Supplementary:

RACE 1 – PRYDES EASIFEED PACE – 1609M MOBILE

JAKCLIFF – Showed gate speed.

SHADES SILK – Worked forward in the middle stages, raced rough at times throughout the event.

KUNGFULATOR – Restrained to the rear at the start.

BOLT OF COBARGO – Showed gate speed to lead, surrendered the lead early.

STONE WRITER – Worked forward shortly after the start to lead.

RACE 2 – CAVALOR EQUICARE PACE – 2020M MOBILE

ALWAYSBEALADY – Showed gate speed to lead the event before surrendering the leading position.

SOUTHERN LUCK – Showed gate speed.

CARDINAL SIN NZ – Commenced to give ground from the 600m and finished with a flat near side tyre. No action was taken due to the flat tyre.

SHOON – Showed gate speed to sit outside the leader.

SAPPHIRE GAMBLER – Restrained at the start.

KEAYANG FITZY – Showed gate speed and raced three wide in the early stages and progressed forward to lead the event.

RACE 3 – MORE CONFIDENCE CONSULTING PACE – 1609M MOBILE

SUE NIEN – Driver questioned and reminded of obligations to ensure he has his drives fully in position by the candy pole. Stewards took into account that he was in position as the start was affected.

SNEAKY PEAK – Showed gate speed and utilized the sprint lane in the run to the finish.

LIFEOFBRIAN NZ – Showed gate speed to lead the event. Hung outwards under pressure in the run to the finish.

ALBERIO – Showed gate speed and gained the position outside the leader.

REMEMBER ME NOW NZ – Restrained at the start. Pulled hard in a trailing position. Hung outwards at various stages.

COVEFFE HUSTLER – Restrained at the start.

RACE 4 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT PACE – 2090M MOBILE

WHAT A WOMAN – Had a tendency to race roughly in the score up. Commenced to give ground over the final 500m. Post race veterinarian examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer was advised the filly will be stood down until a completion of 1 satisfactory trial given the beaten margin.

DISTINCTIVE STRIDE – Showed gate speed to lead the event. Had a tendency to hang outwards while in the leading position. Broke free of interference making the 300m turn. Given the geldings previous race record DISTINCTIVE STRIDE will be stood down until the completion of 2 satisfactory trials prior to its next race start.

B K WINDERMERE NZ – Showed gate speed and gained the position outside the leader.

TASSIE DAZZLER – Broke free of interference in the front straight given the geldings previous good record was placed on its last chance to race truly.

LEWICKI LEIS – Driver questioned and reprimanded for failing to maintain his position behind the starting gate until the start. Stewards took into account the drivers good record under this rule.

ULTIMATE MOD – Broke free of interference in the front straight and was placed on its last chance to race truly given its previous good race record. Trainer when questioned advised it was out of character and would be making some changes.

IDEN KAMAKAZI – Raced three wide from the 900m in a trailing position.

MAJOR IDEAL – Raced three wide in the middle stages. Commenced to give ground from the 900m and will be stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial given the beaten margin.

NOT YET MUM – Left a trailing position to race at the lead of the three wide line from the 800m.

RACE 5 – LADBROKE IT! PACE – 2090M MOBILE

FIESTA STRIDE – Showed gate speed and gained a trail behind the leader. Had a tendency to pull hard in the run. Tired over the final 400m and will be required to trial to the satisfaction of stewards on 1 occasion prior to its next race start. Stewards took into consideration the beaten margin on this occasion.

EYE SEE DOUBLE – Showed gate speed from the barrier.

IMPULZE – Gained the position outside the leader. Hung inwards entering the home straight on the final occasion.

NO NUKES SKIPPER NZ- Showed gate speed to lead the event. Raced in restricted room entering the front straight on the final occasion and contacted marker pegs.

SPOOKY GIRL – Commenced to tire over the final stages and when questioned the trainer advised the stewards, that the Mare will be going for an immediate spell. SPOOKY GIRL was stood down until a completion of a satisfactory official trial prior to its next race start.

MONEYS NO ISSUE – Was held up for a clear run in the early part of the home straight. Laid in under pressure over the concluding stages.

DAZZLE ME NZ – Trainer queried in relation to the improved performance.

