Comments / Explanations:

Trainer J Bazen was fined \$50 under the provisions of LR 13.3 for the late rider declaration of B Muhcu as the rider of CAPITAL CHEVAL in Race 1.

Trainer M Ganderton was fined \$50 under the provision of AR124(3) for failing to have a rearing bit on his horse at a track work inspection at the Devonport track on the 20th October, 2023.

RACE 1 – LADBROKES OWNERS INCENTIVE MAIDEN - 1390 METRES

CAPITAL CHEVAL – Hung out after the start tightening GONNA BE MY GIRL.

CRAFTY BOSS – Tightened on jumping between GONNA BE MY GIRL and ELLA DULCIE after GONNA BE MY GIRL was carried outward.

NEED AN ESCORT – Raced wide throughout. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RAFAEL'S RAID – Raced wide to the 700 metres.

GONNA BE MY GIRL – Shifted out on jumping.

LA FOLIE DOUCE – A post-race veterinary inspection revealed a high heart rate recovery. Trainer S Cotton advised stewards that on returning to her stables she noticed that the mare had come into season

SAKURA HIME – Stewards granted permission for rider B McCoull to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight. Laid in after the start and had to checked off the heels of NEED AN ESCORT.

ELLA DULCIE – Fractious in the barriers, bounded on jumping and checked soon after the start when tightened between CRAFTY BOSS and LADY SARAH both of which shifted ground.

EMMJAY – Declared a late scratching at 9.15am due to there being no available rider.

GEE GEES DESERT – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 2 – LADBROKE IT! MAIDEN – 1100 METRES

BUEL – Jumped awkwardly and struck the inside barrier gate, then shifted outwards. Tightened near the 800 metres when SHADES OF FROST blundered and became unbalanced.

ES AND ES – Slow to begin.

SHADES OF FROST – Tightened near the 800 metres and blundered.

STRATOJACK – Laid in near the 800 metres tightening SHADES OF FROST which blundered.

ESSIE ESSIE – Raced wide throughout.

MISS CHICA MALA – Laid in over the concluding stages.

UPPERCUTS – Jumped awkwardly and contacted the inside barrier gate. Raced wide throughout.

RACE 3 – JBM GROUP 3YO HANDICAP – (1100 METRES)

NEEDS SUGAR – Bounded on jumping and was slow to begin. When questioned on the below market expectations, rider T Baker explained that the filly had sweated up prior to the race, was fractious in the barriers and then jumped poorly, placing him in a position where he didn't want to be. He then elected to take a sit with cover and the filly commenced to over race. The filly then failed to run on when placed under pressure. Stewards also queried trainer

S Gandy in relation to the below market performance. Trainer S Gandy in his opinion believed the extra weight carried may not of assisted in this preparation or that the filly may have choked down in the run. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

THESPIAN WATERS – Rider S Carr was reminded of her obligations when celebrating approaching the winning post.

POPILITA – Tired over the concluding stages. Stewards reprimanded Erica Byrne-Burke under the provisions of AR 131(b) for failing to ride her mount out fully to the line. A post-race veterinary examination revealed high heart rate and slow recovery.

RACE 4 – TELEGRAPH HOTEL BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP 1390 METRES

REWARD ACHIEVER –Tired over the concluding stages. (Check to see if the mare is retired)

GEE GEE MISS QUITA – Bumped with HOT RELATION on several occasions in the home straight.

HOT RELATION – Bumped with GEE GEE MISS QUITA on several occasions in the home straight.

RACE 5 – MINGARI + CO BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP – (2100 METRES)

NO SURPRISES – Slow to begin raced three wide in the middle stages. Stewards spoke to rider Troy Baker regarding the below market expectations performance. He elected to improve his position racing into the back straight when he was concerned that the leaders had too much of a break. The gelding then failed to respond to his riding and he believes it had not backed up from the previous start. A post-race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

FURTHER NORTH – Slow to begin.

RACE 6 – GRAHAM FAMILY FUNERALS 0-60 – (1100 METRES)

UNDER HIS EYE – Jumped awkwardly.

ENSNARE – Laid in entering the home straight. Apprentice Jackson Radley was reprimanded under the provisions of AR 132(7)(1) for using his whip on consecutive strides twice before the 100 metre mark.

ELMAJAY – Bounded on jumping.

NEV'S BOY – Raced three wide throughout.

GEE GEE GOLDENLASS – Bumped entering the home straight.

TIDAL – Bumped with GEE GEE GOLDENLASS entering the home straight.

RACE 7 – AVISO TAS INSURANCE CLASS 1 HANDICAP (1390 METRES)

HAPPY CLAN – Raced wide throughout.

VANITY STAR – Slow to begin.

RICHMOND POET (NZ) – Over-raced in the early stages and eased down over the concluding stages. Rider E Byrne Burke reported that in her opinion the gelding was lame. A post race veterinary report revealed an elevated heart rate and slow recovery.

LAUNNIE NIGHTS – Over raced in the early stages.

GEE GEES CHORIS – Slow to begin. A post race veterinary examination revealed no abnormalities.

EXPENSIVE MISTAKE – Lost a near fore plate in the run. Under-went a post race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.
