Comments / Explanations:

Rider C Baker was replaced on her first two riding engagements this evening due to flight delays.

RACE 1 – CONGRATULATIONS GARY WHITE LEGEND STATUS HALL OF FAME BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP – (1600 METRES)

SWOOP THERE IT IS – Raced wide throughout.

LI'L HAIL MARY – Had a tendency to over race throughout.

OLE OLA – Raced three wide in the middle stages. Had a tendency to hang out under pressure. Stewards queried rider D Pires on the below market performance of the mare. Rider D Pires stated that in his opinion the mare raced with an unusually high head carriage and hung out throughout the run and failed to respond to his riding when placed under pressure. Trainer J Bazan was also queried on the below market performance of the mare. Trainer J Bazan stated that in her opinion being caught wide throughout placed the mare at a disadvantage.

KABOOM KABOOM – Reared on jumping and as a result was slow into stride.

POP A HONDA – Raced wide throughout.

RACE 2 - SPORTIES HOTEL MAIDED/CLASS 1 - (1600 METRES)

DISTRUSTFUL AWARD – Checked off heels of THONATUS at the start. Had a tendency to over race in the middle and latter stages. Hung in under pressure in the home straight.

KICKPASS – Tightened shortly after the start when CORSA VELOCE jumped outward and THONATUS shifted in. Bumped with PEACE BE WITH YOU after jumping.

PUMA – Raced wide throughout. Brushed with HALEN at about the 100 metres.

RALPH THE ROCKET – Cast a near fore plate during the preliminary and was replaced by the oncourse farrier and underwent a pre-race veterinary examination and was passed suitable to race. Tightened and checked shortly after the start

THONATUS – Jumped inwards at the start

MISS PEBBLES – Bumped with RALPH THE ROCKET at the beginning of the home straight when shifting to obtain clear racing room.

CORSA VELOCE – Jumped outwards at the start bumping with CORSA VELOCE.

HALEN – Raced wide in the early stages. Brushed with PUMA at about the 100 metres.

INDIAN COTTON – Jumped awkwardly at the start and bumped with CORSA VELOCE.

ALL ABOUT LUNA - Slow to begin.

OUTERTHISWORLD - Jumped awkwardly. Had a tendency to over race throughout.

STARS IN MY EYES – Slow to begin.

PEACE BE WITH YOU – Bumped with KICKPASS shortly after jumping. Had a tendency to over race in the middle stages.

RACE 3 – BRIDPORT BAY INN MAIDEN – (1400 METRES)

MATEUS – Slow into stride. Had a tendency to over race in the early and middle stages. Raced fiercely and shied away from the rail at about the 1200 metres, then proceeded to race erratically up onto heels for the next few strides.

NEED A GIGGLE – Resaddled behind the barriers.

BEAU WARRIOR – Had a tendency to race fiercely in the early stages.

RAPIDS AHEAD – Raced wide throughout. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no visible abnormalities.

FERRANS LOCH – Checked off the heels of ELLA MAY which was shifting to find clear racing room.

MAKARSKA SUNSET - Bounded on jumping.

MISS TANZANITE - Difficult to load.

OCEAN EYES – Raced wide throughout.

ZULU FIELDS – Had a tendency to over race in the early stages.

ELLA MAY – Had a tendency to over race throughout.

Stewards inquired into an incident entering into the home straight, in which ELLA MAY (C Newitt) had abruptly shifted wider to obtain clear racing room, and as a result MISS TANZANITE (L Annells) had momentarily restrained. After taking evidence from all riders and reviewing the official patrol footage, stewards reminded rider C Newitt that he must ensure he is fully clear when shifting ground.

RACE 4 - KEVIN LUCAS MEMORIAL - (1400 METRES)

NICCO THE GREEK – Slow to begin. Raced wide throughout.

BETTER THAN BANKSY – Slow into stride. Rider D Pires stated he was disappointed with the geldings run, the gelding had not settled throughout the race, and felt that the heavier weight had not assisted with todays performance. Underwent a post-race veterinary examination which revealed no obvious abnormalities.

