Comments / Explanations:

RACE 1 – SADDLE UP WITH CRAWF & THE CREW, YOUR RACING PODCAST MAIDEN (1420 METRES)

FOREIGN LEGION – Bumped with NO MORE ROCKS on jumping.

MILES 'N' MILES – Bumped with MONCLERE on jumping.

AFFAIROFTHEHEART – Bounded inwards on jumping, bumping with OUTERTHISWORLD. Forced wider approaching the 100 metres and checked off the heels of ELLISPHERE.

ELLISPHERE – Raced three wide throughout, bandage became dislodged at about the 1300 metres.

MISS PRIVATE – Shifted wider approaching the 100 metres momentarily bumping with AFFAIROFTHEHEART.

MONCLERE – Bumped with MILES 'N' MILES on jumping.

TWICE THE ICE – Stewards granted permission for rider, A Darmanin to ride ½ kg over the allotted minimum weight.

STREETS AHEAD – Over raced early stages, raced three-wide throughout.

NO MORE ROCKS – Bumped with FOREIGN LEGION on jumping.

OUTOFTHISWORLD – Stewards granted permission for rider E Walsh, to ride ½ kg over the allotted minimum weight. Bounded outwards on jumping, bumping with AFFAIROFTHEHEART, raced three wide throughout.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES OWN SPRING MAIDEN – (1220 METRES)

MILTON – Raced wide throughout.

NEED A GIGGLE – Jumped awkwardly, bumping with HEART OF PARIS, held up for a clear run rounding the home turn.

HEART OF PARIS – Prior to the start of the race, the mare reared and placed its foreleg between the barrier gates, forcing them to open prematurely and running for a short distance before being caught by the clerk of the course. The mare underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to run. Jumped awkwardly, bumping with NEED A GIGGLE.

WITHIN SIGHT – Began awkwardly, raced three-wide throughout.

NAVARRÉ RIVER – Stewards granted permission for rider E Walsh to ride 1kg over the allotted weight due to no other suitable rider being available. Slow to begin and over-raced in the early stages. Shifted wider entering the home straight to obtain a clear run.

RAPIDS AHEAD – Rider J Webb was reprimanded under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding for allowing his mount to shift in rounding the home turn tightening the run of MASTRETTA (T Childs).

MASTRETTA – Rounding the home turn elected to shift out over heels of RAPIDS AHEAD to obtain a clear run. Tightened for racing room at about the 200 metres.

ENUFF BREAKERS – Raced three-wide throughout.

NOTORIOUS OUTLAW – Checked and lost its position at about the 200 metres. Lost an off fore plate during the running. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination that revealed no obvious abnormalities.

Rider J Webb (RAPIDS AHEAD) pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under the provisions of AR131(a) for allowing his mount to shift out at about the 200 metres when not fully clear to do so, resulting in MASTRETTA (T Childs) being carried out and tightened out onto NOTORIOUS OUTLAW (C Van Munster) which was tightened and checked by its rider. In assessing penalty

stewards took into account rider J Webbs riding record under this rule and his guilty plea. The licence of rider J Webb was suspended from riding in races for a period of one Tasmanian race date. Rider J Webb was advised of his right of appeal.

RACE 3 – LADBROKES RACING CLUB CLASS 1 HANDICAP – (1220 METRES)

PRIVATE STORM – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination that revealed the gelding to be lame in its near hind. Trainer G Stevenson was advised a veterinary certificate of clearance would be required prior to racing again.

BLONDE STAR – Slow to begin, slow to muster early speed.

ROW ROW POWER – Slow to begin.

ELEGANTLY WRITTEN – Declared a late scratching at 3.13pm due to the track downgrade. On the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered that all monies invested on ELEGANTLY WRITTEN be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 3.13pm.

Stewards ordered that the following deductions would apply:

1st - 6	MAGNAPRIME	3 cents win, 4 cents place.
2nd - 3	DIOS	5 cents place.
3rd - 9	FIGHTING FOR GOLD	6 cents place.

