Comments / Explanations:

Rider C Newitt (MONCLERE) was replaced in race one due to his flight being delayed.

RACE 1 – POWER SOLUTIONS TASMANIA MAIDEN – (1200 METRES)

FREDDY'SAJETSTAR – Over raced early stages, held up at about the 400 metres.

MONCLERE – Jumped out at the start and brushed with SUNRISE AT KIRRA.

COME TO PASS – Slow to begin.

PHERE THE GIRLS - Over raced early stages and raced three wide throughout.

PUZZLE MISS – Fractious in the barriers prior to the start.

STEEL RAIDER – Slow to begin.

YOU BETTER RUN – Restrained after the start to take up a position closer to the rail.

LADY FERN – Underwent a post-race veterinary examination and no abnormalities were detected. Trainer J Blacker was of the opinion that the filly had failed to run out the distance.

PURR SEFANEE – Raced four wide from the 800 metres.

Rider C Wells pleaded guilty under the provisions of AR131(a) careless riding. The particulars of the charge being that at about the 1000 metres she allowed her mount to shift in when not fully clear of PURR SEFANEE (C Jordan) Resulting in PURR SEFANEE being checked by its rider and losing its rightful run. Rider C Wells licence to ride in races was suspended for one Tasmanian race date. Stewards advised C Wells of her right of appeal.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES YARD COMMENTS MAIDEN – (1200 METRES)

ALPINE THUNDER - Over raced early and middle stages of the race.

GUBER – Over raced early stages and raced wide throughout. Bumped with BROADMARSH at about the 200 metres.

STEEL BLUE – Fractious in barriers prior to the start and was slow to begin, over raced middle stages.

GEMS EAGLE – Slow to begin.

SHE PLAYS GAMES – Raced wide throughout.

WORTH TRYING – Raced wide throughout.

BROADMARSH – Began awkwardly and was **s**low to begin. Shifted wider at about the 200 metres to improve to the outside of FIRST LINE, which had shifted out under pressure and then bumped with GUBER.

CURRENCIES – Over raced early and middle stages.

OXIDIZE – Over raced early stages. Held up from about the 400 metres until entering the home straight.

RACE 3 – ANDREW WALTER CONSTRUCTIONS CLASS 3 HANDICAP (1600 METRES)

ASVA – Over raced early and middle stages.

MANDATE – Fractious prior to the start, underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed fit to start. Stewards queried rider L Bingley in relation to the below market expectations. Rider L Bingley stated that in her opinion the gelding was unsettled after being examined by the oncourse veterinarian and when placed under pressure from the 800 metres the gelding failed to respond to her riding. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities. Stewards placed a warning on the gelding's barrier manners. **BLONDE STAR –** Slow to begin, over raced early and middle stages.

FIORENTE DE LEGEND – Stewards granted permission for rider A Darmanin to ride 1/2kg over the allotted weight. Over raced early and middle stages.

RACE 4 – BEC THOMAS MLC FOR ELWICK BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP – (1100 METRES)

MAKE A DECISION – Restrained after the start to obtain a position closer to the rails.

ALTAI RANGER (NZ) – Stewards queried rider A Darmanin in relation to the below market performance. Rider A Darmanin stated that in his opinion the gelding failed to respond early in the race when placed under pressure. He was unable to offer any other explanation. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

WARICA – Over raced early stages.

ANYWAYS ROXIE – Raced wide with cover.

SISTINE – Raced three wide throughout.

KENSINGTON DIVA – Slow to muster early speed.

RACE 5 – POWER SOLUTIONS TASMANIA CLASS 1 HANDICAP – (1390 METRES)

STRATOJACK – Slow to begin.

APRIL'S DANCE – Over raced early stages.

VANITY STAR – Slow to muster early speed.

RACE 6 - POWER SOLUTIONS TASMANIA MAIDEN/CLASS 1 - (2200 METRES)

BULBUK (GB) – Reared on jumping dislodging its rider. Correct weight was delayed for the Stewards to review the official patrol films and speak with rider A Darmanin. After doing so Stewards were satisfied and correct weight was given on the judge's numbers. Stewards advised trainer L Laskey that the gelding must complete a satisfactory trial before racing again. Rider A Darmanin was examined by the on-course doctor and medical staff and was passed fit to fulfil his remaining riding engagements.

KING KURT – Eased down by its rider at about the 1200 metres. A post-race veterinary examination revealed a tendon injury to the near fore. Trainer advised that the gelding would now be retired.

LET'S MESSAROUND – Raced wide throughout.

NO MORE ROCKS – Over raced early stages, shifted out about the 700 metres to avoid the heels of the riderless horse BULBUK.

PINANDI – BULBUK which had lost its rider clipped the heels of PINANDI at about the 1600 metres.

PIPING WILLOW – Fractious in barriers a warning has been placed on the barrier manners of the gelding.

UNNERVING – Fractious in barriers prior to start, raced wide throughout.

RACE 7 – MCKAY TIMBER BENCHMARK 68 HANDICAP – (2200 METRES)

PENNINE – Stood flat footed at the start.

JOHNNIE PINCH - Over raced early stages.

SPRING BEAN – Over raced middle stages.

CHI MAZEL – Shifted wider to improve at about the 1700 metres carrying JOHNNIE PINCH wider on the track.

ROWING POWER – Fractious in barriers prior to the start, slow to begin. Raced wide from about the 1000 metres.

Rider L Bingley (METAVERSE) pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using her whip on 9 occasions prior to the 100 metres, four more than permitted. In assessing penalty stewards noted that this was rider L Bingley's first offense under this rule, and she was fined the sum of \$200.

RACE 8 – POWER SOLUTIONS TASMANIA BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP – (1200 METRES)

KAKIA – Held up rounding the home turn.

GINGERSON – Cross over noseband replaced behind barriers prior to the start.

EAGLE STREET – Tightened for racing room at the start between MR FREEZE which shifted in and EASTCOAST MISS which shifted out.

EASTCOAST MISS – Lost an off-hind plate shortly after the start.

TOUGH IMPACT – Began awkwardly brushing the outside barrier partition, raced wide throughout.

ARAYA SUNSHINE – Held up rounding the home turn and entering the home straight until about the 250 metres.

VENTUS – Bounded out at the start.

MR FREEZE - Over raced early stages.

RACE 9 – DAVID DODGE MEMORIAL BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP - (1390 METRES)

RAFAEL'S RAID – Fractious in the barriers

RUBBLEONTHEDOUBLE – Raced wide from the 700 metres.

ESPRIT DIVA – Stewards queried rider A Darmanin in relation to the below market performance. Rider A Darmanin was unable to explain the performance. He also stated that the mare may have come to the end of its preparation. Trainer J Luttrell was unable to explain the disappointing performance and the only explanation he could offer was that the mare may not have handled todays track conditions or that she may have come to the end of her preparation, and he would now spell the mare. A post-race veterinary examination failed to reveal any obvious abnormalities.

LILY LUELLA – Over raced early stages.

SHARE THE GOLD – Fractious in the barriers, raced wide till the 700 metres and then raced wide with cover from the 700 metres.
