

RACE 1 – JEREMY ROCKLIFF PACE – 1670m Mobile

FANCY ANOTHER – Broke free of interference racing in the back straight to receive the bell. Given its good record was placed on its last chance to race truly.

MISMATCH – Raced greenly throughout. Tired over the concluding stages to be beaten more than 90m. A post race veterinarian examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer was advised that the filly will be required to trial to the satisfaction of stewards on two occasions prior to racing again.

PHLOW JO – Galloped out and broke on the first turn and will be placed out of the draw in mobile events.

LIKACHOCCIESHAKE – Galloped out and will be placed out of the draw in mobile events.

OUR WILLOW - Showed gait speed to lead the event.

UNOBETTER – Hung inwards despite efforts from the driver contacting numerous marker pegs and racing inside pegs. Stewards advised the trainer that the gelding must trial to the satisfaction of stewards on one occasion prior to racing again.

BOLT OF COBARGO - Raced wide in the early stages to gain the position outside the leader.

The announcement of "All clear" was delayed as stewards wished to view the official patrol films as UNOBETTER raced inside several marker pegs making the home turn. Stewards after taking evidence from Driver Jacob Duggan in the presence of Trainer Adrian Duggan who was deputizing for trainer Gregory Scott were satisfied that the gelding tended to lay inwards despite efforts from the driver to shift outwards and made no ground up during this stage. Stewards were satisfied that the gelding only made ground up over the final 100m after it was moved outwards to its correct line to finish in second place. Stewards gave the "all clear" on the judge's numbers.

RACE 2 – PFEIFFER CRANES STAKES – 2150m Mobile

GEMAEDDE – Raced roughly at various times in running and particularly off the back straight on the final occasion.

STRAWBERRY BLING – Showed gait speed to lead the event.

HERES HENRY – Showed gait speed to sit outside the leader and obtained a trail in the early stages. Gave ground over the final stages.

I WANT IT ALL NZ – Showed gait speed and was caught racing three wide before gaining the position outside the leader in the back straight on the first occasion.

ALAPHILIPPE - Restrained at the start.

ITS SUPER EASY – Hung inwards and contacted marker pegs racing into the back straight after receiving the bell. Performed poorly and was beaten more than 200m. Post race veterinarian examination revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer was advised that the gelding must trial to the satisfaction of stewards on one occasion prior to its next race start.

KIAVINO STRIDE – Was caught racing wide in the early stages before attempting to restrain to the rear, commenced a forward move shortly after to gain the position outside the leader. Pulled hard in the run.

RACE 3 – WING RURAL STAKES – 2150m Mobile

MISS MAGIK - Showed gait speed.

NORBET – Showed gait speed to gain the position outside the leader. Obtained a trail in the early stages.

DANGER PLAY - Showed gait speed to lead the event.

MIKI SANZ – Caught racing wide in the early stages before restraining to the rear. On returning after the race, it was noted that the head check clip was broken.

OUR BETTER BRO – Raced wide in the early stages before progressing forward to gain the position outside the leader.

HAMMER DAN – Left a position on the pegs behind the leader and shifted outwards into the running line. Shifted three wide heading to the back straight after receiving the bell.

MACH ANGELO – Slightly out of position at the start. Driver reminded of his obligations. Raced roughly racing into the back straight on the final occasion.

RACE 4 – BARUNAH STAKES – 2090m Mobile

MUZZAME MATE – Showed gait speed to lead the event. Broke free of interference at the 700m and the trainer will be advised that the gelding will be placed on its last chance to race truly. Hung inwards making the home turn and contacted marker pegs.

NOT YET MUM – Showed gait speed and broke in running free of interference and was placed on its last chance to race truly.

SWIMINTHERIVER – Was severely checked because of a runner breaking gait at the 700m. Hung in and contacted marker pegs making the home turn.

ENSTEIN – Restrained at the start.

KERALA STAR NZ – Severely checked twice and lost ground because of a horse breaking gait in front at the 700m.

DONNY IN PARIS - Had to be severely checked twice due to a horse galloping in front.

HES APPLES – Broke free of interference in the front straight to receive the bell. Was placed on his last chance to race truly. Had to be checked by its driver to avoid a galloping runner. Underwent a post race veterinarian examination and was found to have laceration to its coronet band. Trainer advised that the gelding will be stood down for a period of two weeks and a certificate of fitness must be supplied before being nominated to race again.

SHARMEY - Had to be checked by its driver because of a galloping runner in front.

RACE 5 – LADBROKES RACING CLUB PACE – 2150m Mobile

INDELIBLE – Shortly after the start the mare broke gait and galloped for a short distance resulting in the mare falling to the track dislodging its driver. The mare was captured and taken into the inside of the track.

