

## STEWARDS REPORT

### **RACE 1 – PRYDES EASIFEED PACE – 2090M**

CARDINAL SIN NZ hung out in the score up and was reluctant to fill its position behind the mobile. After taking into consideration its recent record behind the barrier the gelding has been placed on its last chance in the mobile draw.

CHEDDAR VALLEY NZ broke shortly after the start and has been placed out of the draw in future mobile events.

DYNAMIC DAN showed gate speed to race outside the leader throughout.

LORIMER LADY hung in rounding the home turn when attempting to improve its position.

SEACHANGE hung in and contacted a marker peg when giving ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 45 metres.

MARIANNA BROMAC NZ was held up approaching the home turn before gaining clear running in the home straight.

### **RACE 2 – TYPEFACE PACE – 2090M**

VAN NIEKERK NZ swung sideways as the start was effected and the galloped for a short distance. The gelding has been placed on its last chance in future standing start events.

KARALTA DAZZLER worked forward in the middle stages to race outside the leader before giving ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 40 metres.

Driver O Weidenbach, (OZZIE MAJOR) was fined the sum of \$200 after pleading guilty to a charge under AHRR156(2)(a). Particulars were that she used her whip with more than a wrist only flicking motion.

### **RACE 3 – TAS HORSE TRANSPORT PACE – 2090M**

BEE SEVENTEEN was well out of position as the start was effected and has been placed on its last chance in the mobile draw.

LONGNWINDINGROAD showed gate speed to lead before obtaining a trail in the early stages.

CINOCAL JAMANE worked forward to the lead before surrendering the lead in the middle stages. The mare used the sprint lane to win the event.

BRIAN WHO worked forward in the middle stages to lead the event.

STAR ROCKER raced outside the leader and pulled hard during the event.

CLASSY COUNTESS was held up around the final time before gaining clear running in the home straight.

### **RACE 4 – GOOD FRIDAY DUAL CODE RACE MEETING PACE – 2090M**

MAJOR MUCHA showed gate speed before restraining to a position behind the leader.

HOT EMBERS showed gate speed to lead before surrendering the lead in the middle stages then gave ground to be beaten in excess of 45 metres.

SEA HAWKE raced outside the leader early and had a tendency to pull hard before working to the lead at the 1400 metre mark.

IFBUTZANDMAYBES raced ungenerously during the event then broke at around the 400 metre mark. The gelding has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

### **RACE 5 – NUTRIEN SPRINTLANE PACE – 1609M**

LORIMERTYRRELL worked forward to race outside the leader throughout.

FURY DAN broke twice during the event and has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

SPOOKY GIRL hung in and broke racing into the back straight the final time and has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

RANIERI NZ used the sprint lane in the run to the finish.

Driver J White, (JEDI MIND) was fined the sum of \$200 after pleading guilty to a charge under AHRR156(2)(a). Particulars were that he used his whip with more than a wrist only flicking motion.

### **RACE 6 – LADBROKES PACE – 2090M**

ULTIMATE ME NZ showed gate speed to lead then withstood a challenge from VELOCITY STRIDE.

VIVID STRIDE was caught wide early before restraining to rear of the field.

SUTTER STAR raced outside the leader early before obtaining a trail in the middle stages. Driver R Ashwood was advised to modify his whip action to prevent any breaches of the whip rule.

REDS GOOD TO GO was caught wide early before restraining to rear of the field.

VELOCITY STRIDE worked forward in the early stages and unsuccessfully contested for the lead then raced outside the leader before tiring to be beaten in excess of 59 metres. The gelding has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

THE DUDE NZ raced roughly during the event.

BE GOOD BENNY hung in and contacted a marker peg racing to the back straight the final time and then used the sprint lane in the run to the finish.

Stewards inquired into the reasons for JACKS N JAZZ NZ breaking at the 550 metre mark. After taking evidence from drivers D Ford, (VELOCITY STRIDE) T Madden, (JACKS N JAZZ NZ) and J Duggan, (ABS BOY) it was established that as VELOCITY STRIDE was tiring back through the field JACKS N JAZZ NZ was held up and unable to avoid contact with the rear of the sulky of VELOCITY STRIDE due to being covered by ABS BOY. As Stewards could not be satisfied any one driver could be held responsible for this incident no action was taken.

### **RACE 7 – CAVALOR EQUICARE PACE – 2090M**

OUR SEQUEL NZ was caught wide early before restraining to the rear of the field.

SAPPHIRE GAMBLER used the sprint lane to win the event.

JUNIPER used the sprint lane in the run to the finish.

OUR BALOU raced outside the leader and pulled hard before giving ground to be beaten in excess of 41 metres.

### **RACE 8 – YOUNG GROUP PACE – 2579M**

WHERE YA BIN NZ led early before obtaining a trail when LORD VERDE NZ worked around to take over that position.

SCOTLYNN BEACH NZ was restrained after the start.

JACK JAMES was held up early and raced roughly around the home turn before gaining clear running in the home straight.

A warning was issued to TAROONA BROMAC NZ which gave ground to be beaten in excess of 55 metres.
