**RACE 1 – LADBROKES PUNTER ASSIST PACE - 3YO UPWARDS - MAIDEN**  
**2180m - MOBILE START**

BROADWAY BLING- Had a tendency to lay inwards at various stages of the event and as a result contacted several marker pegs during the run. Was momentarily held up for a clear run in the early part of the home straight.

PISTOL QUEEN- Showed gait speed to lead the event throughout. Shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages. Driver reprimanded for carelessness for allowing his horse to shift outwards.

OUR SWEET TRIXY- Showed gait speed to gain the position outside the leader. Momentarily inconvenienced over the concluding stages.

OBLER- Raced roughly after the start and the trainer was advised the gelding will be placed on its last chance to race truly.

PARTY BLAZE- Raced roughly leaving the front straight on the second occasion and contacted marker pegs.

JILLIBY SORRENTO- Began to give ground racing off the back on the final occasion and was beaten by a margin of 50m. Trainer was advised that the gelding will be placed on its last chance to race competitively.

BARBETTE- Commenced to give ground off the back straight to be beaten over the margin of 50m. Post race veterinarian examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer was advised that the gelding will be placed on its last chance to race competitively.

## **RACE 2 – GREG BYRNE MEMORIAL – NR UP TO 44 - 2180m –**

### **MOBILE START**

ORAVOIR- Showed gait speed and lead the event.

BOLT YOUR SOCKS ON- Restrained at the start and raced roughly at various stages.

TASHS MATE- Raced roughly and broke free of interference and given the geldings good record was placed on its last chance to race truly.

BRIAN WHO- Left a trailing position and raced wide in the middle stages to gain the position outside the leader. Gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten more than 40m. Trainer was advised that the gelding was placed on its last chance to race competitively.

DEADLY ASSASSIN- Raced roughly after the start.

## **RACE 3 – CELEBRATING 70 YEARS OF WIVENHOE GRANDSTAND PACE – 3YO and OLDER PACERS – 2180m - MOBILE START**

MAJOR IDEAL- Was slow in the score up and slow to muster early speed.

DIAMONDSNBLUE- Broke after the start and will be excluded from the draw in mobile starts. Driver fined for carelessness.

HELLO SWEETHEART- Showed gait speed to lead the event.

SOHO UNDERTAKER- Raced roughly and broke gait making the first turn and given its good record was placed on its last chance to race truly.

KEAYANG KEVIN- Had a tendency to race roughly racing off the back straight and out of the front straight on the first occasion.

Stewards questioned drivers Charlie Castles (CEE TEE CHELSEA) and Dylan Ford (DIAMONDSNBLUE) into reasons why Charlie Castles had to check his horse racing into the back straight after receiving the bell. Stewards after taking evidence from both drivers and acting on their own observations and viewing the official patrol films charged Dylan Ford under provisions of rule 168 (1) (a) for carelessness. It was established that DIAMONDSNBLUE was shifted wider at this point, and the move caused CEE TEE CHELSEA to be checked by its driver.

Driver Dylan Ford pleaded Guilty to the charge and was fined a sum of \$100.00. Stewards took into account his good record and the degree of interference in this incident.

**RACE 4 – JOIN US IN 2025 FOR MORE GREAT RACING PACE – NR 45 OR BETTER - 2180M - STANDING START**

QUEENOF THE DANCE – Galloped out and given its previous record was placed out of the draw in future standing start events. Progressed forward in the early stages to lead the event. Gave ground over the concluding stages of the event.

ROCKS ROY – Galloped out and was placed on its last chance in the draw. Gave ground over the concluding stages. Post race veterinarian examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. It was noted that the gelding returned with a broken hople.

COLBY ART – Galloped out and was placed on its last chance in the draw.

OZZIE MAJOR – Galloped out and will continue to be excluded from the draw in standing start events.

OUR RUBY ROSE – Lead the field and surrendered the lead in the middle stages. Hung inwards and contacted marker pegs racing in the front straight to receive the bell.

SMOOTH DEAL NZ – Broke in running and was placed on its last chance to race truly. Trailed the field throughout and took no competitive part.

SVITOLINA LEIS – Galloped out and was placed on its last chance in the draw.

