RACE 1 – KEVIN SHARKIE 3YO MAIDEN (1100 METRES)

CALIFORNIA PUNK – Raced three-wide throughout. Rider K Sanderson reported the gelding had a tendency to lay-in throughout the event.

TERIKI SON – Trainer P Dargan was advised that a warning was placed on the gelding's pre-race manners during the preliminary to the barriers.

RARE ORO – Bounded out, brushing the outside of the barrier. Bumped with SMASH 'N' GRAB and YOURAWAY after the start. Had to be steadied off the heels of the runners in front at about the 600 metres.

SMASH 'N' **GRAB** – Underwent a pre-race veterinary examination after having a plate replaced to the near fore and was cleared to race. Bumped with RARE ORO after the start. Over-raced in the early stages. Raced three-wide throughout. Had a tendency to lay-in in the home straight.

SUNRISE AT KIRRA – Had a tendency to over-race early. Shifted out at about 600 metres inconveniencing VANSITTART.

VANSITTART - Inconvenienced at about the 600 metres when SUNRISE AT KIRRA shifted out.

WANNABE ZIGGY – Slow to begin.

WEDNESDAY'S BOSS – Slow to begin.

YOURAWAY – Bumped with RARE ORO after the start. Had a tendency to over-race in the early stages.

RACE 2 – LADBROKE OWNERS INCENTIVE 2YO MAIDEN – (1100 METRES)

EXPOSTAR – Over-raced in the early stages, raced wide throughout.

GEEGEES LEGACY – Commenced awkwardly unbalancing its rider.

GET 'EM WARRIOR – Shifted in about the 200 metres, tightening SURPRISE SECRET.

ANGEL SPHERE – Bumped after the start with SMIFFY. Shifted in and contacted the rail at about the 600 metres.

FORTYFOUR MAGNUM – Slow to begin. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination, no abnormalities were detected.

ICE CRYSTAL – Over-raced in the early stages.

SILVER DAGGER – Fractious in the barrier prior to the start. Over-raced in the early stages, raced wide throughout.

SMIFFY – Bumped with ANGEL SPHERE after the start.

SURPRISE SECRET – Slow to begin. Had to steady off the heels of GET 'EM WARRIOR which shifted out at about the 200 metres.

WILD NIGHTS – Stewards spoke to apprentice J RADLEY in the presence of senior rider C Newitt when allowing his mount to shift out when not fully clear when entering the home straight. Stewards reminded apprentice J Radley to exercise care and ensure he is fully clear when shifting ground.

RACE 3 - AVISO TAS INSURANCE BROKERS MAIDEN - (1200 METRES)

GAZZA'S SPIRIT – Tightened by COME TO PASS after the start and then shifted out and bumped with COME TO PASS.

MISTER MANIHI – Bumped with PROPEROUS MISS after the start. Had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages.

CLOVER HILL – Raced wide throughout with cover.

COME TO PASS – Jumped in after the start, tightening GAZZA's SPIRIT.

CROWNED DECEIVER – Raced wide throughout with cover.

GREENHILL GAL - Checked after the start when PROPSEROUS MISS shifted out.

PROSPEROUS MISS – Stewards granted permission for rider K Sanderson to ride 1/2 kilogram over the allotted weight. Jumped awkwardly, shifted in abruptly after the start, bumping with MISTER MANIHI then shifted out tightening the run of GREENHILL GAL. Over-raced in the early stages and middle stages.

AUTUMN GLORY – Tightened by PROSPEROUS MISS at the start.

Stewards inquired into an incident at about the 800 metres when STEEL CONNECTION (C Van Munster) was tightened for racing room by LOVE NEST (J Radley) and PUZZLE MISS (E Byrne Burke). Stewards accepted the explanations provided by riders, and reminded all riders to exercise care and ensure they allow sufficient room for fellow riders when racing tight.

RACE 4 – TASMANIAN BLOODSTOCK MAIDEN 1 – (1600 METRES)

AL MAXIMUS – Had a tendency to over-race in the early stages. Raced wide with cover.

OXY BOLT – Raced three-wide with cover. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and was found to be lame in the near foreleg. Trainer G Stevenson was advised the gelding would require a veterinary clearance prior to racing.

UNNERVING – Rider C Van Munster reported her mount laid-out throughout the event, placing the gelding at a disadvantage.

ALL ABOUT LUNA – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which detected a laceration to the mouth. Trainer B Franklin was advised the mare would require a veterinary clearance prior to racing.

