RACE 1 – PRYDES EASIFEED DYNAMO PACE – 1120m Mobile

RACE 2 – MORE CONFIDENCE CONSULTING DYNAMO PACE – 1120m Mobile

HES APPLES has been placed back in the mobile start draw.

RACE 3 – INTERSPORT HOBART DYNAMO PACE – 1120m Mobile

BOTANY BAY WARRIOR broke free of interference as the field raced out of the home straight. This horse has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

CAROLS JUDGE was inconvenienced by the galloping BOTANY BAY WARRIOR.

CHARMEDFORAREASON broke free of interference as the field raced into the back straight. This horse has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

UPSIZE ME NZ contacted marker pegs approaching the home turn after being tightened for clear racing room by the tiring MODERN JIVE.

RACE 4 – LADBROKE IT DYNAMO PACE – 1220m Mobile

RACE 5 – TASRACING DYNAMO PACE – 1120m Mobile

JUSTIFY raced roughly for a few strides during the score up.

LOU LOUS ALLGOLD broke gait as the field raced towards the first turn. This mare has been placed on its last chance to race truly.

RACE 6 – INTERTSPORT KINGSTON DYNAMO PACE – 1120m Mobile

TWO SOCK CREEK NZ raced roughly and broke gait for a few strides shortly after the start. Due to this gelding's recent poor mobile start record it has been placed outside the draw in future mobile start events.

RACE 7 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT DYNAMO PACE– 1120m Mobile

RACE 8 – CAVALOR EQUICARE DYNAMO PACE – 1120m Mobile

General:

Stewards concluded an inquiry into the reasons why MONTANA LAD NZ (Ben Yole) failed to present for a pre-race swab (TCO2) prior to the running of race 4 the Cavalor Equicare Pace at the Tasmanian Trotting Club (TTC) meeting on 29 October 2023.

The Office of Racing Integrity (ORI) accepts responsibility for ensuring participants are notified of the requirement to present a horse to be swabbed and to follow up in a timely manner if a horse fails to be presented at the allocated time.

It has been established that on this occasion MONTANA LAD NZ failed to be presented due to a communication error between ORI and trainer Ben Yole. As a consequence, MONTANA LAD NZ remained on course two and a half hours after its race to provide a post-race swab (TCO2), the equivalent of the intended pre-race swab.
