Comments / Explanations:

Rider A Darmanin was stood down by the on-course doctor and medical staff after being assessed with mild dehydration. Rider A Darmanin was replaced in races 6 and 7.

RACE 1 – LADBROKES RACING CLUB CLASS 1 HANDICAP - (1200 METRES)

GLORY MISSION – Momentarily held up entering the home straight. Bumped with KAKIA entering the home straight when improving.

KAKIA – Bumped with GLORY MISSION entering the home straight.

BUNKER BOB - Laid in over the concluding stages, bumping with SWINGING IT.

LONTANO – Slow to begin, laid in, in the home straight.

GEEGEES STRAWBERRY – Slow to begin, raced three-wide throughout.

GEEGEESCHASER - Laid in over the concluding stages bumping with KAKIA.

MISS NIAGARA (NZ) – Slow to begin. Raced three-wide throughout.

SWINGING IT – Bumped with BUNKER BOB on several occasions.

LOVE NEST – Stewards granted permission for rider D Pires to ride ¹/₂ kg over the allotted weight.

SWOOPING EAGLE – Restrained of heels shortly after the start and as a result was slow to muster early speed.

Stewards spoke to rider J Radley in relation to him allowing his mount to shift out over the concluding stages, bumping on several occasions with SWINGING IT.

RACE 2 – LADBROKES FORM GENIUS 3YO & UPWARDS MAIDEN – (1200 METRES)

ENSIGN EAGLE – Collapsed 100 metres after the winning post. Stewards were advised by the oncourse veterinarian Ms L Collier that in her opinion that ENSIGN EAGLE died most likely as a result of some form of exercise induced cardiovascular failure, such acute episode resulting in the collapse and death of ENSIGN EAGLE 100 metres past the winning post, which harmlessly dislodged its rider. A swab sample was taken from the gelding following its death, the results of which are currently being analysed at the Racing Analytical services Limited.

ELLISPHERE – Jumped out at the start and bumped with PURR SEFANEE.

HEART OF PARIS – Slow to begin, a warning was placed on the mare's barrier manners.

MAKARSKA SUNSET – Very slow to begin 2/3 lengths. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in near fore. Trainer, P Luttrell, was advised a veterinary clearance is required prior to racing again.

MATERIAL MADAM – Raced in restricted room rounding and entering the home straight. Car5ried inwards at about the 150 metres when PURR SEFANEE shifted in under pressure.

MOORLANDS MISS – Raced wide throughout.

PURR SEFANEE – Fractious in barriers prior to the start. Jumped inwards at the start bumping with ELLISPHERE. Raced wide throughout, shifted in under pressure carrying MATERIAL MADAM inwards at about the 150 metres.

RAPIDS AHEAD – Fractious in the barriers prior to the start. Jumped inwards at the start. A warning has been placed on the colt's barrier manners.

TIGERS ON TOP – Began awkwardly and was slow to begin, raced wide throughout.

COME TO PASS – Raced in restricted room rounding and entering the home straight.

Stewards inquired into an incident rounding the home turn were COME TO PASS (H McCarthy) was racing in restricted room when attempting to shift out over the heels of the tiring ENSIGN EAGLE (L Bingley). Shortly after MATERIAL MADAM (M Ulucinar) shifted in marginally to improve to the inside of PURR SEFANEE resulting in COME TO PASS (H McCarthy) racing in restricted room between MATERIAL MADAM and ENSIGN EAGLE (L Bingley). Both riders were advised to exercise care and give each other the room they are entitled to.

RACE 3 - MYLES BAKER ELECTRICAL 3Y) & UPWARDS MAIDEN (1400 METRES)

GEE GEES BROTHER – Raced wide throughout.

SCARLETTI – Raced wide throughout.

AUTUMN GLORY – Bumped with GEEGEES LIGHTWOOD at the start, raced wide throughout. Raced greenly in the home straight. Tired over the concluding stages. Stewards to follow up with trainer.

GEEGEES LIGHTWOOD – Bumped with AUTUMN GLORY at the start.

PREMIER CRU – Slow to begin. Uncompetitive - Beaten in excess of 30 lengths. Underwent a postrace veterinary examination and no abnormalities could be detected. Trainer W McShane was advised that the gelding must complete a satisfactory trial prior to racing again.

DIAMOND SUNRISE – Began awkwardly shifted out and bumped with SCARLETTI and carried the gelding wider on the track.

GEEGEEHAILSTORM – Began awkwardly.

MISS PRIVATE – Held up from the 150 metres to about the 50 metres in the home straight.

OCEAN EYES – Shifted out to improve bumping with CURRENCIES carrying the filly marginally wider.

CURRENCIES – Carried marginally wider when bumped by OCEAN EYES rounding the home turn.

RACE 4 – WIN A BRAND NEW CAR ON LADBROKES LAUNCESTON CUP DAY MAIDEN/CLASS 1 – (1600 METRES)

STRATOJACK – Slow to begin, threw its head around after the start and trailed the field.