SUSHI EXPRESS – Fractious in the barriers.

GEE GEE ENUF SPEED – Tightened entering the home straight by NICCO THE GREEK which had momentarily shifted in.

ISLAND WARRIOR – Slow to begin.

Stewards inquired into an incident entering the home straight, in which GEE GEE ENUF SPEED (E Byrne Burke) had attempted to take an inside run, and was momentarily tightened by NICCO THE GREEK (R Morimoto) which had shifted in. After taking evidence from both riders and Mr K Ring representing apprentice R Morimoto and reviewing the official patrol footage, stewards issued apprentice R Morimoto with a reprimand. In not taking more severe action stewards took into account that Apprentice Morimoto had responded quickly to relieve the pressure.

RACE 5 – JACKSONS SECURITY TASMANIAN NEWMARKET (1200 METRES)

HYPE (IRE) – Checked on jumping by JAGUAR STONE and as a result was slow into stride.

FIRST ACCUSED – Jumped inwards at the start bumping with GALENUS.

SWOOP DOG – Raced wide throughout.

BELLO BEAU – Raced three wide throughout.

GEEGEES GEMSTONE – Bounded on jumping.

KALIUWAA FALLS (NZ) - Bumped with TSUNAMI SAM (NZ) at about the 100 metres.

TSUNAMI SAM (NZ) – Bumped with KALIUWAA FALLS (NZ) at about the 100 metres.

ALVARINHO - Bumped with AND BEYOND

AND BEYOND – Bumped with ALVARINHO

GALENUS – Bumped with FIRST ACCUSED at the start.

JAGUAR STONE – Jumped out at the start, checking HYPE (IRE). Held up briefly entering the home straight.

RACE 6 - McB DEVELOPMENTS 3YO CUP - (1200 METRES)

ZOETE'S ROCK – Bumped with ANGEL SPHERE on the home turn, pushing that horse wider.

MS TASMANIA – Had a tendency to over race. Raced wide throughout.

ANGEL SPHERE – Pushed wider when bumped by ZOETE'S ROCK on the home turn.

DANCING WOLF – Slow to begin.

WILD NIGHTS – Had a tendency to over race.

MASTRETTA – Slow to muster early speed.

Rider A Darmanin (AZONTO) pleaded guilty under the provisions of AR210(1) for failing to weigh in following the running of race 6. In not taking further action, stewards took into consideration submissions from A Darmanin, his record under the rule, and his guilty plea. Rider A Darmanin was fined the sum of \$500.

Rider T Baker pleaded guilty to a charge under the provisions of AR132(7)(a)(ii) for using his whip on 9 occasions prior to the 100 metres. Four more than permitted. Rider T Baker was fined the sum of \$600. In considering penalty stewards took into account his record under this rule and that he had won the race.

RACE 7 - LADBROKES OWN SPRING MAIDEN - (1100 METRES)

DYNAMIC WARRIOR – Difficult to load. Slow into stride.

TEAH – A warning was placed on the loading manners of the mare. Jumped outwards at the start. Had a tendency to over race throughout.

ICE CRYSTAL – Raced three wide in the middle and latter stages. At about the 800 metres, had a tendency to hang in and crowded TRANSOM.

SILVER DAGGER – Had a tendency to over race throughout. Shifted out at the winning post at the completion of the event.

TRANSOM – Jumped awkwardly.

RACE 8 - PHI; HUGHES OFFICE SOLUTIONS CLASS 3 HANDICAP - (1100 METRES)

STARDARMUS – Raced wide throughout.

PEROLA – Had a tendency to over race in the early stages.

RESTRICTED ACCESS – Had a tendency to over race in the early stages.

GOLDEN MEADOW – Bumped with PEROLA in the early stages. Held up momentarily in the latter stages of the home straight.

FAR AWAY HIT – Began awkwardly, contacting the outside barrier gate when the gelding threw its head in the air and bounded on jumping, as a result was 3-4 lengths slow.
