#### Comments / Explanations:

## **RACE 1 – JG PEST CONTROL MAIDEN - (1220 METRES)**

**NOTORIOUS OUTLAW** – Bumped heavily at the start by WEDNESDAY'S BOSS and was momentarily unbalanced. Checked off heels at about the 600 metres when over racing.

**RED FOX** – Raced three wide throughout, restrained over heels to improve rounding the home turn.

**STAR WALKIN'** – Bumped with VANSITTART at about the 200 metres.

**TRABZON** – Raced wide throughout.

**TYROE** – Slow to begin and over raced early stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near hind. Trainer D Tyson was advised a veterinary certificate will be required prior to the geldings next race start.

**GEE GEE SALTBUSH** – Rider J Radley dropped his at about the 150 metres.

**PURPLE MOON** – Raced wide with cover.

**SOULITA** – A post-race veterinary examination did not identify any significant abnormal findings.

**WEDNESDAY'S BOSS** – Jumped out at the start and bumped heavily with NOTORIOUS OUTLAW.

**MONCLERE** – Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start.

**TWICE THE ICE** – Slow to begin and over raced early.

**WILD NIGHTS** – Stewards granted permission for rider C Newitt to ride 1kg over the allotted minimum weight. Over raced middle stages.

**VANSITTART** – Shifted out under pressure at about the 200 metres and bumped with STAR WALKIN.

Stewards inquired into an incident rounding the home turn. Rider D Pires was reminded of his obligations under AR131(a) careless riding that he must ensure that he is fully clear when shifting ground outwards resulting in TRABZON (C Van Munster) having to steady her mount.

## **RACE 2 – LADBROKES MAIDEN – (1620 METRES)**

**AL MAXIMUS** – Bumped with SUN HALO at the start and raced three wide throughout, had a tendency to over race at about the 1200 metres.

**AQUAFAN (NZ)** – Raced wide throughout.

**GEEGEE'S ROYAL DUKE** – Inconvenienced at the start.

**NEED AN ESCORT** – Jumped out at the start inconveniencing GEEGEE'S ROYAL DUKE.

**RIPPEN GOLD** – Rider M Ulucinar reported that there was something amiss with the gelding on returning to scale and that his mount had changed strides near the 1350 metres and had blundered as a result. In his opinion he believed the gelding to be lame. A post-race veterinary examination did not identify any significant abnormal findings. Trainer D Tyson was advised that the gelding must complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again.

**SHAMUS EAGLE** – Rider D Ganderton reported that there was something amiss with the gelding on returning to scale. Beaten in excess of 61.5 lengths. A post-race veterinary examination did not identify any significant abnormal findings. It was reported that the gelding had dislodged a left fore plate in the run. Trainer P Luttrell was advised that the gelding must complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again.

**SUN HALO** – Bumped with AL MAXIMUS at the start.

**MISS PRIVATE** – A post-race veterinary examination did not identify any significant abnormal findings.

**LYCO RECO** – Stewards granted permission for rider C Newitt to ride 1kg over the allotted minimum weight.

### **RACE 3 – R F FERGUSSON CLASS 1 HANDICAP – (1420 METRES)**

**ASTRO TED** – Began awkwardly and bumped with ELEGANTLY WRITTEN at the start, raced wide throughout.

**NIGHT ACTION** – Under-went a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start, raced three wide with cover throughout.

**SIR TOROBEEL** – Bounded out and bumped with GEE GEES ME BOY at the start.

**ELEGANTLY WRITTEN** – Bumped with ASTRO TED at the start.

**GEE GEES ME BOY** – Bumped with SIR TOROBEEL at the start.

**ROCKIERRO** – A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the left hind. Trainer S Carr was advised a veterinary certificate will be required prior to the geldings next race start.

**VANITY STAR** – Jumped outwards at the start inconveniencing ROYAL SCOTCH and was slow to muster early speed.

**ROYAL SCOTCH** – Inconvenienced at the start when VANITY STAR jumped outwards.

### **RACE 4 – CONGRATS JOHN BLACKER LEADING TRAINER 23/24 SEASON BM60 HCP – (1420 METRES)**

**HOT RELATION** – Raced wide throughout.

**MONTE FLEUR** – Restrained by its rider after the start to obtain a position closer to the rails.

**SANDUAL** – Raced three wide throughout.

**IBUTHO** – Tightened and restrained at about the 1200 metres and commenced to over-race, raced wide from the 900 metres.

