Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 - KEVIN SHARKIE 2YO & 3YO MAIDEN - (1200 METRES)

DYSART – Slow to begin.

KAKIA – Jumped awkwardly. Raced wide with cover.

PIPING WILLOW – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after the trainer reported the gelding had a minor abrasion under the right eye and was passed fit to race.

APRIL'S DANCE – Had a tendency to over-race in the early and middle stages.

GEE GEE SALTBUSH – Jumped out at the start, raced three-wide throughout.

GEEGEE STRAWBERRY – Raced wide with cover. Brushed with GEEGEEHAILSTORM entering the straight.

GEEGEEHAILSTORM – Shifted out and brushed with GEEGEE STRAWBERRY entering the home straight.

SKY LAND – Rider G Catania reported her mount hung out throughout.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES OWNERS INCENTIVE MAIDEN – (1200 METRES)

FREDDY'SAJETSTAR – Had a tendency to over-race in the early and middle stages. Steadied off the heels of WE ALL DECIDE when the mare shifted out approaching the 200 metres.

MACAN – Raced three-wide in the early and middles stages.

GEE GEES MOONLITE – Had a tendency to over-race in the early stages.

OPEN ARMS – Brushed the rail on the home turn. When entering the home straight attempted to run to the inside of TOUGH IMPACT then elected to shift out over heels in an attempt to improve.

PINANDI - Raced three-wide with cover.

WE ALL DECIDE – Shifted out over the heels of GEE GEES MOONLIGHT to obtain a clear run approaching the 200 metres.

ZONNA VERDE – Restrained and shifted in to obtain cover shortly after the start. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

RACE 3 - KEVIN SHARKIE BM68 HCP - (2100 METRES)

RACE 4 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – (2100 METRES)

AMERICAN JEWEL – Bumped with AUSSIE WARRIOR at the start. Raced three-wide to about the 1300m.

AUSSIE WARRIOR – Bumped with AMERICAL JEWEL at the start. Raced three-wide early. Made contact with the hindquarters of TOSEN FAME after being bumped by BUELL when rounding the home turn. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding had cardiac arrhythmia. Trainer J Blacker was advised the gelding will require a vet certificate prior to racing or trialling again.

BUEL – Bumped with FRYER HILL at the start. Raced three-wide in the middle stages. Shifted out marginally when rounding the home turn, brushing with AUSSIE WARRIOR. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer S Gandy advised the gelding would now be retired.

MILES 'N' MILES – Had a tendency to over-race in the early stages. Stewards spoke to apprentice C Van Munster in the presence of President of the Tasmanian Jockeys Association Mr K Ring in relation to her shifting wider than necessary when rounding the home turn.

FRYER HILL – Bumped with BUEL at the start.

TOSEN FAME – Was unbalanced momentarily when bumped by AUSSIE WARRIOR when rounding the home turn.

RACE 5 - VALE PATRICIA MCSHANE OPEN HCP - (1600 METRES)

AND BEYOND - Steadied off the heels of YARRA MASTER at about 1300 metres.

YARRA MASTER – Stewards granted permission for rider C Newitt to ride ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

RACE 6 – LADBROKE IT! BM68 HCP – (1100 METRES)

GEEGEE JET BY – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities. Stewards queried trainer S Gandy on the perceived below market performance of the gelding. Trainer S Gandy stated that he was disappointed with the run and was unable to offer any explanation other than the gelding may not have handled the track conditions. Stewards followed up with trainer S Gandy on returning to his stables. Mr Gandy advised that his stable veterinarian had looked at the gelding the following morning and believed the gelding to be stiff in its movement and in his opinion may have failed to let down in the run.

WARICA – Lunged on jumping forcing the gates to open quicker and unbalancing the rider. Raced three-wide with cover throughout.

THUNBERG – Raced wide in the early stages.

TITLE SHOT – Raced in restricted room when WARICA shifted in marginally approaching the 600 metres. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities. Trainer G Stevenson advised the mare will be retired.

GREY WHISPER (NZ) – Began awkwardly contacting the outside of the barrier.

BELLASARIO – Slow to muster early speed. Raced three-wide with cover throughout.

RACE 7 – AVISO TAS INSURANCE BROKERS CLASS 1 HCP – (1400 METRES)

CAPTAIN TAZ (NZ) – Shifted out and brushed with FASHION FOX entering the home straight.

LONTANO – Shifted out over the concluding stages carrying DAIQUIRI DIVA wider.

FASHION FOX – Raced wide throughout. Shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

GEEGEES DOWN SOUTH – Raced wide throughout. Trainer S Gandy advised that the colt would now be retired.

DAIQUIRI DIVA – Raced wide early stages. Had a tendency to over-race in the early and middle stages.

RACE 8 - TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK CLASS 4 HCP - (1400 METRES)

DANTES (NZ) – Had a tendency to over-race in the early stages. Stewards queried rider T Johnstone on the tactics adopted in today's event. Rider T Johnstone stated that her instructions were to not to attempt to lead from the wide barrier or be caught wide without cover. Rider T Johnstone in her opinion believed the horse may be at the end of its preparation.

SUSHI EXPRESS – Fractious in the barrier. Stewards allowed rider H McCarthy to ride ½ kilo over the allotted weight.

RUBBLEONTHEDOUBLE – Had a tendency to over-race in the early stages.

PRINCESS MATOAKA – Slow to muster early speed, had a tendency to over-race in the early stages. Hung out throughout.

NO ACCESS – Slow to muster early speed. Had a tendency to over-race in the early stages.

Stewards inquired into an incident approaching the 600 metres where it appeared NO ACCESS lost its position, at the same time PRINCESS MATOAKA was racing ungenerously, NO ACCESS rolled in marginally, tightening the run of PRINCESS MATOAKA. In considering the race manners of both horses, Stewards took no further action.

RACE 9 – VALE FRED WESTWOOD BM60 HCP – (1600 METRES)

RIGOLETTO – Raced wide throughout.

ADACHI – Raced wide with cover in the early stages.

HAMOGANY – Steadied after the start to take up a position on the rail.

STEEL MIST – Stewards spoke to rider T Baker regard the below market performance of the gelding. Rider T Baker stated when placed under pressure, the gelding failed to respond to his riding. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

UNIQUE GLOW – Resaddled behind the barriers.

MARIPOSA – Raced three-wide throughout.