The mare was attended by the club's veterinarian surgeon on site. Trainer B Dornauf was advised by the veterinarian surgeon, that the mare will require further veterinarian attention on returning to his stables. The mare will be placed out of the draw and must provide a certificate of fitness prior to being nominated for a race again.

VINCENZO - Showed gait speed to lead the event.

JAMES IN CHARGE – Showed gait speed to gain the position outside the leader.

JO AN JO - Restrained at the start.

STIR ME UP – Gained the position outside the leader and obtained a trail in the early stages.

KILLARNEY DANCE NZ – Raced three wide in the late stages of the event.

FLEETWOOD ROCK – Was severely checked because of the fallen horse and trailed the field throughout.

WE SALUTE YOU – Raced three wide in a trailing position in the late stages.

Following the running of this event the oncourse Medical Edge team further examined driver Jacob Duggan who fell heavily to the track while driving INDELIBLE and were not satisfied that Jacob Duggan was fit to fulfil his remaining driving engagements. Stewards replaced Jacob Duggan on his engagements and advised him that a certificate of fitness will need to be supplied before he can drive again. Stewards will be confiscating his helmet that took a heavy knock to the ground.

RACE 6 – LADBROKES TASMANIAN COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIP – 2150m Mobile

ROCK AMOUR – Got severely checked because of another runner breaking gait in the back straight after receiving the bell. Gave ground over the concluding stages.

MISS DUTTON – Gained the position outside the leader and progressed forward to lead the event.

PETALI BEACH - Showed gait speed to gain the position behind the leader.

FREMONT STREET – Showed gait speed to lead the event and obtained a trail in the middle stages. Gave ground over the concluding stages to be beaten over 50m. Trainer will be advised that the gelding will be placed on its last chance to race competitively.

IDEN KAMAKAZI – Broke gait racing off the back straight on the final occasion and was placed on its last chance to race truly.

JUST JAYDO - Gained the position outside the leader.

RACE 7 – WESTWOOD QUARRY STAKES – 2150m - Standing Start

The start of this race was delayed 2 minutes due to a race at the Sunshine Coast running late.

DIAMONDS N CASH NZ - Stepped away to lead the event.

ROYAL APPOINTMENT – Jumped sideways at the start and given the geldings previous record was placed out of the draw in future standing start events.

PARDOE PLUGGA – Left a trailing position to race three wide leaving the straight after receiving the bell.

GLENLEDI ELVIS – Left a trailing position racing in the front straight to receive the bell to race three wide thereafter.

KEAYANG FITZY – Galloped out and trailed the field. Will continue to be excluded from the draw in standing start events.

MAGNETIC TERROR – Began badly and will be excluded right out of the draw in standing start events.

Trainer Conor Crook was fined for failing to advise the stewards of the tactics of both his runners in this event. Stewards considered his previous record under this rule.

RACE 8 – S & M HORSE TRANSPORT PACE – 2150m Mobile

MACH MAJOR NZ -

MISS COLLANN - Showed gait speed to lead the event.

OUR MIKI DIVA NZ – Showed gait speed to lead to gain the position outside the leader and gained a trail in the middle stages. A post race veterinarian examination revealed the mare to be lame and a veterinary certificate of soundness will be required before being nominated to race again.

DIDYALOUSAROOSTA – Broke in the score up at the first attempt causing a false start. The gelding will be excluded from the draw in future mobile events. On the second attempt the gelding showed gait speed to gain the position outside the leader. Broke free of interference leaving the back straight on the final occasion and was stood down until the completion of a satisfactory trial.

JOOGLE - Out of position at the start. Driver reprimanded given his good record.

PARK LANE NZ – Out of position at the start. Driver fined as a result. Tended to pull hard throughout the event.

JORGE STREET - Left a trailing position in the middle stages to gain the position outside the leader.

RACE 9 – HAMMOND SEAFOOD STAKES – 2150m Mobile

OCTAGONISE - Showed gait speed to lead the event.

KATALTA ARTEMIS – Showed gait speed to gain the position outside the leader. Obtained a trailing position in the early stages.

SETTEBELLO – Showed gait speed and raced three wide in the early stages and gained the position outside the leader in the middle stages of the event. Obtained a trail shortly after.

SHOOIN – Underwent a prerace veterinarian examination at the start due to a small laceration and passed fit to take its place in the field. Raced wide early and gained the position outside the leader.

IDEN BLACK PRINCE – Left a trailing position in the front straight to receive the bell to race three wide.
