

STEWARDS REPORT

RACE 1 – CAVALOR EQUICARE PACE – 2090 METRES

MILITARY MAN NZ caught wide during the early stages and restrained to the rear of the field.

GOBSMACKED pulled hard at various stages and was held up for clear racing room entering the home straight.

LORD VERDE NZ held up for clear racing room over the concluding stages.

PLEASE SHUDDUP NZ sulky tyre deflated during the running of this event.

RACE 2 – PRYDES EASIFEED PACE – 2090 METRES

WHATTA GOOD REASON caught wide early before working forward to sit outside the leader. This gelding received cover when SOMEDAN worked around the field during the middle stages to sit outside the leader.

SPOT ON NZ caught wide early and restrained to the rear of the field.

WHATTA GOOD REASON tired, to be beaten in excess of 55 metres. This gelding underwent a post-race veterinary examination that revealed no apparent abnormalities. WHATTA GOOD REASON has been stood down for 14 days and until the completion of two satisfactory trials.

VALOUR STRIDE tired, to be beaten in excess of 54 metres. This gelding underwent a post-race veterinary examination that revealed this gelding to be sore in the left hind leg. VALOUR STRIDE has been stood down until the receipt of a veterinary clearance.

RACE 3 – LADBROKES PACE – 2090 METRES

JOHN RICHARD caught wide early, before being restrained to a position in the one out line.

STAROFREMEMBRANCE utilised the sprint lane.

CINOCAL JAMANE has been placed back in the draw for future mobile start events.

RACE 4 – NUTRIEN SPRINTLANE PACE – 2090 METRES

CANTSEEME broke during the score up and was out of position at the start. This mare has been placed outside the draw in future mobile start events.

CHARMEDFORAREASON broke after the start and will continue to be placed outside the draw in future mobile start events. This mare gave ground over the concluding stages.

CANTSEEME over raced for a few strides in the back straight on the first occasion, contacting the sulky of HALIS BOY. CZARINA who was travelling behind CANTSEEME was momentarily inconvenienced.

STONY THE SPY utilised the sprint lane.

RACE 5 – MOORE CONSULTING PACE – 1609 METRES

FURY DAN caught wide early before working forward to race outside the leader.

SHAUN TO THE MAX raced three-wide throughout.

RACE 6 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT PACE. – 1609 METRES

BACKINTOWN failed to present on track by the appointed time. This gelding was a late scratching at 8:06PM.

ROAD RUNNER NZ broke as the field raced towards the home turn on the first occasion. This gelding has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

OUR BALOU checked and broke as a result of the galloping ROAD RUNNER.

JACK JAMES held up late for clear racing room.

Trainer Ben Yole pleaded guilty to a charge under AHHR 45(5) in that he presented the incorrect horse to start in this race, after the Stewards inspected a horse in the stabling area presented as BACKINTOWN when this was not in fact that runner. It was established that the incorrect horse had been inadvertently transported to the meeting and that BACKINTOWN was not on course. BACKINTOWN was declared a late scratching by order of the Stewards at 8:06pm.

In assessing penalty Stewards were mindful of Mr. Yole's guilty plea, his prior good record, and accepting that the circumstances surrounding the error were accidental. Being mindful of previous penalties imposed, the seriousness of the offence, specific and the requirement for both specific and general deterrence, Mr. Yole was fined the sum of \$1000.00

RACE 7 – TASMANIA CUP 18TH MARCH PACE – 2090 METRES

KENYA NZ caught wide early before restraining to the rear of the field.

CAPTAIN COSMONAUT raced roughly and broke for a few strides while being restrained off the back of CHRISTIAN MAJOR who had elected to progress three wide as the field approached the bell.

WAYONBYE hung in and raced roughly for a few strides while being eased off the back of STALEY as the field raced towards the back straight on the first occasion.

WAYONBYE held up for clear racing room as the field raced into the home straight on the final occasion. WAYONBYE after initially hanging up the track, raced roughly and broke for a few strides while being eased off the back of KENYA NZ (Nathan Ford). This gelding has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

EYE SEE DOUBLE locked wheels with STALEY who had momentarily hung down the track as the field raced into the home straight on the final occasion.

DAPPER NZ contacted the inside sulky wheel of WAYONBYE and broke as the field raced into the home straight on the final occasion.

CAPTAIN COSMONAUT checked and broke by the galloping DAPPER NZ.

DYNAMIC DAN utilised the sprint lane.

Driver Tiarna Ford pleaded guilty to a charge under AHRR 168(1)(a) in that as the driver of DAPPER NZ she attempted to progress to the inside of WAYONBYE as the field raced into the home straight on the final occasion when in the opinion of Stewards there was insufficient room to do so. Ms. Ford was fined the sum of \$100.

RACE 8 – CASCADE DRAUGHT PACE – 2090 METRES

ABS BOY caught wide early before being restrained to the rear of the field.

PROSECUTION WITNESS NZ caught wide early before being restrained to the rear of the field.

NINE DIAMONDS utilised the sprint lane.

ISLAS JOY NZ tired, to be beaten in excess of 55 metres. This gelding underwent a post-race veterinary examination that revealed no apparent abnormalities. This gelding has been stood down for a period of fourteen days and until the completion of two satisfactory trials.
