Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – LADBROKES ODDS SURGE MAIDEN 2-Y-O & UP – (1150 METRES)

MIDNIGHT FLYER – Commenced to over race for some distance approaching the 700 metres.

AUNTY CONNIE (NZ) – Bounded out on jumping. Shifted in abruptly and took up a position at the rear of the field.

DELAMERE – Shifted in passing the 800 metres when not quite clear of ZULU FIELDS which had to be momentarily steadied. Apprentice E Byrne Burke was advised to exercise care.

DIAMOND SUNRISE – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after sustaining minor abrasions to both hips whilst enroute to the course and was passed fit to start. Over raced approaching the 600 metres.

GIE IT LALDY – Held up for a clear run from the 400 metres behind DELAMERE until entering the home straight.

I'VE BEEN DREAMING – Bounded on jumping and was slow to begin.

LIGHTMEUPJAZZ – Bounded on jumping and slow to begin as a result.

MISS PASHA – Raced three wide throughout.

TIGERS ON TOP – Near hind shoe replaced prior to racing. Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to race. Approaching the 600 metres had to be restrained off the heels of LIGHTMEUPJAZZ.

HALEN – Required a gear adjustment behind the barriers prior to the start.

TWINKLEDUST – Jumped awkwardly and shifted out. Rider S Carr reported the mare hung out throughout and she was unable to ride her mount out in her normal manner. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

RACE 2 – GOODSTONE GROUP MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – (1650 METRES)

A LITTLE DECEIT – Bumped with FLIGHT READY at the start.

FLIGHT READY – Bumped at the start with A LITTLE DECEIT.

MIKAZUKI – Bumped with MYSTIC HOPE at the start.

MYSTIC HOPE – Bumped at the start as a result of MIKAZUKI shifting out. Near the 600 metres raced in restricted room between PINANDI and MISS PEBBLES which shifted in marginally. Rider D Ganderton was advised to exercise care in similar circumstances. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the gelding to have a high heart rate, slow recovery.

KREGLINGER – Raced three wide in the early stages.

UNNERVING – Raced wide middle stages. Rider L Annells reported the gelding raced wide throughout as she believed her mount resented the kickback.

MISS PEBBLES – Began awkwardly contacting the outside barrier gate, bumping heavily with MIKAZUKI. Shifted in marginally passing the 600 metres tightening the running of MYSTIC HOPE. Rider J Radley dropped his whip at about the 200 metres.

PINANDI – Tightened and restrained and lost its position at the 600 metres, when tightened by MYSTIC HOPE which had received pressure from MISS PEBBLES.

RACE 3 – KEVIN SHARKIE CLASS 1 HANDICAP – (1009 METRES)

THOROS OF MYR – Laid in, in the home straight.

BLUFF POINT – Over raced early and middle stages.

HYPERCUBE – Bumped with POSITIVE PRESS shortly after the start.

SWOOPING EAGLE – Slow to begin.

TRIXIE (NZ) – Rider G Catania reported that she was reluctant to ride her mount out in the home straight as the filly made unusual respiratory noises. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

POSITIVE PRESS – Bumped with HYPERCUBE shortly after the start. Over raced passing the 800 metres. Shifted out and raced three wide thereafter. Hung in approaching the 200 metres.

RACE 4 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT BM60 HANDICAP – (1150 METRES)

The start of this race was delayed due to the tractor moving the barriers having a flat battery. The race start time was subsequently discussed with Sky Channel and changed to 2:53pm.

GEE GEE CAN WIN – Steadied off the heels of CORNELIAN BAY passing the 600 metres.

DUNCANNON – When questioned on the below market expectations performance rider G Catania stated that the nasal strip had fallen off the gelding, she also stated that the gelding had just returned from a spell and that the distance didn't suit on this occasion in her opinion. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

BELPINE MISS – Held up momentarily approaching the 200 metres. Rider C Baker reported that the mare's stride was uneven entering the home straight and the mare made abnormal respiratory noises. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

EXALTED CROWN – Held up from the 300 metres until about the 150 metres.

SUNSHINE MOSHE – Carried wider when BAO BUN was subsequently forced wider.

BARMAID GIRL – Declared a late scratching at 2:55pm on veterinary advice after becoming fractious in the barriers. On the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered that all monies invested on BARMAID GIRL be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to all successful wagers placed prior to 2:55pm.

Stewards ordered that the following deductions would apply:

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the tickets.

POWER MAGNUM – Shifted out at around the 600 metres carrying BAO BUN and SUNSHINE MOSHE wider on the track. At a subsequent inquiry apprentice J Radley was reprimanded under the provisions AR131(a) careless riding for allowing his mount to shift out at the 600-metre mark.

BAO BUN – Shifted in approaching the 800 metres bumping with POWER MAGNUM. Rider E Byrne Burke was advised to exercise care when allowing her mount to shift ground. Carried wider at about the 600 metres when POWER MAGNUM was shifted wider to obtain a clear run.

RACE 5 – TORQUE GEAR GUYS BM72 HANDICAP - (1150 METERS)

The start of this race was re-scheduled to start at 3:19pm.

MUSCLE UP – Laid in near the 200 metres bumping with ALPINE AVIATOR which was laying out. Brushed again approaching the winning post.

THE SPIRIT OF ZERO – Slow into stride. Over raced early and middle stages.

ALPINE AVIATOR – Shifted out on jumping bumping with INTISAR. Over raced approaching the 600-metre turn. Laid out near the 200 metres bumping with MUSCLE UP which was laying in. Brushed again approaching the winning post.

RACE 6 – TORQUE GEAR FOR GUYS BM 68 HANDICAP – (1350 METRES)

COPPLESON (NZ) – Rider L Annells reported her mount was unable to be ridden out approaching the winning post when racing in restricted room between BANKROLLBENNY and NOBLE EXCEPTION.

TRICKY MIKKI – Over raced early and middle stages. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed the mare to have high heart rate slow recovery.

RACE 7 – TASMANIAN HORSE TRANSPORT 0-60 (1350 METRES)

The barriers were manually started in this event.

MY DEMETRA – Raced three wide in the early stages.

NO ACCESS – Laid in under pressure over the concluding stages.

LION'S TOOTH – Laid in entering the home straight and shifted in marginally.

THREE'S A CROWD – Had to be steadied when approaching the 200 metres when racing in restricted room between LION'S TOOTH and MARTINI BLUE.

WELDBOROUGH – Inclined to over race at about the 1100 metres.

MARTINI BLUE – Shifted out upon entering the home straight when rider G Catania had difficulty drawing her whip through to her left hand, at the same time NO ACCESS shifted in marginally.
