Horses that raced at Burnie on Friday 13th underwent pre-race veterinary inspections and were passed suitable to run.

RACE 1 – PRYDES EASIFEED PACE – 1609 METRES

ROCK AMOUR hung out and then raced roughly shortly after the start. Placed on its last chance to race truly after breaking approaching the 400 metre mark.

MACKEON tired to be beaten in excess of 65 metres and has been placed on its last chance to race competitively.

RACE 2 - CAVALOR EQUICARE PACE - 1609 METRES

NOBLEZZZ ADVICE underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed suitable to run.

HY ON A HILL worked forward in the middle stages to race outside the leader.

RACE 3 - CASCADE DRAUGHT PACE PACE - 2090 METRES

TWO SOCK CREEK NZ broke in the score up inconveniencing the following runner however was in position when the start was effected. The gelding has been placed on its last chance in future mobile events.

I OF THE HURRIKANE was caught wide early before working forward to race outside the leader then gained a trail when **NYACK** worked forward in the middle stages.

LETSPLAYUNI was inconvenienced during the score up then underwent a post-race veterinary examination after tiring to be beaten in excess of 112 metres. No abnormalities were detected and the gelding has been stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES RACING CLUB PACE – 2090 METRES

MORE THAN THIS raced outside the leader throughout.

HALIS BOY gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 47 metres.

PACIFIC ROCK gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 50 metres.

KELLYS DELIGHT gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten in excess of 43 metres

RACE 5 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT PACE – 1609 METRES

LAID BACK KENNY failed to circle unassisted and will continue to be right out of the draw in mobile events.

VIGOROSO NZ broke shortly after the start and has been placed out of the draw in future mobile events.

SHARKATTACK was held up early before using the sprint lane to win the event.

ROCKS ROY worked forward in the middle stages to race outside the leader.

RACE 6 – NUTRIEN SPRINTLANE PACE – 2090 METRES

SNEAKY PEAK raced outside the leader early before gaining a trail.

MONEYS NO ISSUE was caught wide early before working forward three wide to race outside the leader.

RUBY BABY NZ underwent a post-race veterinary examination after giving ground to be beaten in excess of 41 metres. No abnormalities were detected.

RACE 7 - MORE CONFIDENCE PACE - 2090 METRES

RACE 8 – YOUNG GROUP PACE – 2579 METRES

PUNTARNO STRIDE NZ galloped out and has been placed out of the draw in future standing start events.

STEPPING STONES stepped and led before surrendering the lead in the middle stages when **VILLACCI** worked around the field to take over the front.

PUNTARNO STRIDE NZ worked around the field to race outside the leader before gaining a trail in the middle stages.

CHECK IN NZ worked forward in the middle stages to race outside the leader.

RACE 9 – DYNAMO 10TH NOVEMBER PACE – 2090 METRES

All clear was held on this event when Driver D Ford (**DENWEN DANCER**) which was placed third indicated that he wished to view the official replay of the concluding stages. After review of the films Mr Ford declined to take any further action and all clear was declared on the Judge's numbers.

DUKE OF DUNDEE NZ underwent a pre-race veterinary examination before the event and was passed suitable to run.

SCOTLYNN BEACH NZ was out of position at the start and will continue to be out of the draw in mobile events.

KERALA STAR NZ was caught wide early before working forward to race outside the leader and then commenced to pull hard.

STARVIN MARVIN NZ underwent a post-race veterinary examination after giving ground to be beaten in excess of 45 metres. No abnormalities were detected.

RACE 10 - LADBROKES HUB PACE - 2090 METRES

CARIBBEAN DELIGHT broke in the score up severely checking **LORD VERDE NZ** and took no competitive part in the event. The mare has been placed out of the draw in future mobile events.

LORD VERDE NZ was out of position at the start after being checked when CARIBBEAN DELIGHT broke in the score up.

HELANSIN was caught wide early before restraining to the rear of the field. The gelding was checked when **LORD VERDE NZ** raced roughly approaching the 800 metre mark.
