Comments / Explanations:

Trainer R Hamer was fined \$50 under the provisions of LR13.3 for the late rider declaration for QUICKEN UP in Race 6.

Rider B Hanham was indisposed due to having a wisdom tooth removed.

RACE 1 – LADBROKES ODDS SURGE MAIDEN – (1200 METRES)

FOREIGN LEGION – Slow into stride and was inconvenienced shortly after. Raced wide and without cover throughout.

NEED A GIGGLE – A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near fore. Trainer A Fulton was advised that a veterinary certificate would be required prior to racing.

WHIZ BY – Inconvenienced at the start. Raced wide and without cover throughout.

BAO BUN – Bumped heavily on jumping.

BATTLE AWARD – Bumped on jumping.

LOVIN'BEV – Began awkwardly and shortly after bumped heavily with BAO BUN.

MISS PECULIAR – Bumped when crowded near the 700 metres. Near the 200 metres had to be momentarily steadied when awkwardly placed on the heels of NEED A GIGGLE (App C Wells) which shifted in when not quite clear. Apprentice C Wells was advised to exercise more care. A post-race examination revealed minor graze to the upper lip.

STONE COLD STUNNER – Disappointed for clear running over the concluding stages. Apprentice C Jordan explained she was not overly disappointed with the mare however she was unlucky in the run to the finish. She explained that passing the 300m there was a run to the outside of the heels of BAO BUN and to the inside of the eventual winner WINNING WITNESS. She said that it was of the opinion that she wasn't travelling well enough to take that run. App C Jordan explained that shortly after her mount was not travelling well to obtain the run inside BAO BUN and LOVIN' BEV and as a result she was unable to improve. Stewards noted the explanation.

WINNING WITNESS – Began very awkwardly resulting in its rider becoming unbalanced.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES COMMUNITIES MAIDEN – (1400 METRES)

Prior to the declaration of correct weight, stewards viewed the official patrol footage to determine if WHERE YOU FROM had been denied a fair start. After viewing the official patrol footage and hearing the submissions of rider K Sanderson and the starters Mr D Evans and Mr J Evans, it was determined that when the started was affected WHERE YOU FROM was encumbered by a barrier attendant being in the stall and as a result began very awkwardly resulting in its rider K Sanderson becoming unbalanced. The stewards declared the gelding a non-runner at 6:05pm.

On the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered that all monies invested on WHERE YOU FROM be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to all successful wagers placed prior to 6.05pm.

Stewards ordered that the following deductions would apply:

1st - MONTE FLEUR - 5c win 6c place

2nd - GEE GEES RUN OUT - 9c place

3rd - MINDFUL - 10c place

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the tickets.

ADA WAY – Raced wide and without cover.

WHERE YOU FROM – Declared a non-runner at 6:05pm, denied a fair start.

LI'L HAIL MARY – Stewards granted permission for rider B McCoull to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight. Performed below market expectations. Rider B McCoull explained that in his opinion the mare does not appreciate racing between runners. He further added that the mare ran on well over the concluding stages and that he was not overly disappointed in the performance.

MINDFUL – Slow to begin.

TURF PUZZLE – Raced very wide and without cover.

CAPE ZORRO – Apprentice L Annells explained that the mare hung out from the 600 metres.

RACE 3 – LADBROKES RACING CLUB MDN/CL1 – (1600 METRES)

A LITTLE DECEIT – Resaddled at the start. Slow into stride and was inconvenienced at the start.

I'M KEEFE – Rounding the home turn and until passing the 200 metres was awkwardly placed on the heels of LONDIANI and was unable to improve.

LONDIANI – Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed suitable to start.

PUNTER – Over raced in the early and middle stages.

WHEELKNOT – Began awkwardly.

GRAND PEGASUS – Inconvenienced at the start. Raced wide and without cover. Finished tailed off. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

LILY LUELLA – Began awkwardly and shifted out.

RACE 4 – LADBROKE IT! 3YO MAIDEN – (1100 METRES)

The start of this race was delayed approximately 2 minutes owing to STARDARMUS having to be reshod.

JUST CRUISIN' – Over raced throughout.

MILES 'N' MILES – Slow to begin.