**A WEE NIP** – Tightened and restrained at about the 1200 metres.

**O'REILLY MCLUKE (NZ)** – Raced wide early stages.

**MAARKLE** – A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the right fore. Trainer J Luttrell was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to the mare racing again. Trainer J Luttrell advised that the mare would now be retired.

Stewards inquired into an incident at about the 1200 metres were A WEE NIP (A Malik) and IBUTHO (E Byrne Burke) were tightened for racing room and restrained out of their positions. After taking evidence from all riders and viewing the official patrol films, Rider A Darmanin was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) Careless riding for allowing his mount to shift in when not fully clear.

### **RACE 5 – BLAIR SAWMILL / GUY NEWITT MEMORIAL – (1120 METRES)**

**IN THE OCEAN** – Bumped with BLOOMTIME shortly after the start.

**PROPHET EYES** – Raced wide throughout.

**BLOOMTIME** – Inconvenienced at the start, shifted in shortly after and bumped with IN THE OCEAN.

**ZOETE'S ROCK** – Tightened between runners at the start, raced four wide throughout.

**MIHOKO TAKEO** – Raced wide throughout.

**CAPTAIN CAM** – Began awkwardly, over raced early stages.

**STARS IN THE NIGHT** – Began awkwardly shifted in and bumped with BLOOMTIME.

**VOLKANOVSKI** – Began awkwardly shifted in and bumped with ZOETE'S ROCK, raced three wide throughout.

### **RACE 6 – HORSE TRANSPORT BENCHMARK 64 HANDICAP – (1620 METRES)**

**MYWORDIS** – Over raced in the early stages.

**ASVA (NZ)** – Began awkwardly brushing the outside barrier gate.

**THE SPIRIT OF ZERO** – Bumped with ZULU ANGEL at the start.

**ZULU ANGEL** – Bumped with THE SPIRIT OF ZERO at the start.

**PERUN (NZ)** – Bumped by BERSERKER at the start.

**BERSERKER** – Began awkwardly and bumped with PERUN.

**BANCA GLEE** – Declared a late scratching on veterinary advice at 3.20pm after it was found the mare had bled from one nostril on route to the barriers. Trainer J Keys was advised BANCA GLEE has been stood down to a 1000 metre gallop before being permitted to race again. Trainer J Keys was advised of the requirements under the provisions of AR79.

On the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered that all monies invested on BANCA GLEE be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 3.20pm.

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the tickets.

**REWARD FOR ROSIE** – Trainer G Stevenson advised stewards of a change of tactics, and it was their intentions for the mare to be ridden further forward circumstances permitting. Tactics adopted. Stewards queried trainer G Stevenson in relation to the improved performance. Trainer G Stevenson was unable to offer any explanation only that his instructions to his rider was to lead. Rider L Annells was advised that she must ride her mounts out fully to the line.

### **RACE 7 – DELORAINE HOTEL DELORAINE CUP – (1120 METRES)**

**GALENUS** – Over raced early and middle stages.

**HELLOVA NIGHT** – Raced wide throughout.

**GENERAL ASSEMBLY** – Bounded out at the start.

**GEE GEE ENUF SPEED** – Began awkwardly and was slow to begin and then shifted out after the start and bumped with PHILOSOPHERS STONE.

**PHILOSOPHERS STONE** – Slow to begin, bumped by GEE GEE ENUF SPEED and then restrained off heels of HELLOVA NIGHT shortly after. Raced wide throughout. Stewards queried ride C Jordan in relation to the below market performance. Rider C Jordan stated that being caught wide for a major part of the trip didn't assist the horses chances and that in her opinion the gelding maybe better suited to a firmer track and that today's conditions didn't suit.

**GEE GEE PLANE** – Bounded out at the start.

**GEEGEELUCKYSTAR** – Began awkwardly.

### **RACE 8 – THANK YOU KEVIN SHARKIE FROM THE TTC BM60 HANDICAP – (1220 METRES)**

**LORD WHITEGATE** – Began awkwardly unbalancing its rider and was slow to begin.

**LAYLA'S SONG** – Fractious in barriers prior to the start, bumped with LA FOLIE DOUCE rounding the home turn.

**WINCHESTER RIFLE** – Bumped with Mr Freeze shortly after the start.

**LA FOLIE DOUCE** – Bumped with LAYLA'S SONG rounding the home turn.

**MR FREEZE** – Began awkwardly, bumped with WINCHESTER RIFLE shortly after the start and raced fiercely in the early stages, commenced to over race thereafter.