Stewards questioned drivers Olivia Weidenbach (NO NUKES SKIPPER NZ) and Lachlan Dakin (MONEY NO ISSUE) into reasons why NO NUKES SKIPPER NZ entered the sprint lane in the early part of the home straight resulting in MONEY NO ISSUE being momentarily held up for a run. After taking evidence from both drivers and stewards acting on their own observations and viewing the official patrol films it was established that racing towards and entering the front straight IMPULZE Dylan Ford was racing tight to the outside of NO NUKES SKIPPER NZ resulting in that gelding contacting pegs. As the sprint lane came up Olivia Weidenbach found herself half inside the sprint lane. MONEY NO ISSUE Lachlan Dakin was attempting a run to the inside of NO NUKES SKIPPER NZ but did have a tendency to lay outwards and contributed to not getting a clear run. In all instances stewards advised Olivia Weidenbach that in similar circumstances she must ensure she shifts back outwards should the horse she is driving move into the sprint lane when leading. Driver

Dylan Ford will be advised that he should ensure more room is given in similar circumstances.

Stewards questioned trainer Wayne Yole in relation to the improved performance of DAZZLE ME NZ. Trainer Wayne Yole explained that he was not fully surprised to see the gelding form improve as this race was a drop in class and believed its previous starts were better than what it reads on paper. The trainer also advised the stewards, that he has changed the feeding and work regime on the gelding, looking for improvement, and further stated that the gelding needs to get the right run in its races and driven in this manner. Trainer Wayne Yole praised his Driver Mark Yole drive in this event.

Stewards were satisfied with the explanation given and advised Trainer Wayne Yole that they will monitor the gelding in future race starts.

RACE 6 – THE BEAUTIDE 3RD AUGUST PACE 2090M MOBILE

ROCK THE TABLEAU – After showing gate speed and leading the event, surrendered the lead in the early stages. Utilized the sprint lane in the run to the finish.

KIAVINO STRIDE – Sat outside the leader after showing gate speed. Tired over the concluding stages. Trainer was advised that the gelding must trial to the satisfaction of stewards on one occasion prior to its next race start given the beaten margin.

SVITOLINA LEIS – Restrained at the start and left a trailing position at the 900m to race 3 wide thereafter.

KENYA NZ – was caught wide in the early stages after showing gait speed and restrained to the rear.

SPACEWRITER – Gate speed and led the event.

SMOOTH DEAL NZ – Gave ground over the concluding stages and was placed on its last chance to race competitively given its previous good record.

MIKISPUR – Following the running of the event it was reported that MIKISPUR had shown signs of traces of blood coming from one nostril only. A post race veterinarian examination confirmed this, and the gelding was scoped on track by the veterinarian, and it was again confirmed. Trainer Rodney Ashwood was advised of Rule 101 B (2) and informed the gelding shall not be eligible to race until it has trailed to the satisfaction of the stewards.

ALEXIS ROCKET NZ – Gave ground over the final stages and was placed on its last chance to race competitively. Stewards took into account his previous racing record.

RACE 7 – FEHLBERGS PRODUCE SPRINTLANE PACE – 2090M MOBILE

ELIZABETH DELILAH – After showing gate speed obtained a trail behind the leader.

I WANT IT ALL NZ – Showed gate speed and led the event. Had a tendency to shift outwards under pressure in the run to the finish.

RESURGENT REBEL – Gate speed from the barrier and raced wide in the early stages before gaining the position outside the leader.

MARGARETS CLAN – Caught wide in the early stages, before restraining to the rear. Gave ground to be beaten by 153 meters. Post race veterinarian examination revealed the mare suffered an arterial fibrillation. Trainer will be advised the provisions of Rule 101C (2) (a) that the mare will be stood down from racing for 14 days , require the horse to undergo an ECG prior to a trial and then trial to the satisfaction of stewards.

ELENNA – Restrained at the start. Raced wide in a trailing position from the 800m. Trainer was fined for presenting the mare with the wrong number displayed.

QUEENOFDANCE NZ – Restrained at the start. Raced wide in a trailing position from the 800m.

ROCKS ROY – Raced three wide in a trailing position from the 800m.

DAPPER NZ – Raced at the lead of the three wide line from the 900m.

Note: Stewards had a complaint from a member of the public, Mrs. Fiona Steele in relation to some racing stables not parading their horses in the parade area prior to the start of their events. It was also stated that some horses were going straight onto the track rather than parading.

The stewards will be monitoring this allegation and taking the necessary steps to ensure this is not happening.