STARDARMUS – Had to be reshod upon arrival at the barriers.

STRATOJACK – Began awkwardly.

GETCHA GROOVE ON – Rounding the home turn was momentarily steadied when awkwardly placed inside the heels of STRATOJACK.

RICH 'N' POWERFUL – Raced wide and without cover.

TIGERS ON TOP – Began awkwardly. Hung out rounding the home turn.

UNCLE'S TIP – Began awkwardly.

RACE 5 – LADBROKES BLACKBOOK CLASS 1 HCP – (1100 METRES)

HARPER RAE – Slow to begin. Raced wide and without cover.

BARMAID GIRL – Slow to begin. Raced wide and without cover. Performed below market expectations. Apprentice C Wells reported that the mare was wide throughout, and this was a significant contributing factor to the below market expectation performance.

GEEGEES DOWN SOUTH – Began awkwardly.

GOOD MORGEN – Bumped on jumping. Over raced in the early stages.

ZULU GURU – Stewards permitted rider D Pires to ride the mare one kilogram over its declared weight of 54kgs. Failed to respond from the 600 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

VENTUS – A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

RACE 6 – LADBROKES BET TICKER BM76 – (1100 METRES)

REWARD ACHIEVER – Pre-empted the start and as a result began very well. Rounding the home turn had to be checked when awkwardly placed on the heels of GEE GEE PLANE (T Baker) which laid in marginally. After hearing the evidence, it was established that no rider was careless and as such it was deemed a racing incident.

LE CADEAU – Began awkwardly.

GEE GEE PLANE – Laid in when placed under pressure rounding the home turn. Shortly after the winning post had to be severely checked, clipped heels and lost ground.

GEEGEELUCKYSTAR – Inconvenienced at the start. Over raced in the middle stages and was steadied near the 600m. Steadied on the home tur.

SCARDIMALIA – Stewards permitted rider D Pires to ride the mare half a kilogram over its declared weight of 54.5kgs. Performed below market expectations. Rider D Pires reported that the mare travelled well throughout however failed to respond when placed under pressure. He also added that in his opinion the mare did not handle the Good (4) surface tonight. Trainer D Tyson also confirmed the following morning the mare had jarred up and treatment had been provided by his stable chiropractor. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

WARICA – Rounding the home turn was steadied when awkwardly place outside the heels of REWARD ACHIEVER.

Stewards found rider A Darmanin (GEE GEE QUEEN BEE) guilty under the provisions of AR131(a) Careless riding. The particulars of the charge were that shortly after the winning post

he permitted his mount to shift in when insufficiently clear of GEE GEE PLANE (T Baker), resulting in that runner clipping heels, being severely checked and losing ground. A Darmanin's licence to ride in races was suspended for a period of two (2) Tasmanian race meetings. In assessing penalty stewards were mindful that the carelessness was in the mid-range, his record under this rule and also that there was a minor contribution from WARICA. Rider A Darmanin was reminded of his right of appeal.

RACE 7 – LADBROKES OWNERS INCENTIVE CLASS 2 HCP – (1400 METRES)

BORN A WINNER – Bounded on jumping. Raced wide in the early stages.

EGAO – Apprentice E Byrne-Burke reported that she had concerns with the action of the mare. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

RACE 8 – LADBROKES YARD COMMENTS BM68 – (1400 METRES)

ETHICAL DILEMMA – Raced wide and without cover.

MAARKLE – Slow to begin.

RACE 9 – LADBROKES SPORTS BAR BM60 HCP – (1200 METRES)

MOVE ON OVER – Raced greenly in the middle stages.

GEEGEE'S GEMSTONE – Inconvenienced near the 800 metres when MOVE ON OVER when racing greenly shifted out.

MR FREEZE – Began awkwardly and shortly after was crowded.

ENSNARE – Fractious in the barriers and reared. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed suitable to start. Trainer G McCulloch was advised that a warning would be placed on the record of the gelding for being fractious.

NEV'S BOY – Slow into stride.

PUNK PRINCESS – Stewards permitted rider A Darmanin to ride the mare half a kilogram over the declared weight of 54kgs. Over-raced early stages.