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the tickets.

FIGHTING FOR GOLD – Raced greenly, over raced early and middle stages.

AZONTO – Jumped awkwardly.

RACE 4 – JACKSON SECURITY NEWMARKET & MCB DEVELOPMENTS 3YO CUP NOV 27TH CLASS 3 HANDICAP – (1420 METRES)

WINNING WITNESS – Began awkwardly, held up for a clear run on the home turn.

RACE 5 – BOOK INTO FLINDERS ISLAND CUP NIGHT 25TH OCTOBER MAIDEN/CLASS 1 (2150 METRES)

PUMA – Slow to begin. Bumped with SPRING BEAN on jumping.

SPRING BEAN – Bumped with PUMA on jumping.

AQUAFAN (NZ) – Eased down approaching the home turn by rider D Pires. A post-race veterinary examination revealed lameness to the near fore. Trainer D Tyson was advised a veterinary certificate is required prior to the geldings next race or trial nomination.

PINANDI – Slow to muster early speed.

UNNERVING – Raced three-wide early stages.

FIRE UP RUBY – Raced three-wide early stages, tired over the concluding stages.

RACE 6 – GOLDEN TICKET INTO AUSTRALIAN HERITAGE CUP ON LEXUS MELBOURNE CUP DAY (2450 METRES)

COPPLESON (NZ) – Slow to begin.

GARCON D'ESPOIR – Bounded out on jumping, bumping with A WEE NIP. Tired over the concluding stages.

THREE'S A CROWD – Jumped awkwardly.

REWARD FOR ROSIE – Raced three-wide over the early stages. Tired over the concluding stages. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the near hind. Trainer G Stevenson was advised a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing again.

A WEE NIP – Slow to begin, bumping with GARCON D'ESPOIR.

RACE 7 – FIELD FAMILY BENCHMARK 76 HANDICAP (1120 METRES)

CARTOON GRAVEYARD – Reared prior to the start. Rider K Sanderson on returning to scale reported that he believed the gelding to be lame and elected not to ride his mount out. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the off hind. Trainer J Keys was advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing again.

ROYAL AND TOUGH – Slow to begin.

RACE 8 – CRESSY CHAFF CUTTERS JIM OSBORNE LONGFORD CUP DAY JAN 1 0 – 62 RATING – (1220 METRES)

CREATIVE LICENCE – Over raced early stages.

GEE GEE CAN WIN – Had a tendency to lay in rounding the home turn and in the home straight,

KABOOM KABOOM – Declared a late scratching at 9:37pm on veterinary advice after rearing and becoming cast in the barriers. Trainer W McShane will be advised that a veterinary clearance and a satisfactory trial must be completed prior to the mares next race start. On the announcement of correct weight Stewards ordered that all monies invested on KABOOM KABOOM be refunded, with the following deductions to apply to successful wagers placed prior to 9.37pm.

Stewards ordered that the following deductions would apply:

1st - 7	DAY PERFORMER	11 cents win, 11 cents place.
2 nd - 11	CAPE ZORO	13 cents place.
3rd - 2	DID YOU DECIDED	11 cents place.

All monies bet after the withdrawal to be paid at face value of the tickets.

KENSINGTON DIVA – Declared a late scratching at 11.23am on veterinary advice after showing signs of having a virus. Trainer S Carr was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to racing again. Trainer S Carr advised that she would be having blood tests done on the mare and that she would advise stewards of the results.

FAR AWAY HIT – Began awkwardly, shifted out and bumped with STORM GIVER.

STORM GIVER (NZ) – Stewards granted permission for rider J Webb to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight. Bumped with FAR AWAY HIT at the start and tightened for racing room.

The start of race 8 was delayed nine minutes for the clerk of the course to remove a kangaroo on the course proper between the 400 and 800 metres, a further delay occurred due to KABOOM KABOOM becoming cast in the barriers.