LITTLE RIVER TOFF – Checked off heels of VALIANT KHAN at about the 900 metres. Commenced to race fiercely for some distance. A post-race veterinary examination revealed the mare to be lame in the off hind. Trainer J Luttrell was advised a veterinary clearance would be required prior to the mares next race or trial start.

PEACE BE WITH YOU – Began awkwardly and jumped outwards bumping with CARNELIAN ROCK. Checked off the heels of LITTLE RIVER TOFF at about the 900 metres.

SON GOKU – Raced wide throughout.

DON'T GIVE UP – Raced wide throughout.

GIRLS CLUB – Tightened for racing room at about the 900 metres.

CARNELIAN ROCK – Jumped inwards at the start and bumped with PEACE BE WITH YOU. Tightened for racing room at about the 900 metres.

Rider L Bingley pleaded guilty to a charge of careless riding under the provisions of AR131(a). Particulars being that at about the 900 metres she allowed her mount to shift ground inwards when not fully clear. Resulting in CARNELIAN ROCK (J Radley) being carried in onto GIRLS CLUB (T Baker) which was carried in onto VALIANT KHAN (E Byrne-Burke) being tightened and checked by its rider. As a result, LITTLE RIVER TOFF (A Darmanin) which was following was severely checked

by its rider and lost its position and PEACE BE WITH YOU (H McCarthy) then checked off the heels of LITTLE RIVER TOFF. In assessing penalty stewards considered rider L Bingley's record under this rule and that the carelessness was in the mid to high range. Rider L Bingley's licence to ride in races was suspended for two Tasmanian race dates. Ms Bingley was advised of her right of appeal.

RACE 5 – LADBROKES COUNTRY CUP MARQUEE LONGFORD CUP DAY BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP (2100 METRES)

ALWAYS A WINNER – Bounded out at the start and inconvenienced shortly after when being tightened for racing room between MONTE FLEUR which jumped outwards and GODDESS OF ROCK which jumped inwards. Restrained off heels of O'REILLY MCLUKE rounding the home turn, which was hanging out and shifted out.

MONTE FLEUR – Jumped out at the start and bumped with ALWAYS A WINNER.

CHI MAZEL – Began awkwardly and shifted out at the start, raced wide throughout.

IRISH STORM (IRE) – A post-race veterinary examination revealed the gelding to be lame in the near fore. Trainer A Brakey was advised that a veterinary clearance would be required prior to the geldings next race or trial start.

PROPHET EYES – Bumped with A WEE NIP at the start.

LAUNNIE NIGHTS – the cross over noseband was adjusted behind the barriers prior to the start.

GODDESS OF ROCK – Jumped inwards at the start and bumped with ALWAYS A WINNER.

THREE'S A CROWD – Began awkwardly, throwing its head in the air.

O'REILLY MCLUKE (NZ) – Rider D Parish advised that the gelding had a tendency to hang out throughout. Shifted out under pressure over the concluding stages.

PUNTER – Raced three wide early.

A WEE NIP – Bumped with PROPHET EYES at the start, raced fiercely in the early stages.

Correct weight was delayed for rider J Radley (LAUNNIE NIGHTS) to view the official race replays with a view to lodging an objection against the winner O'REILLY MCLUKE for alleged interference in the home straight. After viewing correct weight was declared.

RACE 6 – BOOK INTO THE KRELINGER CORPORATE MARQUEE BENCHMARK 60 HANDICAP (1200 METRES)

SWEET LUCIFER – Over raced early stages.

JEHBENTI – Bumped with STEELE MY SUNSHINE shortly after the start.

GOLDEN MEADOW – Tightened and inconvenienced at the start.

STREET DIVA – Fractious in barriers prior to start.

STEELE MY SUNSHINE – Began awkwardly shifting out tightening GOLDEN MEADOW and then bumping with JEHBENTI shortly after.

WITHIN SIGHT - Raced wide throughout.

NGAPALI BEACH – Restrained off heels of DAY PERFORMER NZ at about the 800 metres.

WINCHESTER RIFLE – Shifted in after the start bumping with SWEET LUCIFER.

RACE 7 – CRESSY CHAFF CUTTERS LONGFORD CUP NEW YEARS DAY CLASS 3 HANDICAP (1400 METRES)

RUBBLEONTHEDOUBLE – Held up for clear racing room for a major part of the home straight. When being restrained by its rider at about the 150 metres, shifted out marginally clipping the heels of DIOS.

GEE GEES ME BOY - Raced fiercely early and middle stages.

DIOS – A post-race veterinary examination revealed minor lacerations to the off-hind cannon.

MANDATE – Held up early part of the home straight.

MIGHTYMAXI – Stewards granted permission for rider C Jordan to ride 1/2kg over the allotted minimum weight.

RACE 8 – LADBROKES LAUNCESTON CUP WEDNESDAY 26TH FEBRUARY BENCHMARK 76 HANDICAP (1100 METRES)

LOVIN' BEV – Raced fiercely early stages.