MISS DARKSIDE (NZ) – Trainer J Keys was advised the mare is required to complete a satisfactory trial after she was difficult to load on a number of occasions.

NIGHTCLUBBING – Slow to begin.

RAFAEL'S RAID - checked after the winning post when TIDEFORD Shifted in, and TAHITIAN WARRIOR shifted out.

Stewards adjourned an inquiry into the reasons why ALL ABOUT LUNA (H McCarthy) and OXY BOLT (A Darmanin) were both dislodged from their mounts rounding the home turn.

RACE 5 - "IT'S WHY WE RACE" CLASS 1 HCP - (1390 METRES)

JOHNNIE PINCH – Shifted out under pressure in the home straight.

POP A HONDA – Raced three-wide throughout.

STORM GIVER (NZ) – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination, no abnormalities were detected.

BOUNTY BAY – Raced three-wide with cover. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination, no abnormalities were detected.

SWOOPING EAGLE – Slow to muster. Had a tendency to over-race in the early stages, raced wide with cover.

ARCUCCI – Stewards granted permission for rider S Carr to ride 1 kilo over the minimum allotted weight.

BELLA TESORO – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination, no abnormalities were detected.

RACE 6 - MOREY'S SPORTS & MUSIC TOURS CLASS 1 HCP - (1390 METRES)

SH'BOURNE MIDNIGHT – Jumped inwards at the start placing the rider at a disadvantage. Had a tendency to over-race in the middle stages.

RESTRICTED ACCESS – Fractious in barrier prior to the start.

ROWING POWER – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination, no abnormalities were detected.

FIORENTE DE LEGEND – Raced three-wide throughout.

VANITY STAR – Slow into stride.

ARELIUS – Stewards granted permission for rider L Riordan to ride 1 kilogram over the allotted weight.

LA LOUVE - Raced three-wide with cover.

SHALL WE PLAY – Stewards granted permission for rider C Newitt to ride 1 kilo over the minimum allotted weight. Jumped awkwardly.

ROYAL SCOTCH – Raced three-wide with cover.

RACE 7 – LADBROKE IT! BENCHMARK 64 HCP – (1200 METRES)

RICH CLAN – Raced wide throughout with cover.

FURNEAUX – Over-raced in the early stages, raced wide throughout.

MAKE A DECISION – Slow to muster.

NGAPALI BEACH – Had a tendency to over-race in the early stages.

I'M BACK – Raced wide throughout with cover.

ENSNARE – Stewards granted permission for rider M Ulucinar 1/2 kilo over the allotted weight.

RACE 8 - KEVIN SHARKIE OPEN HCP - (1200 METRES)

ALPINE WOLF – Held up for clear running in the home straight. Stewards queried rider K Sanderson in relation to the perceived below market performance. Rider K Sanderson stated that in his opinion he was unable to slot into a positive position early and was held up for clear running in the home straight.

KALIUWAA FALLS (NZ) – Slow to begin.

HELLOVA NIGHT – Stewards granted permission for rider M Ulucinar to ride 1 kilo over the minimum allotted weight.

ARUMA – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which detected the gelding had a high heart rate and slow recovery.

JUST A NEEDS – Had a tendency to over-race in the early stages.

FAKE MAGIC – Stewards granted permission for rider S Carr to ride 1 kilo over the minimum allotted weight.

ZIAVERA – Was re-saddled behind the barrier prior to the start.

NEV'S BOY – Slow to begin.

RACE 9 – WINNING EDGE PRESENTATIONS BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP – (2100 METRES)

SUSHI EXPRESS – Reared in barrier prior to the start.

SUNSET GUN – Stewards granted permission for rider C Newitt to ride 1 kilogram over the minimum allotted weight.

SOUTHERN WIND - Raced three-wide with cover.

CAPTAIN MORGAN (NZ) – Re-saddled behind the barriers prior to the start. Raced three-wide with cover. Rider B Muhcu pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on 10 occasions prior to the 100 metres, five more than permitted. In determining penalty stewards took into account his guilty plea and his record under this rule. Rider B Muhcu was fined the sum of \$200. Stewards queried rider B Muhcu on the perceived improved performance. Rider B Muhcu stated that he rode the gelding in a similar manner to his previous win on the gelding and that in his opinion the quick pace set assisted. Trainer P Luttrell also confirmed that the early pace set suited the gelding.

UNIQUE GLOW – Raced three-wide with cover.

PUNTER - Raced wide throughout.
