RACE 1 – KEVIN SHARKIE ALEXANDRA PLATE 2YO– (1000 Metres)

GEEGEES LEGACY – Shifted out on jumping bumping with OLIVE GIRL.

MONCLERE – Inclined to lay in entering the home straight and then laid out when being corrected near the 100 metres.

OLIVE GIRL – Bumped at the start when GEEGEES LEGACY shifted out.

I'M BEGGIN – Raced greenly in the early stages and shifted in abruptly near the 300 metres.

RACE 2 – LADBROKE IT! MAIDEN – (1100 Metres)

TRABZON – Tightened near the 200 metres when MISS CHICA MALA shifted in.

MISS CHICA MALA – Laid in near the 300 metres and withstood a protest after shifting in and bumping with SHE PLAYS GAMES. Continued to lay in thereafter and tightened the running of THE LAST HURRAH. Rider A Darmanin was advised to exercise more care in future.

MISS TANZANITE – Momentarily held up on the home turn and the again near the 200 metres and obliged to shift wider to obtain clear running.

POSSUM MAGIC – Raced wide throughout. Apprentice C Van Munster reported abnormal breathing noises from the mare. A post- race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

ROYAL MURTRESS – Tightened and bumped near the 200 metres when MY DESIGN took a run to its inside where there was questionable room. Apprentice J Radley was advised that he is to exercise far greater care in future when electing to pursue tight runs. In not taking more severe action it was noted that ROYAL MURTESS had shifted in marginally contributing to the interference.

ZONNA VERDE – Slow to muster early speed.

BINHBA – Declared a late scratching at 2.50pm when unable to be loaded. Trainer T Evans was advised that the filly must complete a satisfactory trial before racing again. On the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered that all monies invested on BINHBA be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to all successful wagers placed prior to 2.50pm.

Stewards ordered that the following deductions would apply:

1st – ES AND ES	1c Win 1c Place
2nd – THE LAST HURRAH	1c place
3rd – ZONNA VERDE	1c place.

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the tickets.

THE LAST HURRAH – Tightened for room near the 200 metres when MISS CHICA MALA shifted in.

SHE PLAYS GAMES – Tightened and bumped near the 300 metres by MISS CHICA MALA shifting in. Lodged a protest 6th versus 4th for interference at this point. After considering the evidence and viewing the official patrol films stewards dismissed the protest.

Prior to the declaration of correct weight, rider C Baker (SHE PLAYS GAMES) the 6th place getter in the event wished to view the official patrol footage to ascertain whether there were grounds to lodge a protest. After viewing the footage rider C Baker (SHE PLAYS GAMES) and Trainer J Blacker wish to proceed with the grounds that being near the 300 metres they received tightening from the outside by A Darmanin MISS CHICA MALA the 4th placegetter. After taking evidence from all parties and viewing the official patrol footage the protest was

dismissed. Stewards were of the opinion that SHE PLAYS GAMES had received pressure from the inside when THE LAST HURRAH (T Johnstone) had shifted out marginally.

MY DESIGN – Obtained a tight run to the inside of ROYAL MURTESS near the 200 metres and contacted the hindquarters of that mare on a number of occasions.

RACE 3 - IT'S WHY WE RACE MAIDEN - (1400 METRES)

The start of this race was delayed when the bridle came off ELECTRO MASTER when it was being loaded.

MATEUS – Held up for the majority of the home straight.

MISTER MANIHI - Laid out under pressure over the final 100 metres.

NOXIOUS – Shifted out on jumping hampering ELECTRO MASTER.

ROWDY GIRL – Raced three wide throughout. Laid in during the home straight.

ELECTRO MASTER – Stewards granted permission for rider L Lafferty to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight. Checked at the start when NOXIOUS shifted out on jumping and lost ground. A post- race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

GOLD PROOF – Over-raced in the early stages.

ALBIONA – Slow to muster early speed. A post- race veterinary examination revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 4 – LADBROKES ODDS SURGE FILLES & MARES BM64 – (1400 METRES)

GREY WHISPER (NZ) – Slow to begin.

MAARKLE – Inclined to over-race in the early stages.

PUNK PRINCESS – Inclined to lay in over the concluding stages.

ZULU GURU – Permission given to be ridden 1kg over the allotted weight.

RACE 5 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK CLASS 2 HCP – (1400 METRES)

CARTOON GRAVEYARD – Bumped by GOLDEN MEADOW entering the home straight when that filly was held up for a clear run.

BERSERKER - Steadied off heels near the 1000 metres.

ENCHANTED SPY – A post-race veterinary examination revealed an elevated heart rate and slow recovery.

GOLDEN MEADOW – Held up for a clear run on the home turn and bumped with CARTOON GRAVEYARD when attempting to shift out to obtain a clear run.

NEEDS REMEMBERING – Began slowly and then failed to muster early speed.

KITTY PURRING – Raced three wide throughout. The whip became entangled in the reins momentarily near the 100 metres.

RACE 6 – LADBROKES TASMANIAN GUINEAS – (1600 Metres)

THESPIAN WATERS – Bumped with JUST CRUISIN' entering the home straight on a number of occasions. Trainer S Carr reported that the gelding had pulled up sore and would advise of any further findings in the following days.

D'ORO STAR – Stewards granted permission for rider C Newitt to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination as it became fractious in the barriers and was passed fit to run. Trainer L Gray was advised a warning had been placed on the geldings barrier manners. Bumped at the start with JOHNNIE PINCH.

JOHNNIE PINCH – Bumped with D'ORO STAR on jumping.

JUST CRUISIN' – Over raced early stages. Bumped on a number of occasions entering the home straight.

ISLAND WARRIOR – Over raced early stages, A post race veterinary examination revealed superficial wounds to the off-hind fetlock.

RACE 7 – TAS INSURANCE BROKERS BM72 – (1600 METRES)

SUPER SWOOP – Slow to begin.

CLIFTON DANSEUR – Over raced in the early stages.

GEEGEES HISWORD – Ridden ½ kg overweight.

GLOBAL AWARENESS – Permission given to carry 1kg over the allotted weight. Rider reported he felt his mount did not appreciate the firm track today.

RACE 8 – WAKEFUL CLUB BRIGHTON CUP – (1200 METRES)

BOKEO – Compounded in the home straight. A post race veterinary examination revealed a high heart rate, slow recovery.

SHOOTING NORTH – Raced three wide throughout.

WHIZ BY – Shifted in when insufficiently clear of VOLKANOVSKI which had to be restrained when passing the 900 metres. Apprentice Jackson Radley was issued with a reprimand under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding.

VOLKANOVSKI – Commenced to over-race when placed awkwardly on the heels of the runners in front passing the 900 metres when WHIZ BY crossed when not fully clear.

EASTCOAST MISS – Slow to begin.

RACE 9 – OLIVE TREE CATERING BM64 HCP – (1400 Metres)

GEEGEE LUCKY JESS – Raced three wide throughout.

SISTINE – Slow to begin. Placed awkwardly on heels entering the home straight and momentarily held up.

ETOSHA – Stewards granted permission for rider M Ulucinar to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight.
