – 1680 METRES

All clear was held on this event when driver M Jones (BIGLITTLESIS) requested to view patrol film of the final straight. After viewing the films All Clear was given on the judges numbers.

AUNTY BESSY galloped shortly after the start and has been placed out of the draw in future mobile events.

CAROLS JUDGE was inconvenienced after the start when AUNTY BESSY galloped.

A warning was issued to LAFOND which hung in and contacted marker pegs around the final time.

LAFOND shifted out under pressure in the home straight. A warning was issued.

AUNTY BESSY broke free of interference during the event and has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

LALIBELA NZ was caught wide early before being restrained to the rear of the field.

RACE 5 – TASSIE WASH STAKES – 2200 METRES

WHATTA GOOD REASON was caught wide early before working forward to race outside the leader.

LAVROS MIDAS TOUCH NZ was caught wide early before restraining to the rear of the field.

VELOCITY STRIDE pulled hard during the event.

SOUTHSHORE NZ shifted out under pressure in the home straight the final time.

RACE 6 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT SHOW CUP – 2200 METRES

AHA REACTION NZ galloped shortly after the start and will continue to be out of the draw in standing start events.

JAWBREAKER raced roughly after the start and raced inside a marker peg shortly after.

JAWBREAKER pulled hard during the event.

COLBY SANZ pulled hard during the event.

A warning was issued to JAWBREAKER who hung in and contacted marker pegs around the final turn.

RACE 7 – RARE EARTH STAKES – 2200 METRES

RAMBLEON was out of position at the start and has been placed on its last chance in the mobile draw.

MONTANA LAD NZ was caught wide early before working forward to race outside the leader.

DEADLY ASSASSIN was held up and unable to be fully tested.

A warning was issued to OUR BALOU who hung in around the final time locking wheels with MONTANA LAD NZ.

BETTER AMOUR was tightened and raced inside several marker pegs around the final time.

A warning was issued to ROCK ON PLAYBOY who shifted out under pressure in the home straight

RAMBLEON tired over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 54 metres. The gelding has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

RACE 8 – LADBROKES RACING CENTRE PACE – 2200 METRES

STAR RULER NZ underwent a veterinary examination before the event and was passed fit to race.

KING OF COOL refused to score-up at the first attempt and caused a false start. The gelding has been placed out of the draw in future mobile events.

ARTYBOY GLEWOOD was caught wide early before restraining to the rear of the field and then pulled hard during the event.

TEE JAY CEE worked forward three wide in the middle stages to race outside the leader.

SEA HAWKE pulled hard during the event

IM QUITE AMERICAN underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 50 metres. No abnormalities were detected and the gelding has been stood down for 14 days and until the completion of two satisfactory trials.

RACE 9 – TRAINERS ENCOURAGEMENT PACE – 2200 METRES

BRIDWOOD BELLA hung out in the score-up and was out of position at the start. This mare was placed out of the draw in future mobile events.

DELIGHTFUL JUNIE was checked and broke around the final turn

BAROOGA ROCK hung in broke around the final time severely checking PRINCELY REIGN and checking DELIGHTFUL JUNIE

PRINCELY REIGN was severely checked and broke on the final turn.