AMBIGUOUS – Raced outside the leader.

**RACE 5 – FRANK CRAWFORD MEMORIAL – NR 55 OR BETTER - 2500M - STANDING START**

BOLD CENTURIAN – Galloped out and was placed on its last chance in the draw. Obtained the leading position in the early stages before surrendering that position to another runner in the front straight on the first occasion.

YAREKON IM SWEET- Galloped out at the start and was placed on its last chance in the draw. Raced wide in the middle stages to gain the position outside the leader.

WILL HE PIKE – Broke gait free of interference making the first turn and given its previous good record was placed on its last chance to race truly.

COLBY SANZ – Galloped out and was placed on its last chance in the draw. Left a trailing position to race three wide off the back straight on the first occasion to gain the position outside the leader. Had a tendency to pull hard while racing outside the leader.

BETTER EXCLUSIVE NZ – Galloped out and was placed on its last chance in the draw. Left a trailing position to race three wide in the front straight to receive the bell. Raced roughly racing out of the front straight on the final occasion.

IMPULZE – Gained the position outside the leader early before progressing forward to challenge and gain the leading position. Was placed back in the draw in standing start events.

KENYA NZ – Galloped out and will remain out of the draw in standing start events.

**RACE 6 – KEVIN REDPATH NORTH WEST PLATE FINAL – NR- 50 OR BETTER - 2180M - STANDING START**

FORSAKEN ME – Galloped out and was placed on its last chance in the draw.

DONE WELL – Jumped sideways at the start and a warning was issued. Gained the position outside the leader in the middle stages.

PARK LANE NZ – Obtained the leading position in the early stages before being challenged by another runner and surrendering that position. Had a tendency to pull hard throughout.

SNEAKY PEAK – Gained the position outside the leader early and successfully challenged for the lead.

GOTTAHAVEAHOBBY- Galloped briefly at the start. Hung inwards making the first turn and contacted marker pegs.

ONEHANDONEBOUNCE – Had a tendency to hang inwards at various stages. Raced three wide in the late stages.

**RACE 7 – LADBROKES BLACK BOOK PACE- UP TO NR 40 – 1892M - STANDING START**

SPORTY CHICK – Galloped out and a warning was issued. Gave ground over the concluding stages and was beaten more than 50m. Trainer will be advised that the gelding will be placed on its last chance to race competitively.

ARTS CLASSIC – Jumped sideways at the start and galloped for a short distance. Trainer advised that the gelding will be placed on its last chance in the draw.

MY ULTIMATE JACKO – Broke briefly after the start before gaining the position outside the leader.

TAXI METER – Stepped away to gain the leading position.

WHATTA GOOD REASON – Left a trailing position to race three wide and gained the position outside the leader in the front straight on the second occasion.

ROCK ON PLAYBOY – Trainer queried in relation to the improved performance.

ONEOFTHELADS – Returned after the race with a broken Hobble. On inspection of the gear it was found to be of substandard quality and the trainer was advised to ensure the racing gear is of good quality if future.

Stewards questioned trainer Wayne Yole in relation to the improved performance of the winner ROCK ON PLAYBOY. Trainer Yole explained that the gelding tonight was down in grade and given the tempo of the race suited the gelding to be back in the field and work home late. He further stated that he was of the opinion that the driver Hanna Van Dongen drove the gelding to perfection and was not surprised to see the gelding win. Stewards were satisfied with the explanation and noted his comments for future reference.

## **RACE 8 – ROADWAYS PTY LTD PACE – NR 45 – 54 - 2180M - MOBILE START**

SAPHIRE GAMBLER – Showed gait speed to lead the event. Hung out making the home turn. Driver dropped his foot in the run to the finish. Inquiry pending.

ULTIMATE DESTINY – Showed gait speed to gain the position outside the leader and obtained a trail early stages.

SWEET AMOUR – After showing gait speed raced wide early and gained the position outside the leader in the front straight on the first occasion.

GRINNING AGAIN NZ – Restrained at the start. Had difficulties obtaining a clear run over the vital stages of the event.

CINOCAL JAMANE – Obtained the position behind the leader on the pegs.
